TODAY'S GAME: Is Game 3 (1-1) of a 3-game, 4-day homestand vs. St. Louis (1-1) prior to the All-Star break (7/11-7/14)....following the break, the Brewers take a 6-game, 7-day road trip to Cincinnati (3g) and Pittsburgh (3g).

IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: RHP **Yhonathan Barrios** (right shoulder strain), OF **Rymer Liriano** (facial fractures), LHP **Sean Nolin** (left elbow soreness) and LHP **Chris Capuano** (left elbow soreness) are currently on the 60-day disabled list....OF **Domingo Santana** (right elbow soreness) is currently on the 15-day disabled list.

BREWERS IN THE STANDINGS (98 days): The Brewers have spent the following number of days alone or tied at each position in the NL Central: **FIRST:** 0, **SECOND:** 1, **THIRD:** 1, **FOURTH:** 73, **FIFTH:** 23....the team is currently in fourth place, trailing the first-place Cubs by 13.5 games....the Brewers trail the second-place Pirates by 7.0 games and the third-place Cardinals by 6.5 games....are ahead of the fifth-place Reds by 7.0 games.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Brewers are 8-13-7 in series play this season....**Game 1:** 13-16, **Game 2:** 11-18, **Game 3:** 11-12, **Game 4:** 3-2....**Sweep Wins (2):** at Atlanta (3g, 5/24-5/26) and vs. Oakland (2g, 6/7-6/8)....**Sweep Losses (4):** at Chicago-NL (2g, 4/26-4/28), at New York-NL (3g, 5/20-5/22), at San Francisco (3g, 6/13-6/15) and at St. Louis (3g, 7/1-7/3).

BREWERS AT HOME: The Brewers are 23-21 at home this season, going 6-5-3 in series play....the team had a season-high 4-game home winning streak (6/11-6/25) and a season-high 3-game home losing streak (4/21-4/23)....the team went 34-47 at home last season, going 8-15-3 in series play.

BREWERS ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 15-27 on the road this season, going 2-8-4 in series play....the team had a season-high 4-game road winning streak from 5/24-6/2 and has had four season-high 4-game road losing streaks....the team went 34-47 on the road last season, going 8-17-1 in series play.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 23 replay challenges, going 11-12....their last challenge (lost) came on 6/28 vs. Los Angeles as an out call at home plate involving Hernan Perez was confirmed....the team went 16-14 in replay challenges last season.

MANAGER: **Craig Counsell** is in his second season as manager of the Brewers (99-124) and first full season....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing **Ron Roenicke**....he went 61-76 last season....bio is on p. 48 of the media guide.

COACHES: Returning from the 2015 staff: hitting coach **Darnell Coles** (2nd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (10th season, 6th as 3B coach) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (4th season)....new to the staff are pitching coach **Derek Johnson**, coach **Jason Lane**, bench coach **Pat Murphy** and first base/infield coach **Carlos Subero**.

TODAY'S STARTER: #41 - RHP JUNIOR GUERRA (12gs, 6-1, 2.93)

GUERRA AT A GLANCE: Junior Guerra, 31, is making his 13th start of the season and second against the Cardinals....Guerra last started last Monday at Washington and earned a 1-0 victory (7.1ip, 2b, 2bb-1bb, 7k, 1wp)....he has won his last 3 starts, posting a 0.81 ERA (22.1ip, 2er) with opponents batting .120 (9-for-75, 1hr)....he has tossed 15.1 consecutive scoreless innings....Guerra has made 8 quality starts....the team is 10-2 in his starts.... opponents are batting .201 (55-for-274, 7hr)....he was recalled on 5/3 from Triple-A Colorado Springs, where he went 0-2 with a 4.63 ERA in 4 starts....Guerra was claimed off waivers by Milwaukee from Chicago-AL on 10/7/15....bio is on p. 89 of the media guide.

YOU NEVER FORGET YOUR FIRST: When he was claimed off waivers on 10/7/15, Guerra became the first player acquired under new GM David Stearns, who joined the team last 9/21.

LAST SEASON: After spending the 2014 season in Italy, Guerra signed as a free agent with Chicago-AL on 10/28/14....he went a combined 4-7 with a 3.13 ERA and 7 saves in 31 games (11 starts) between Double-A Birmingham (5g, 3gs) and Triple-A Charlotte (26g, 8gs)his contract was selected by the White Sox on 6/7 and he made his Major League debut on 6/12 at Tampa Bay....he made 3 relief appearances overall for the White Sox.

CAREER: Is 6-1 with a 3.12 ERA in 15 games, including 12 starts (80.2ip, 28er)....has pitched for Chicago-AL (2015) and Milwaukee (2016).

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Guerra is 5-12 with a 3.72 ERA in 71 games (15 starts) while pitching in the Braves (2006), Mets (2008), White Sox (2015) and Brewers (2016) organizations (169.1ip, 70er)....he has also pitched in the independent American Association with the Wichita Wingnuts (2011 and 2013) and in the Mexican League with Yucatan (2012)....he pitched in Italy during the 2014 season.

CAREER AT MILLER PARK: Is 4-1 with a 2.48 ERA in 6 starts (40ip, 11er)....had not pitched at Miller Park prior to this season.

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 2-0 with a 3.76 ERA in 9 games, including 6 starts (40.2ip, 17er)....is 2-0 with a 3.47 ERA in 6 starts this season (36.1ip, 14er).

CAREER vs. CARDINALS: Took a 6-0 loss in his only start vs. St. Louis on 5/30 this season at Miller Park (6.1ip, 8h, 4r, 3er, 0bb, 6k, 1wp).

CAREER AT THE PLATE: Is batting .190 (4-for-21) with 9 strikeouts....has 5 sacrifice bunts....did not have a plate appearance prior to this season.

FRIDAY'S STARTER: RHP MATT GARZA (1-2, 5.54)

RHP Matt Garza will make his sixth start of the season and first against the Redlegs....Garza last started on 7/6 at Washington and suffered a 7-4 defeat (4.1ip, 8h, 7r, 7er, 2bb-1bb, 2k, 3hr, 1hbp, 1wp).....he has made 1 quality start.....the team is 1-4 in his starts.....opponents are batting .336 (37-for-110, 3hr)..... he was placed on the 15-day disabled list on 4/5, retroactive to 4/2, with a right lat strain, and transferred to the 60-day DL on 4/28.....he was sent to Class-A Wisconsin on rehab assignment on 5/31 (3gs, 0-2, 4.76era, 11.1ip, 13h, 7r, 6er, 1bb, 10k, 1hr)....Garza is 4-3 with a 4.91 ERA in 12 career starts against the Reds (69.2ip, 38er), including 3-0 with a 3.65 ERA over his last 6 starts vs. the Reds (37ip, 15er).
