**CUBS BEGIN 140TH N.L. SEASON:** The Chicago Cubs tonight open their 140th National League campaign on Easter Sunday when they host the St. Louis Cardinals in the first night game home opener in franchise history.

© In 2014, the Cubs finished fifth in the N.L. Central Division with a 73-89 record, 17.0 games behind the Cardinals.  
© Chicago looks for its first winning campaign since going 83-78 in 2009.

**OPENING DAY FACTS:** The Cubs have a 75-62-2 all-time Opening Day record ... Chicago is 46-39 when opening the season on the road and 29-23-2 when opening at home (includes the 2000 opener in Japan) ... Chicago is 22-22-1 in 45 season openers at Wrigley Field.

© The Cubs will be playing the St. Louis Cardinals on Opening Day for the 31st time ... the only team the Cubs have played more Opening Day games against is the Reds (36 times).

© The Cubs will be playing the Cardinals on Opening Day for the first time since 1991 – a 4-1 win by St. Louis at Wrigley Field ... Chicago has dropped its last four Opening Days against the Cardinals after beating St. Louis in a 2-1, 10-inning win at the Friendly Confines, April 6, 1971.

© Chicago is looking for its first Opening Day win at Wrigley Field since April 1, 1996, a 5-4 victory vs. San Diego ... since then, the Cubs have lost season openers at Wrigley in 2001 (Montreal), 2008 (Milwaukee), 2011 (Pittsburgh) and 2012 (Washington).

**JOE MADDON AT THE HELM:** Joe Maddon begins his first season as manager of the Cubs after he was named to the position, November 3, 2014 ... he takes over for Rick Renteria and is the 54th manager in Cubs history.

© The 2015 campaign marks Maddon's 41st season in professional baseball, his 22nd at the major league level and his 10th as a major league manager.

© Maddon previously managed the Tampa Bay Rays for nine seasons from 2006-14, leading the club to four post-season appearances (2008, 2010, 2011, 2013) and winning the A.L. pennant in 2008.

© Maddon is a two-time BBWAA Manager of the Year Award winner, having earned the honor in 2008 and 2011.

**LESTER MAKES OPENING NIGHT START:** Jon Lester will make tonight's Opening Day start for the Cubs after signing a six-year deal with a vesting option for 2021 this past offseason ... he's the first lefty to make a season-opening start for the Cubs since Terry Mulholland in 1997.

© This marks Lester's fifth-straight Opening Day start, as he toed the rubber in season openers for the Red Sox from 2011-14 ... he is 1-1 with a 3.70 ERA (10 ER/24.1 IP) in his four Opening Day starts, all of those coming on the road.

© The last lefty to start the Cubs season opener and earn a win was Pail Minner in 1954 ... only four times in the Wrigley Field era has a lefty starter picked up a win on Opening Day for the Cubs: Hippo Vaughn (1917, 1919), Johnny Schmitz (1950) and Minner (1954).

**ERNIE BANKS:** The Cubs are dedicating this season to Hall of Famer Ernie Banks, who passed away on January 23 ... "Mr. Cub" was a 14-time National League All-Star who spent his entire 19-season career with Chicago (1953-71) ... he earned back-to-back N.L. Most Valuable Player awards in 1958 and 1959, when he hit 47 home runs with 129 RBI in 1958 and followed up with 45 homers and 143 RBI in 1959.

© Banks ranks first in franchise history in games played (2,528), at-bats (9,421), extra-base hits (1,009) and total bases (4,706); second in home runs (512), RBI (1,636) and hits (2,583); third in doubles (407); fifth in runs scored (1,305); seventh in triples (90); and eighth in walks (763).

**NEW FACES IN 2015:** The Cubs have nine new players on the Opening Day 25-man active roster since the conclusion of the 2014 campaign: pitchers Phil Coke (free agent), Jason Hammel (free agent), Jon Lester (free agent) and Jason Motte (free agent); catchers Miguel Montero (trade with Arizona) and David Ross (free agent); infielders Jonathan Herrera (free agent) and Tommy La Stella (trade with Atlanta); and outfielder Dexter Fowler (free agent).

**AROUND THE HORN:** Starlin Castro will be making his fifth Opening Day start at shortstop ... he is the first Cub to start at least four Opening Day games at shortstop since Shawon Dunston made his 11th Opening Day start at short in 1997.

© Anthony Rizzo will make his third-straight Opening Day start at third base ... the previous player to start three-straight Opening Days at first base was Derrek Lee, done seven-straight seasons from 2004-10 ... Carlos Pena was the Cubs Opening Day first baseman in 2011 and Jeff Baker handled the duty in 2012.

**ROOKIE ROUNDUP:** The Cubs begin the 2015 season with two rookies on the active roster: outfielders Jorge Soler and Matt Szczur ... the Cubs also had two rookies on both the 2013 (Kyuji Fujikawa and Hector Rondon) and 2014 (Mike Olt and Brian Schlitter) Opening Day rosters.

© Chicago last had more than two rookies on an Opening Day roster in 2012 when pitchers Lendy Castillo and Rafael Dolis, and catcher Steve Clevenger, were on the season-opening roster.

**PITCHER IN THE EIGHTH SPOT:** In 15,848 games from 1914 through 2014, the Cubs batted the starting pitcher in a spot other than the ninth position just once ... that took place on September 8, 2012 at Pittsburgh in a 4-3 Cubs victory ... Jeff Samardzija, making his final start of the season, hit eighth in the lineup and earned the complete game win while going 0-for-3 at the dish ... thanks to Ed Hartig for his research assistance.

**UNDER THE LIGHTS:** Chicago is 288-288 in 576 night games at Wrigley Field since lights were first installed in 1988 ... the Cubs were 22-16 in 38 night contests last season ... the 22 victories and 38 night games are both franchise marks.

© Tonight's game ties the Cubs earliest calendar date for a night game at Wrigley Field ... in 1989, the Cubs lost to the Phillies, 12-4, in the second game of the season, April 5, 1989.

**SPRING TRAINING SUMMARY:** The Cubs went 15-15-1 in their Cactus League schedule and finished Spring Training 15-17-1 ... after starting out 0-6-1, Chicago was 15-9 in its final 24 Cactus League contests ... the team batted .267 with a .331 on-base percentage and a .459 slugging mark while the staff pitched to a 5.29 ERA (168 ER/286.0 IP) in 33 Spring Training games ... all told, the Cubs used 106 players in Cactus League games – 59 position players (including Will Ferrell's time at the plate and manning first base) and 47 pitchers.

### 2014 Season

Jon made 21 starts for Boston before he was traded to Oakland, July 31 ... he made 11 outings for Oakland, and started the A.L. Wild Card game against Kansas City ... all told, went 16-11 with a 2.46 ERA (60 ER/219.2 IP) in 32 starts between the Red Sox and Athletics.

- ⊙ With Boston, went 10-7 with a 2.52 ERA (40 ER/143.0 IP), 149 strikeouts, 32 walks and a 1.12 WHIP.
- ⊙ Allowed two earned runs or fewer with at least six strikeouts in each of his first four starts from March 31-April 17 ... became the third Red Sox pitcher to begin a season with such a streak since 1914.
- ⊙ Set a team record for most strikeouts by a left-handed pitcher in a regulation nine-inning game when he fanned 15 batters in 8.0 innings against Oakland on May 3.
- ⊙ Traded to Oakland, July 31, with outfielder Jonny Gomes and cash considerations for outfielder Yoenis Céspedes and a 2015 competitive balance pick.
- ⊙ Went 6-4 with a 2.35 ERA (20 ER/76.2 IP) in 11 starts with Oakland, helping the Athletics to an AL Wild Card berth.
- ⊙ Named AL Player of the Week for September 8-14 after going 2-0 with a 1.29 ERA in two starts (2 ER/14.0 IP) with 15 strikeouts.
- ⊙ Overall, his 2.46 ERA was his lowest full-season ERA of his career and he pitched a career-high 219.2 innings.

Jon last pitched against the Cardinals in the 2013 World Series, making two starts ... his only regular season outing against St. Louis came on June 22, 2008 at Fenway Park.

### Career Notes

Jon today makes his fifth-consecutive Opening Day start and first with the Cubs after signing a six-year major league contract in December of 2014 ... he is the first left-handed Opening Day starter for the Cubs since Terry Mulholland in 1997 ... Mulholland was also the last Cubs starter to make his Cubs debut on Opening Day.

- ⊙ A three-time All-Star and two-time World Series Champion, he has twice finished fourth in A.L. Cy Young award voting, doing so in 2010 and 2014.
- ⊙ Has surpassed the 200.0 inning mark in three-straight seasons and in six of the last seven.
- ⊙ During his career has limited lefties to a .243 average (369-for-1,518), while righties have batted .250 (1,123-for-4,492).
- ⊙ He ranks seventh among active left-handed pitchers with 1,457 strikeouts and third with 8.22 strikeouts per nine innings.

### Tuesday's Starter vs. St. Louis — RHP Jake Arrieta (0-0, 0.00)

Jake enters his second full season with the Cubs after a breakout 2014 campaign in which he went 10-5 with a 2.53 ERA (44 ER/156.2 IP) in 25 starts for Chicago ... his 0.92 career ERA against the Cardinals is the lowest among all active pitchers with at least five starts against St. Louis.

- ⊙ Went 3-1 with a 3.86 ERA (6 ER/14.0 IP) in four Cactus League starts this spring ... struck out 15 and walked five.
- ⊙ Last season Jake tied his career-high with 10 wins, including a 6-1 mark in 12 starts at Wrigley Field.
- ⊙ In 2014, he became the first Cub since 1950 to carry three no-hit bids into the seventh inning in a single season, including in back-to-back starts on June 24 vs. Cincinnati and June 30 at Boston.
- ⊙ Has a 2-0 career record with a 0.92 ERA (3 ER/29.1 IP) in five career starts against St. Louis ... went 1-0 with a 1.21 ERA (3 ER/22.1 IP) in four starts against the Cardinals in 2014.
