TODAY'S GAME: The NL West-leading Giants play game two of this three-game series against the Tampa Bay Rays...the Giants are a season-high 16 games over .500 and enter today's game a season-best 6.5 games ahead of the second-place Dodgers in the NL West.

WINNING WAYS: San Francisco has won their last six games and nine of their last 13...beginning May 11, the Giants are a MLB-best 25-8 (.758)...this is tied for their best 33-game stretch within one season since the team moved to San Francisco in 1958 (also had a stretch of going 25-8 in 1962, 1978, 2002, 2004) (courtesy of STATS, Inc.).

GIANT WIN STREAK: The Giants' current six-game winning streak is their third win streak of five-or-more games this season...that's tied for the most in the Majors...the Giants won eight in a row from May 11-19 and had a five-game win streak from May 21-25.

STARTING HAS BEEN STRONG: Since May 11, Giants starting pitchers have gone 17-4 with a 2.13 ERA (50er, 211.1ip)...SF's starting staff has posted a 3.36 ERA overall this season, the fourth-best in the NL behind Chicago (2.29), New York (3.19) and Washington (3.29).

WELCOME BACK: RHP Albert Suarez signed with Tampa Bay at 16 years old in 2006...he made his professional debut in 2008, but he never pitched above double-A by the time the Rays released him after the 2014 season.

ONE RUN WINS: The Giants are 16-7 (.696) in one-run games this season...SF's 16 wins in one-run games are the most in the big leagues.

REHAB UPDATE: RHP Sergio Romo, on the disabled list since April 15 with a right flexor strain, began a rehab stint with Class A Advanced San Jose last night, tossing 1.0-scoreless inning with two strikeouts.

MATT'S CONSECUTIVE GAMES PLAYED: IF Matt Duffy will likely take over as the active consecutive games played leader if and when Baltimore's Manny Machado starts to serve his suspension for his brawl with Yordano Ventura (currently in the appeal process).

WITH THE BATS: During the Giants' current six-game win streak, they've outscored their opponent by a 36-14 margin while batting .300 (.313 with RISP) and averaging 6.0 runs per game.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Giants are 20-13 (.606) on the road this season, the fourth-best road winning percentage in the NL behind Chicago-NL (22-12, .647), Washington (23-13, .639) and St. Louis (20-12, .625).

BELOW .500: SF's next 22 games leading up to the All-Star break will come against teams below .500...15 of the 22 games come against teams currently in last place or in second-to-last place (Tampa Bay, Philadelphia, Oakland, Arizona)...SF is 27-13 (.675) against teams below .500 this season.

WHERE'S THE POWER?: San Francisco has hit just 56 homers overall, the third-fewest in the Majors (Atlanta, 29; Miami, 55).

WITH THE GLOVES: The Giants have committed just 29 errors this season, the second-fewest in the NL (Nationals, 24)...SF hasn't made a miscue in their last six games.

MANAGER BRUCE BOCHY
Bruce Bochy is in his 10th season at the helm of the Giants...his only predecessors to reach double figures were John McGraw (1902-32), Bill Terry (1932-41) and Dusty Baker (1993-2002)...SF has posted a 793-733 (.520) record during his 10-year tenure...his 1,744 victories are the highest total by an active manager and rank 16th on the all-time list...Bochy is one of 10 managers in ML history to win three World Series titles...the other nine are in the Hall of Fame.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

**#56 RHP Albert Suarez
6-3, 235, 26 years old (October 8, 1989)
2-1 Record, 3.33 ERA**

- 26-year-old rookie is slated to make his third Major League start today against the Rays...has gone 2-1 with a 3.33 ERA in six relief appearances and two starts.
- Was scheduled to start tomorrow, however **RHP Jake Peavy** has been dealing with a stiff neck and has been pushed back to tomorrow, giving him an extra day to recover.
- Is taking the rotation spot of **RHP Matt Cain**, who was placed on the 15-day disabled list on June 14 due to a right hamstring strain...Cain originally suffered the injury in his start on May 27 at Colorado and then re-injured the hamstring during his June 13 start against Milwaukee...Suarez relieved him and tossed 3.2 innings, allowing two runs on five hits (threw 56 pitches).
- Made his last start June 7 against Boston and tossed 6.1 innings while allowing three runs on five hits... left with a 3-2 lead but the bullpen gave up the tying run in the seventh and the Giants eventually lost 5-3 in 10.0 innings.
- Had his contract purchased from triple-A Sacramento on May 6 and made his Major League debut May 8 against Colorado.
- Despite breaking into the Majors as a reliever, Suarez is primarily a starting pitcher: since he began playing minor league games in 2009, 105 of his 117 appearances have been as a starter.
- Posted a 1-2 record with a 2.88 ERA (8er, 25.0ip) in five games (three starts) for triple-A Sacramento this season, his first at the triple-A level.
- A Venezuela native, Suarez signed with Tampa Bay at 16 years old in 2006...he made his professional debut in 2008, but he never pitched above double-A by the time the Rays released him after the 2014 season.
- Pitched in the hitter-friendly Texas League with the Angels' double-A affiliate in 2015 and won the ERA title, posting a 2.98 ERA in 27 starts...was also named a double-A All-Star.
- Was signed by San Francisco as a minor league free agent this past offseason and has stepped into the swingman role vacated by Yusmeiro Petit in the offseason, serving as the team's primary long reliever and as the rotation's sixth man.
- Collected his first big league hit in his start June 1 at Atlanta, hitting a single off LHP Ian Krol.

NOTES: 2007 NL Cy Young Award winner and three-time All-Star is slated to make his 14th start of the season...had his start pushed back a day because of a stiff neck...is 3-6 with a 5.83 ERA (43er, 66.1ip) in his first 13 starts...earned the win in his last start on Sunday against Los Angeles-NL...tossed 6.0-scoreless innings, allowing just four hits and one walk with three strikeouts in the Giants 2-1 victory over the Dodgers...marked his 150th career win... owns a 3-2 record with a 4.96 ERA (27er, 49.0ip) in eight career starts against the Rays...last faced them on May 24, 2014 (with Boston) and threw 6.0 innings, allowing five runs on eight hits in the Red Sox 6-5 loss to Tampa Bay...is 2-0 with a 4.81 ERA (13er, 24.1ip) in four career starts at Tropicana Field...has posted a 22-14 record with a 3.06 ERA (97er, 285.2ip) in 45 career Interleague starts.

- Was placed on paternity leave yesterday and will miss all three games this weekend.
