ST. LOUIS CARDINALS (22-8) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (14-16) MAY 10, 2015 AT PNC PARK --- GAME #31, HOME #16 LHP TYLER LYONS (0-0, 6.23 ERA) vs. LHP JEFF LOCKE (2-2, 4.85 ERA)

THE PIRATES... have won two of their last three games after losing a season-high five in a row...Have gone 3-8 in their last 11 games after winning a season-high five straight from 4/22-26...Have gone 11-10 in their last 21 games...Were 12-18 after 30 games last season (12-19 after 31).

LOCKE IT UP: LHP **Jeff Locke** tied his career high with 8.0 innings pitched in his first start at PNC Park this season; a 6-2 victory over Kyle Lohse and the Brewers on 4/18...In his last 13 starts at PNC Park (dating back to 6/8/14), Jeff has posted a 3.22 ERA (86.2ip/31er)...Dating back to 6/19 of last season, the Pirates have gone 10-2 in games started by Locke at PNC.

LET THE SUN SHINE: The Pirates have gone 3-0 in day games played at PNC Park this season...**Pedro Alvarez** has hit four of his five home runs this season in day games and leads all National League players with 38 home runs hit in day games since the start of the 2012 season...**Gregory Polanco** is hitting .425 (17-for-40) in nine day games this season.

SOUTHPAW SUCCESS: **Starling Marte** is hitting .500 (6-for-12) against left-handed pitchers this season, which ranks second in the National League...Marte's four home runs against southpaws are tied for the second-most in the Majors (Seattle's Nelson Cruz leads the way with five).

HITTIN' THE ROAD: Following today's game the Pirates will depart for Philadelphia, where they are scheduled to begin a four-game series Monday night...The seven-game road trip concludes next weekend with a three-game series at Wrigley Field.

PRETTY IN PINK: In addition to 11 Pittsburgh players using pink bats and 17 wearing pink shoes, many players on both teams today will be wearing pink batting gloves and pink protective gear to once again raise national awareness for breast cancer...In addition, **Chris Stewart** will be sporting pink catching gear behind the plate today.

STEWIE: Bucco backstop **Chris Stewart** ranked third among National League players last year with a .319 batting average from the eighth spot of the lineup (min: 110 AB), trailing only Alcides Escobar (.330) and David Murphy (.328)...Stewart has six hits in his last 15 at bats and the Pirates have gone 5-1 this season in games that he has started...Behind the plate, Chris has posted a 1.49 catcher's ERA and has thrown out three of the six baserunners attempting to steal against him.

GUNG HO OVER JUNG HO: Bucco infielder **Jung Ho Kang** is hitting .419 in his last 11 games, going 13-for-31 with three doubles, a home run and seven RBI...He had a career-high three RBI in his start at shortstop on 4/21, a career-high three hits in his start at third base on 4/29 and hit his first Major League home run last Sunday; a solo shot off Trevor Rosenthal.

DEALING WITH THE CARDS: The Bucs have gone 17-10 against the Cardinals at PNC Park since the start of the 2012 season and are 14-6 in the last 20 games played in Pittsburgh.

THE BIG BULL: **Pedro Alvarez** has 16 career home runs against St. Louis, which are the second-most vs. any team in his career (he has hit 17 vs. Milwaukee)...Since the beginning of the 2013 campaign, Alvarez' 14 home runs and 43 RBI against the Red Birds are the most by any player in the big leagues.

CENTRAL CASTING: Following this homestand, the Pirates will have played 25 of their first 31 games against teams from the N.L. Central division...They have gone 10-14 in the first 24 games against their divisional rivals (7-5 at home), 2-9 against St. Louis and Cincinnati...Beginning Monday, the Bucs will play 22-of-25 game outside their division.

ON THE HOMEFRONT: The Pirates have gone 8-7 at PNC Park this season and have won 109 home games since the start of the 2013 season; the second-highest win total among Major League teams at home behind St. Louis (119).

PEDRO MOVING UP THE CHARTS: With his home run last Sunday, **Pedro Alvarez** tied Hall-of-Famer **Paul Waner** and former outfielder **Bill Robinson** for 17th place on Pittsburgh's all-time home run list with 109...**Bobby Bonilla** is 16th on the list with 114 and current Bucco outfielder **Andrew McCutchen** is 12th with 130.

BEEN CAUGHT STEALING: The Pirates catchers and pitchers share the Major League lead in caught stealings (13) with San Diego...They have caught six of the last 15 runners attempting to steal against them.

START ME UP: Pittsburgh starting pitchers have produced the second-lowest ERA in the National League (3.16) behind the New York Mets (2.89).

ELEMENTARY FOR WATSON: Since the start of the 2012 season, Bucco All-Star **Tony Watson** leads all Major League left-handed relief pitchers in appearances (230)...He also leads N.L. lefty relievers in ERA (1.99) since 2013 and ranks second in the Majors in that time behind New York's Andrew Miller (1.90)...Watson has been scored upon just once in his last 24 games at PNC Park (24.0ip/1er), dating back to 8/6 of last season.

THE HIT PARADE: **Andrew McCutchen** collected his 1000th career hit on 4/29, becoming the 33rd different Pittsburgh player to collect at least 1000 hits...McCutchen's 1010 hits now rank 32nd on the club's all-time list...**Bob Skinner** ranks 31st on the Pirates hit list with 1050 and **Richie Hebner** is 30th with 1079.

STERLING STARLING: With seven home runs, **Starling Marte** is tied for fourth among N.L. outfielders behind Bryce Harper (11), Joc Pederson (nine) and Justin Upton (eight)...Marte also ranks sixth in the N.L. with 21 RBI and is hitting .333 (21-for-63) with four home runs and 12 RBI in his last 17 games.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 10, 1960: Vernon Law tossed a complete game and improved to 5-1 on the season as the Bucs won a 3-2 decision at Los Angeles. All three Pirates runs came by way of the long ball as Hal Smith hit a solo shot in the third inning and Bill Mazeroski broke a 1-1 tie in the fifth with a two-run blast off Dodgers starter Johnny Podres.

TOMORROW'S STARTER

GERRIT COLE: The 24-year-old righthander will be making his seventh start of the season tomorrow night when the Pirates open a four-game series at Philadelphia...He had his eight game winning streak dating back to last season snapped in his last start after losing a 3-0 decision (5.0ip/3r) Wednesday vs. Cincinnati...Has been charged with more than one earned run in just two of his first six starts this season... Took home National League Pitcher-of-the-Month honors for April after going 4-0 with a 1.76 ERA.

vs. PHILADELPHIA: 1-1 with a 2.61 ERA (10.1ip/3er) in two career starts...Won an 8-2 decision over Roberto Hernandez last season on 7/4 at PNC Park; left the game after 5.0 scoreless innings with right lat soreness...Also suffered his first big league loss to the Phillies, dropping a 6-4 decision (5.1ip/3r/3er) to Cole Hamels on 7/4/13 at PNC Park...The Bucs held a 2-0 lead before the Phils scored once in the fifth and four times an inning later.
