TODAY'S GAME: The Cardinals continue their nine-game homestand this afternoon with the final and rubber game of a three-game weekend series against the Arizona Diamondbacks...first pitch is set for 1:15 p.m. CDT and all kids 15 and younger receive a performance T-Shirt, as well as kids 48 inches and under will receive a free ticket to Six Flags...the Cardinals had three home runs yesterday on the way to a 6-2 win as Mike Leake evened his record at 3-3 with the win...St. Louis took 2-of-3 from Colorado to begin the homestand...the Cardinals will host the Rockies (2-1), Arizona Diamondbacks (1-1) and Chicago Cubs (May 23-25) during the current homestand...the Cardinals are 12-12 overall at Busch Stadium, 3-2 on this homestand...they are home for 17 games this month and then just 10 times during the month of June.

MIKE MATHENY: Mike Matheny is in his 5th season as the Cardinals manager, having taken his teams to the postseason in each of his first four seasons, the only manager in MLB history to do so...Mike has managed 43 postseason games, and has 21 postseason wins since 2012, 3rd-most wins among current Major League managers...in 2012 Matheny became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history and in 2013 he took his team to the World Series in just his second season at the helm with a league-best 97-wins...in 2014, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Central title and their 4th-straight trip to the NLCS...he led an injury-riddled team in 2015 to 100 wins, the best in the majors, and the N.L. Central Division title for a 3rd-straight season...Matheny, 45, had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252).

REDBIRD RUNDOWN: The 2015 N.L. Central Champion St. Louis Cardinals are in their 125th season of play in the National League...St. Louis entered the day 7.0 games back of 1st place Chicago & 1/2-game back of 2nd place Pittsburgh...the Cardinals are 16-14 in their last 30 games, 11-9 in last 20, 6-4 in last 10 and 3-2 in their last five...the club holds a +55 run-differential, 3rd in the majors behind only the Cubs (+111) and Red Sox (+63).

THE MERRY, MERRY MONTH OF MAY: Stephen Piscotty is batting .382 (29-76) this month, the Cardinals top mark in May (min. 85 PA's) since Yadier Molina posted a .394 BA (37-94) in May of 2013...Brian Jordan's .424 BA (36-85) in May of 1998 is the Cardinals top average for the month.

GOOD & PLENTY: The Cardinals 13-7 win last Thursday was their 9th game scoring 10+ runs this season, matching their most ever in the first 41 games (also 2000 & 1930) *Orf...* **POWER BURSTS:** The Cardinals 58 HR's are 2nd to the NY Mets (59) in the NL (Arizona is 3rd with 53)...the Redbirds (91) & D-Backs (88) rank 1-2 in NL doubles.

PINCH HITTERS ON PARADE: The Cardinals received pinch hits from Eric Fryer and Brandon Moss Friday night, upping their Major League-leading pinch-hit total to (26), seven more than the 2nd place Diamondbacks (19)...Cardinals pinch-hitters also lead the majors with 8 pinch HR's and 21 pinch-RBI...the Redbirds are batting .356 (26-73) with a .442 on-base pct. and .740 slugging mark in the pinch this season.

FREQUENT FLYERS: The Cardinals have a total of 8 players who have hit 5 or more home runs this season, tops among all MLB teams, followed up by the Diamondbacks & Tampa Bay Rays who have 7 players to have done so.

WAR HORSES: Three Cardinals rank among the NL's top 10 in WAR among position players, led by Stephen Piscotty (2.4-1st), Aledmys Diaz (2.0-T5th) and Matt Carpenter (1.8-8th).

OH MY! Rookie Seung Hwan Oh has fanned 2 or more batters while working 1.0 inning or less, eight times in his first 21 appearances, the most ever by a Cardinal...Kevin Siegrist (2013) & Maikel Cleto (2012) did so five times.

#54 **JAIME GARCIA** • RHP • 6-2 • 215 • 29 yrs

TODAY'S GAME:

- ◆ Makes 9th start of the season in his 135th game/126th career start.
- ◆ Ranks 4th among N.L. pitchers in lowest opponent batting average (.182), 4th in hits per 9.0 IP (5.90), 17th in ERA (2.86) T18th in strikeouts (51), 9th in WHIP (1.03) and baserunners per 9.0 IP (9.48).
- ◆ Allowed three runs over 5.0 innings for loss in homestand opener vs. COL (5/17)...had not allowed an earned run (2R) in previous 16.0 innings before the Rockies scored in the top of the 3rd inning.
- ◆ Is lifetime 17-8 with a 2.89 ERA in 39 career matinee starts; ranks 4th among active MLB pitchers in ERA and win pct (.680) (min. 240 IP).
- ◆ Since beginning of 2015 season (15 GS, 101.0 IP, 11 quality outings), ranks among N.L. leaders in ERA (1.96, 4th), average against (.184, T2nd) and WHIP (0.88, 3rd). STL is 10-5.

VS. ARIZONA DIAMONDBACKS:

- ◆ Has made six career starts vs. Arizona and is 5-0 with a 2.94 ERA.
- ◆ Is one of four MLB pitchers to have a perfect winning pct vs. ARI and at least six games started (Lance Lynn, Steve Parris, Mike Thurman), but the only one at 5-0.
- ◆ Came away with no-decision in 12-7 loss at ARI this season (4/25).
- ◆ Faced Arizona twice in 2015 and won at Busch Stadium (5/26) and almost three months to the day at Chase Field (8/25). Threw 6.0 innings for the win in each.
- ◆ Is a career 2-0 with a 3.75 ERA in two starts at Busch (7/10/11 & 5/26/15) vs. D-Backs, with 12.0 IP & allowing 6R (5 ER) with 10 K's.
- ◆ Has not allowed a home run to an N.L. West batter in last 171 TBF and 40.2 innings (last HR: Nick Ahmed, ARI, 5/26/15 at STL).

2016 SEASON & CAREER:

- ◆ Yielded two home runs over 203 total batters faced this season, 3rd in the N.L. with a 0.36 HR/9 IP ratio (Cueto, SF leads 0.27).
- ◆ One of five N.L. pitchers with a complete game shutout this season (Kershaw 2, Arrieta, Velasquez, Cueto).
- ◆ Produced two separate scoreless inning streaks of 15.1 (4/30-5/11) and 15.0 (4/8-4/19), ranked 9th & 10th-longest in the N.L. this season.
- ◆ Struck out COL's Ryan Raburn (5/17) for his 357th strikeout at Busch Stadium, passing Chris Carpenter into 3rd place at the venue. Needs 19 to tie Lance Lynn (376).
- ◆ Allowed no earned runs (2R) in his start 5/11 at LAA, striking out 8 over 7IP in the 5-2 win. Snapped his scoreless streak w/2R in the 4th.
- ◆ Struck out five while hurling 7.0 scoreless frames in 4-0 win over PHI (5/5), snapping a three-game losing streak against the Phillies; became the 5th pitcher to reach 30 career wins at Busch Stadium III (tied with Kyle Lohse for the 4th-most).
