TODAY'S GAME: The Cardinals & rival Milwaukee Brewers play the final game of three today with an early 12:10 p.m. start...the Redbirds will be looking for the sweep, having last swept the Brewers last May 2-5 in a 4-game series at Miller Park...St. Louis faces MIL-3 (2-0), WSH-4 and NYM-4 on this 11-game roadtrip...their next home game is April 25 when Pittsburgh will visit St. Louis...the Redbird's concluded their first homestand of the year Sunday going 4-2 (2-1 vs. CIN, 2-1 vs. CHI).

MIKE MATHENY: Mike Matheny, who in 2012 became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history, took his team to the World Series in his second season at the helm with a league-best 97-win season in 2013...in 2012, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Championship round of the playoffs...he is the first Cardinals manager to lead his teams to the postseason in each of his first two seasons, having already managed 30 postseason games in his first two seasons...Matheny, 43, had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252) and for consecutive errorless chances (1,565)...he will serve as the N.L. Manager for this year's MLB All-Star Game in Minneapolis, MN.

THIS DATE IN STL HISTORY, 2004: Won 13-5, collecting 16 hits over Colorado in St. Louis...Tony Womack and Reggie Sanders led off the bottom of the 1st with back-to-back homers for St. Louis, as the Cards scored 4 in the 1st inning and 3 in the 2nd frame...Marlon Anderson and Sanders again both homered in the four-run 3rd as St. Louis took an early 10-3 lead...Matt Morris took the win in the start, allowing four runs in 7.1 IP, and went 2-3 at the plate, driving in a run and scoring once.

BIRD WATCHING: The 2013 National League Champion St. Louis Cardinals have entered their 123rd season of play in the National League...the team is wrapping up the first of three cities during its longest roadtrip of the season: 11 games in 11 days with 3 at Milwaukee (2-0), 4 at Washington D.C. and 4 in New York...St. Louis also has an 11-day, 10 game trip to June 23-July 3.

20-for-20: The Cardinals began a stretch of 20 games in 20 days last Friday (4/11) and a stretch of 26 games in 27 days with the lone open date on Thursday, May 1. **READING THE ROAD MAP:** The Cardinals were 14-5 (8-2 at Miller Park) last season...they went 6-0 (3-0 at Nationals Park) against Washington and 5-2 (2-1 at Citi Field) against the NY Mets.

ELLIS JOINS CLUB: Infielder **Mark Ellis** was activated from the 15-day disabled list prior to yesterday's game and started at second base...Ellis went 0-3 with a sacrifice fly, picking up his first two RBI as a Cardinals...his last two regular season RBI came 9/27/13 vs. COL while with the Dodgers last year...shortstop **Pete Kozma** was optioned to Memphis to make room on the 25-man roster.

BIG CITY LIGHTS: **Matt Adams** had two hits last night giving him back-to-back multi-hit games and lifting his batting avg. to .370, 8th in the N.L. ...his team-high 8 multi-hit games are T1st in the League, and his team-high 6 doubles are T5th...Adams leads the team with 20 hits T6th N.L.).

PERALTA POPS: New 'Bird **Jhony Peralta** has collected two hits in each of his last three games after having just two hits through his first 10 games - both solo homers...Peralta has homered in each of the last two games as well, giving him four of his eight hits coming as the long ball...**Edgar Renteria** holds the Cardinals April record for shortstop homers with 5 in 2000...the Redbirds had a total of four home runs from their shortstops in all of 2013.

WHAT A RELIEF: The Cardinals bullpen has worked 5.0 scoreless frames this series vs. Milwaukee, and going back five games the relief core has allowed one run (solo HR) in 9.2IP...four separate relievers have kept the Brewers at bay this series, not giving up a hit or walk, and striking out five... lefthander **Kevin Siegrist** appeared in his 8th game of the season last night, T3rd in the league, and has six strikeouts in 5.2 innings of work...he fanned 50 in 39.2 innings during his rookie season last year.

EARLY BIRDS: The Cardinals own the Major's best mark (211-147, .589) in March/April games since 2000...the Cards last losing April came in 2007 (10-14).

JOE KELLY • RHP • 6-1 • 175 • 25 yrs • #58

⇒ Making his 3rd start of the season, 1st vs. MIL in 2014.
 ⇒ Has 5 career starts, 8 games pitched vs. the Brewers in his career. Is 1-4, 4.68 ERA career; 1-3, 3.94 as a starter vs. MIL.
 ⇒ In his 2 starts at Miller Park, is 0-2, 3.46 ERA; one start in 2012 (6.0IP, 6H, 3R, 2ER) and one in 2013 (7.0IP, 7H, 6R, 3ER).
 ⇒ In his five starts vs. MIL as pitched 5.0+ each game and allowed 2ER or more in each start.
 ⇒ Last season made 2 September starts and pitched 5 gms total against MIL, going 0-3, losing both starts.
 ⇒ Did not get a decision in the team's 6-3, 11-ing. loss last Fri. (4/11) vs. CHI. Went 6.0 IP and did not allow an earned run (1R).
 ⇒ Gained a 6-1 win at PIT on 4/5 in his 2014 debut, limiting the Pirates to 1 run in his 5.1 IP, as he improved to 4-1 against PIT.
 ⇒ His 2.97 ERA from 2012-14 ranks 9th in MLB (min. 30 GS).
 ⇒ Was 2-1, 6.28 ERA in 4 Spring starts (14.1 IP). Had 3 base hits in his 3/15 start against the Braves at Disney.
 ⇒ STL won 9 of his last 11 starts in 2013 and 12 of 15 overall.
 ⇒ Was 9-3, 2.28 ERA in his starts last season, allowing 2 runs or less in 11 of the 15. Worked into the 6th inning in 13 of the 15 starts.
 ⇒ Posted a 1.97 ERA after 6/1, ranking 3rd among all MLB pitchers (min. 90 IP) to MIA's Jose Fernandez & Dodgers Clayton Kershaw.
 ⇒ Was 4-2, 3.38 ERA in his 8 starts at Busch Std. last year with the Cardinals posting a 6-2 mark in those 8 games.

 ⇒ Won both starts in 2013, 1.76 ERA. Allowed no runs over 8.1 IP in his start at DC on 4/23 (5H, 0BB, 9K), a 2-0 win, and gave up 3 runs in 7.0 IP in STL on 9/23 in a 4-3 win.
