TODAY'S GAME: The Cardinals wrap up their three-game weekend series this afternoon against the Miami Marlins with first pitch slated for 1:15 p.m., Central Time...the third and final commemorative giveaway during Budweiser's 2006 World Series Anniversary Weekend will be the Adult Replica Home White 2006 Mystery Player Jersey (30,000 fans, ages 16 and older).

LAST GAME: Adam Wainwright threw his 10th career shutout and 22nd career complete game in St. Louis' 5-0 win last night; Wainwright scattered three hits and struck out five...the Cardinals' scoring was highlighted by three doubles by Tommy Pham, Stephen Piscotty and Randal Grichuk during a four-run third inning...Jhonny Peralta capped the evening with a solo homer in the fifth...the Cardinals are 20-27 at Busch Stadium and 27-16 on the road in 2016.

COMING UP: The Cardinals continue their 10-game homestand (MIA 1-1, SD 4, LAD 3) tomorrow night by welcoming the San Diego Padres for a four-game series at Busch...first pitch is slated for 7:15 p.m. on American Girl Night.

MIKE MATHENY: Mike Matheny is in his 5th season as the Cardinals manager, having taken his teams to the postseason in each of his first four seasons, the only manager in MLB history to do so...Mike has managed 43 postseason games, and has 21 postseason wins since 2012, 3rd-most wins among current Major League managers...in 2012 Matheny became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history and in 2013 he took his team to the World Series in just his second season at the helm with a league-best 97-wins...in 2014, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Central title and their 4th-straight trip to the NLCS...he led an injury-riddled team in 2015 to 100 wins, the best in the majors, and the N.L. Central Division title for a 3rd-straight season...Matheny, 45, had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252).

▢ **REDBIRD RUNDOWN:** The 2015 N.L. Central Champion St. Louis Cardinals are in their 125th season of play in the National League...St. Louis entered the day in second place, 1.5 games ahead of Pittsburgh and 8.0 games behind first-place Chicago in the N.L. Central...the Cardinals are 15-15 in their last 30 games, 10-10 in last 20, 5-5 in last 10 & 3-2 in their last five...St. Louis holds a +93 run-differential, 3rd in NL behind CHI (+147) & WSH (+115).

▢ **PHAM-A-LAM-A DING DONG:** Tommy Pham recorded his second-straight multi-hit game last night and has an extra base hit in each of his last four games (3 HR, 2 doubles)...Pham has reached base safely in his last 10 games and is hitting .387 (12-31) in 11 July contests, 3rd-best in the National League (min. 30 at-bats) (H. Kendrick, .426).

▢ **GOT THAT GRICH:** Randal Grichuk has hit safely in all eight games (12-30, .400) since returning from Memphis, while 6-of-12 July hits have gone for extra bases (3 HR, 3 2B)...his eight-game hit streak ties his career high (July 26-August 5, 2015) and is tied for the 3rd-longest active in the National League. (A. Rizzo, 11).

▢ **AWESOME ALEDMYS:** Aledmys Diaz walked last night to reach base safely in 20 straight games (June 19-present), which is one shy of a team-high (Matt Adams, 21)...Diaz's on-base streak is the longest by an MLB rookie this season and the longest by a Cardinals rookie since Albert Pujols, who had streaks of 30 & 48 games in 2001.

▢ **DEEP THOUGHTS:** Jhonny Peralta's solo homer last night marked the seventh consecutive game in which the Cardinals have homered (14 HR, July 6-present) and is one fewer than their season-high (11 HR, May 25-June 1)...the club's 122 home runs in 2016 are the 3rd-most in the N.L. and are already 15 shy of last year's total (137).

#52 MICHAEL WACHA • RHP • 6-6 • 215 • 25 yrs

TODAY'S GAME:

- ◆ Makes 19th start of the season & 77th start of his career (83rd app).
- ◆ Is 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA in his last six starts (39.0 IP/13 ER). His .750 win pct. since June 1 is tied with Carlos Martinez for team lead.
- ◆ Cardinals have won 5 of his last 7 starts since 6/4 after a stretch in which they had lost 6 of 7 from 4/28-5/29.
- ◆ Has 10 quality starts this season, 4th on Cardinals staff. Has four starts of 7.0 IP or more this season, but an 0-3 record in those games.
- ◆ Is 2-4 in his nine starts at home this year with 4.70 ERA and 3-3 in nine road starts with a 4.02 ERA.
- ◆ Is 3-2, 3.03 ERA in six starts during the day in 2016 and 15-7, 2.88 ERA career in 27 day starts, 20 of which have been quality starts. Is 8-2, 2.28 ERA in 13 career day starts (11 QS) at Busch (83.0 IP/21 ER).

VS. MIAMI MARLINS:

- ◆ Is facing the Marlins for the first time in his career in regular season play. Has made five career appearances against the Marlins in Spring Training, winning his lone decision on March 30 this season, 3-0 (5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 2 SO).
- ◆ Is 6-6, 2.85 ERA career vs. NL East clubs in 14 games/12 starts. Is 0-2 with a 2.57 ERA this season vs. the NL East, losing to PHI & WSH.

2016 SEASON & CAREER:

- ◆ 31 of his 110 hits allowed have been doubles, T1st-most in MLB with PHI's Jeremy Hellickson (31).
- ◆ Has lost two starts this season when allowing only one run (5/3 vs. PHI & 6/17 vs. TEX), both 1-0 Cardinals defeats.
- ◆ Allowed a career-high 3 HR's (all solo) in his last start, 7/8 at MIL, but fanned 8 in 6.2 IP. Took ND in the 4-3 walk-off loss. Was walked twice for the first time in his career, scoring once.
- ◆ Won his 3rd-straight start on 7/3 start vs. MIL, tossing 5.0 innings while scattering nine hits allowing two runs in a 9-8 Cardinals win.
- ◆ Won his second-straight start, 8-4, on 6/28 at KC allowing four runs (3ER) over 6.0 IP.
- ◆ Snapped a career-high seven-game losing streak (4/28-6/17) in his 6/22 start at CHI, the longest loss streak in MLB this season. Made 10 starts during the streak, 5 quality, with a 5.22 ERA (34 ER/58.2 IP).
- ◆ Was the first Cardinals pitcher to suffer seven straight losses since Tyler Lyons (6/2/13-5/16/2015) over 10 starts/20 games.
- ◆ Snapped losing streak with first win since April 23 in his start at Wrigley, 6/22, a 7-2 Cards win to complete a 3-game sweep of the Cubs. Lasted 6.2 innings and allowed only 3 hits and 2 runs - a 2-run HR by W. Contreras in the 7th inning with one out.
