**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The NL West-leading Giants host the Milwaukee Brewers for game two of this three-game series...the Giants are a season-high 13 games over .500 and enter tonight a season-best 6.0 games ahead of the second-place Dodgers in the division...San Francisco has won their last three games and six of their last 10.

**TWO IS FEW:** LHP Madison Bumgarner, who enters tonight's outing with the third-lowest ERA in the NL behind Clayton Kershaw (1.52) and Jake Arrieta (1.86), has limited the opposition to two earned runs or fewer in each of his last 10 starts, the longest such streak by a Giant since Juan Marichal went 11-straight from Sept. 30, 1965-May 26, 1966.

**ONE IS FEWER:** Bumgarner hasn't allowed more than one run in his last six starts and could become the first Giants starter to allow one or fewer runs in seven consecutive starts since Bill Swift did it Sept. 17, 1993-April 15, 1994 (seven).

**HOT SINCE MID-MAY:** The Giants are a MLB-best 22-8 (.733) since May 11.

**STARTING HAS BEEN STRONG:** Since May 11, Giants starting pitchers have gone 14-4 with a 2.21 ERA (46er, 187.1ip)...SF's starting staff has posted a 3.47 ERA overall this season, the fourth-best in the NL behind Chicago (2.34), New York (3.22) and Washington (3.25).

**HOME COOKING:** The Giants have won nine of their last 11 games here at AT&T Park and are 20-13 (.594) at home overall, which is the third-best home record among NL teams behind Chicago (22-8, .733) and Washington (19-11, .633).

**VS. THE BREWERS:** The Giants have won seven of their last eight games against the Brewers at AT&T Park, having outscored them by a 57-21 margin.

**GETTING ON BASE: IF Brandon Belt** has reached base safely (via hit, walk or HBP) in each of his last 24 home games (22 hits and 17 walks)...Belt owns a .412 on-base pct. at AT&T Park during this span.

**HOT AT HOME: IF Matt Duffy**, went 3-for-4 last night to extend his home hitting streak to 13 games, during which he's batting .388 (19-for-49)...Duffy has hit safely in 25 of 33 games at AT&T Park this season and enters tonight's game with the third-highest home batting average in the National League at .355.

**WHERE'S THE POWER?: C Buster Posey** and **IF Brandon Belt** are tied for the Giants' team lead with eight home runs this season...this is the lowest home run total for any Major League player leading his team.

**ONE RUNWINS:** The Giants are 15-7 (.682) in one-run games this season...SF's 15 wins in one-run games are tied with the Phillies for the most in the big leagues.

**PAGAN REHAB STINT: OF Angel Pagan** (left hamstring strain) has gone 4-for-11 (.364) with a double and two RBI in three rehab games with triple-A Sacramento...Pagan is expected to join the Giants today and could be reinstated from the disabled list this series.

**SELLOUT STREAK AT AT&T PARK:** The Giants have sold out their last 441 regular season games at AT&T Park (dating back to Oct. 1, 2010 vs. San Diego)...the Giants' sellout streak is the longest active home streak in the Majors.

#### This Date in Giants History: June 14, 1979

**Willie McCovey** hit his 513th home run off Dennis Lamp, establishing him as the National League all-time left-handed home run leader, but the Chicago Cubs defeated the Giants, 8-6, at Candlestick Park.

#### MANAGER BRUCE BOCHY

**Bruce Bochy** is in his 10th season at the helm of the Giants...his only predecessors to reach double figures were **John McGraw** (1902-32), **Bill Terry** (1932-41) and **Dusty Baker** (1993-2002)...SF has posted a 790-733 (.519) record during his 10-year tenure...his 1,741 victories are the highest total by an active manager and rank 16th on the all-time list...Bochy is one of 10 managers in ML history to win three World Series titles...the other nine are in the Hall of Fame.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#40 LHP Madison Bumgarner**  
**6-5, 248, 27 years old (August 1, 1989)**  
**7-2 Record, 1.88 ERA**

- Three-time NL All-Star will make his 14th start of the season...is 7-2 with a 1.88 ERA, 99 strikeouts and 25 walks in 13 starts...SF is 10-3 in his outings this year, winning each of his last nine trips to the hill.
- Enters today's start riding a six-game winning streak, which matches his career-high (also: May 4-June 5, 2014)...is 6-0 with a 1.14 ERA (8er, 63.0ip), one complete game, 70 strikeouts and just 17 walks in his last nine starts...opponents are hitting just .188 off him during this span.
- A win today and he would have the longest winning streak of any Giants starter in a single season since **Barry Zito** won seven in a row from Aug. 7-Oct. 2, 2012.
- Has limited the opposition to two earned runs or fewer in each of his last 10 starts, the longest such streak by a Giant since **Juan Marichal** went 11-straight from Sept. 30, 1965-May 26, 1966...**Ferdie Schupp** owns the longest streak since 1913 with 16 such starts from July 13, 1916-May 17, 1917.
- Last pitched Wednesday vs. Boston, matching up with LHP David Price...tossed 6.0 innings and allowed one run (solo HR to ChrisYoung) on four hits of the Giants' 2-1 win.
- Has gone 6-2 with a 2.25 ERA (15er, 60.0ip) in nine career starts against the Brewers...has allowed three earned runs or fewer in all nine outings and has won each of his last three outings, going 3-0 with a 3.71 ERA (7er, 17.0ip).
- Is averaging 106.2 pitches per start, the second-most in the NL behind teammate **Johnny Cueto** (106.7).
- Over his last eight starts, opponents are 1-for-32 (.031) in at-bats with runners in scoring position...in fact, they are hitless in their last 28 at-bats off him.
- Has already walked 25 batters this season after issuing 39 walks all of last year.
- Has allowed just four extra base hits to left-handed batters this season...lefties are 10-for-66 (.152) off him with 24 strikeouts.
- Has not allowed a run in the first inning in any of his last 10 starts dating back to April 20.
- For every batter that Bumgarner strikes out this season, Carhartt will donate \$500 to "Helmets to Hardhats," a program assisting military vets transitioning to civilian life...so far his 99 strikeouts this year has generated \$49,500.

**NOTES:** Bumgarner and Noah Syndergaard are the only pitchers in the big leagues with two home runs this season... his 13 career home runs are the most of any active pitcher...his five RBI this year is tied for the fifth-most in the NL...Bumgarner has 29 RBI over the last three seasons...next-most as a P: Mike Leake 14.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP JOHNNY CUETO**  
**2016: 9-1, 2.16 ERA / Career: 105-71, 3.22 ERA**

**NOTES:** 30-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 14th start of the season...has gone 9-1 with a 2.16 ERA, three complete games, 81 strikeouts and 19 walks in 13 starts...signed a six-year contract (through 2021) with SF this offseason (December 16)...the Giants are 11-2 in his outings this season...last started this past Friday vs. Los Angeles-NL and received a no-decision in the Giants' 3-2 loss...tossed 8.0 innings, allowing two runs on three hits with eight strikeouts... allowed one his runs to score on a balk in the first inning...has gone 10-3 with a 2.79 ERA (39er, 126.0ip) in 19 starts against the Brewers... he's won his last seven starts against Milwaukee, going 7-0 with a 1.73 ERA (10er, 52.0ip) in that stretch.
