TONIGHT'S GAME: The Cardinals open a 3-game series tonight with the Pittsburgh Pirates, as they begin a six-game homestand (PIT-3, MIL-3) against a pair of rivals from the NL Central... it's just the 2nd home stand of the season for the Redbirds who closed out an 11-game (2-1 at MIL, 2-2 at WSH, 1-3 at NYM) roadtrip yesterday afternoon with a 4-1 loss to the Mets at Citi Field...first pitch tonight is 7:15 p.m. CDT... tonight's promotional giveaway is 2013 N.L. Champions pennant flag.

MIKE MATHENY: Mike Matheny, who in 2012 became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history, took his team to the World Series in his second season at the helm with a league-best 97-win season in 2013...in 2012, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Championship round of the playoffs...he is the first Cardinals manager to lead his teams to the postseason in each of his first two seasons, having already managed 30 postseason games in his first two seasons...Matheny, 43, had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252) and for consecutive errorless chances (1,565)...he will serve as the N.L. Manager for this year's MLB All-Star Game in Minneapolis, MN.

THIS DATE IN STL HISTORY, 1902: Outfielder Homer Smoot hits a pair of inside-the-park homers in the Cardinals 9-8 win at Cincinnati. Smoot would finish the season tied with George Barclay for the team lead in home runs with three. The Cardinals as a team would hit a total of just 10 home runs on the year.

BIRD WATCHING: The 2013 National League Champion St. Louis Cardinals have entered their 123rd season of play in the National League...the Cardinals went 5-6 on their just-completed 11-game road trip, losing 4 of the last 5, including the last two...the Cardinals are currently in 2nd place in the N.L. Central, 4-1/2 games back of Milwaukee and 1/2-game in front of 3rd place Cincinnati.

BACK AT BUSCH: The Cardinals have played just six home games out of their first 23, the fewest of all Major League teams...the Pirates meanwhile have played an MLB co-leading 14 home games.

BUT NOT FOR LONG: The Cardinals will not be home for too long, as they embark on a 9-game, 10-day roadtrip to CHI, ATL & PIT following this 6-game home stand, continuing a stretch that has them away from home for 20 of 26 games...the Cards are home for 19 of 22 games beginning May 12.

THE YEAR WAS 1927: The last time the MLB schedule makers had the Cardinals on the road for 26 of their first 38 games, as they will be this season, was in 1927...the Cards were away for 21 of their first 38 games last season, going 14-7 in those 21 road contests...in 1921, the Redbirds played 31 of their first 38 as the visitors.

STRIKE (OUT) FORCE: Lance Lynn recorded 9 strikeouts in his first ever April defeat yesterday (he's now 12-1 career in April) and upped the strikeout total for the Cardinals starting staff to a Major League best 143...Cardinals pitchers have fanned 9 or more batters in 10 of their first 23 contests.

CALLING ALL-STARS: MLB announced the official player ballott for the All-Star game today...Cardinals Manager Mike Matheny and his staff will lead this year's N.L. Stars...Yadier Molina, who led all N.L. vote-getters last season (6.8 million), and is a five-time All-Star, is one of seven current Cardinals (Carpenter, Craig, Holliday, Lynn, Molina, Peralta, Wainwright) who were previous All-Stars.

MOLINA STREAKING: Yadier Molina carries a team season-best 14-game hitting streak (.444 BA) into tonight's game, the N.L.'s 3rd-longest hit streak this season and one game shy of his career-best 15-gamer in 2007...**CHASING PAPPY:** The last Cardinals catcher with a hit streak of more than 15 games was Erik Pappas (16 games in 1993), who currently serves as the Hitting Coach for Springfield (AA)...Walker Cooper in 1944 hit in 20-straight, the longest all-time hit streak by a Redbirds receiver.

⇒ Had 2-2Bs Sun. at WSH...his 8 2Bs T4th in NL...had season-best 3 RBI last Thu. at WSH...multi-H in 4 of last 9 starts; is T1st in NL w/10 multi-hit G's...batting .394 on balls in play (T10th NL)...27 H (T8th in NL)...hit team-high 4 HRs & 11 RBI in Spring.

#8 PETER BOURJOS: Streak: 0-12 Series: 0-4, .000 Roadtrip: 1-14, .071
⇒ 7 of his 8 H's have come at Busch, incl. 3-2B's & 1-3B...was 1st RH hitting CFer to start OD for STL since B.Jordan in '97.

#13 MATT CARPENTER: Streak: 0-4 Series: 7-18, .389 Roadtrip: 13-41, .317
⇒ Had 1st career 4-hit game on Wed. at NYM...is T5th among MLB leadoff batters w/9 RBI...set Busch Std. III single-season hits record in '13 (112)...led NL w/199 Hits, 55 2B in '13...4th in '13 MVP & won NL Silver Slugger...signed 6-yr contract ext. this spring.

#21 ALLEN CRAIG: Streak: 0-4 Series: 3-17, .176 Roadtrip: 10-43, .233, HR
⇒ Has .333 BA (9-27) 7th inn. or later...has hit in the #2 spot 3 times, incl. 4/15 for 1st time since 4/24/13...suffered left foot injury 9/4/13 at CIN, missing final 22 games of reg. season & both DS & NLCS...batted .454 w/RISP in '13.

#48 TONY CRUZ: Streak: 2G (3-7, .429) Series: 1-3, .333 Roadtrip: 5-12, .417
⇒ Batting .455 (5-11) w/3 RBI in his 3 starts...had RBI yest. at NY & 2 RBI last Sat at WSH...batted .357 (10-28) w/RISP in '13.

#33 DANIEL DESCALSO: Streak: 0-4 Series: 1-5, .200 Roadtrip: 1-12, .083
⇒ Hit 9th-inn. RBI-2B on Wed. at NYM...had 2 H, incl. 2B on 4/12 vs. CHI in 1st GS at SS...Cards were 50-28 in his GS in '13.

⇒ Has started 5 of his 7 games played...activated fr. 15-day DL (L knee tendinitis) 4/15...signed as free agent 12/16/13.

⇒ Ranks 3rd in all-time hits (387; .316 BA) at Busch III, 2nd in HR's (66)...had 3 hits & BB on Tue. at NYM, his 1st 3-H game of yr...hit HR #1 on 4/15 at MIL...reached base all 4 PAs 4/13 vs. CHI (2BB, 2H)...has 4 GWRBI this yr. (2nd in NL), 55 since 2010.

#19 ION JAY: Streak: 3G (4-10, .400) Series: 4-13, .308 Roadtrip: 12-34, .353, HR
⇒ Has .346 BA (37-107) since 9/15/13, 7th in NL (min. 100 AB's)...owns .412 BA (7-17) in 7th inn. or later...his 2 run-1B was GWRBI on Tue. at NY...had 2 off bench last Fri, 1st PH (1-5 as PH)...has hits in 10 of 12 starts (.295; 13-44) w/9 RBI.

#4 YADIER MOLINA: Streak: 14G (24-54, .444, HR) Series: 5-12, .417 Roadtrip: 13-32, .406
⇒ Ranks 4th (.367) in NL batting...his 14G hit streak is T3rd in NL for '14...multi-H's in 8 of last 12 G's...was 3-3 on Wed., w/2 2Bs...started 10th straight Season Opener, most by a Card since T. Simmons (1971-80)...hit 3rd career Opening Day HR, tying S. Musial for most in STL team history...finished 3rd in NL MVP vote in '13, collecting 6th-str. Gold Glove & 1st Silver Slugger.

#27 JHONNY PERALTA: Streak: 0-21 Series: 0-9, .000 Roadtrip: 7-37, .189, 2HR
⇒ Has 7 XBH among his 11 hits...his HR 4/14 at MIL was GWRBI; hit 2R-HR 4/15 at MIL...Cards 8th diff. OD SS in 8 yrs.

#43 SHANE ROBINSON: Streak: 1G (1-4, .250) Series: 1-5, .200 Roadtrip: 1-12, .083
⇒ Has made 2 starts in RF...had team's 1st PH 4/13 vs. CHI, snapping 0-10 by STL PHERs...used as PHER in 10 of 23 games.

#16 KOLTEN WONG: Streak: 1G (2-3, .667) Series: 2-8, .250 Roadtrip: 4-21, .190
⇒ Snapped 0-10 skid with 2H yest. at NYM...had 2H & RBI on 4/17 at WSH & his 1st multi-K G of '14...has just 9 K's in 72 PA...had 2-run 3B on 4/8 vs. CIN for 1st career RBI...leads team w/3 SB's in 3 ATT...had team-high 18 hits, 10 runs & 5 2B's in Spring.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

SHELBY MILLER • RHP • 6-3 • 195 • 23 yrs • #40

⇒ Makes his 5th start of 2014 & his 2nd of the year vs. PIT on Friday.
 ⇒ Went 1-0, 0.79 ERA, allowing just one run, in his 2 starts (11.1 IP) on recent roadtrip (at MIL, at WSH) while striking out 14 total.
 ⇒ Took ND in his start on Sun. (4/20) at WSH, working 5.1 ShO IP in Cards' 3-2 walk-off loss to the Nationals.
 ⇒ Went 0-4, 5.32 ERA in his 4 GS vs. PIT last season and owns a career mark of 0-5, 5.93 ERA in 5 G's (27.1 IP) vs. the Buccos, allowing 9 HR's while striking out 23.
 ⇒ Suffered 12-2 loss 4/4 at PIT, allowing 5 runs (3 via solo HRs) in 5.1 IP. That start was delayed 1:05 by rain at the start and it was his first game against MLB competition since March 24.
 ⇒ Earned his 1st win of 2014 in start #3 on 4/15 at MIL. Allowed only 3H, 1R, 3BB with 7K in the 6-1 win.
 ⇒ Lost each of his 1st two starts to begin the season. It marked just the 2nd time in his young career to lose back-to-back games; the other time 6/22 vs. TEX & 6/28 at OAK last season.
 ⇒ Pitched a quality start (6.0IP, 7H, 3R) 4/9 vs. CIN, but suffered the loss as the team was shutout 4-0 (6.0IP, 7H, 3R, 3BB, 5K).
 ⇒ Started 3/29 at Jupiter, Fla. in a minor league Spring Training game for Springfield (AA) against New Orleans (Miami/AAA).
 ⇒ Was 1-2, 5.93 ERA in 4 Spring starts, fanning 13 in his 13.2 IP.
 ⇒ Finished 3rd in NL Rookie of Year voting in 2013 to J. Fernandez and Y. Puig. He topped all MLB rookies with 15 wins.
 ⇒ 2013 All-Rookie selection by *Baseball Digest* & *Baseball America*.
 ⇒ His 15 W's were most by STL rookie since Dick Hughes' 16 in 1967.
 ⇒ Was 1st STL rookie to start 30+ games since 2000 (Ankiel).
 ⇒ His 169 K's ranked 3rd on STL single-season rookie list.
 ⇒ Was one of 18 pitchers (6/6 vs. ARI) to hit a homer last season.
 ⇒ Appeared in one PS game, throwing 1.0 IP of relief vs. PIT in D.S.
 ⇒ Was 10-3, 1.75 ERA at Busch & 5-6, 4.57 ERA on road.
 ⇒ He was first STL rookie to win 10 or more home games since Jaime Garcia in 2010.
