## PITTSBURGH PIRATES (9-14) vs. ST. LOUIS CARDINALS (12-11) APRIL 25, 2014 AT BUSCH STADIUM --- GAME #24, ROAD #10 RHP GERRIT COLE (2-1, 3.67 ERA) vs. RHP SHELBY MILLER (1-2, 3.57 ERA)

**THE PIRATES...** have gone 2-6 in their last eight games and 3-11 in their last 14 after going 6-3 in their first nine games...Began the season with a 2-0 record for the first time since 2010...Also began the season with back-to-back extra inning games for the first time since 1964 and posted consecutive walkoff wins to start a season for the first time in club history...Were 13-10 after 23 games in 2013 (14-10 after 24).

**THE MVP:** **Andrew McCutchen** is 8-for-13 in his last four games and 19-for-51 (.373) with five doubles, four homers and 10 RBI in his last 13 games dating back to April 12...He has raised his average from .194 following the game on April 11 to .299 coming into today.

**ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER:** Right-handed pitcher **Gerrit Cole** is making his fifth start of the season tonight after working a career-high 8.0 innings in a no-decision in his last start Sunday vs. Milwaukee...Cole has posted a 5-2 record and 3.34 ERA (59.1ip/22er) in nine career starts against the National League Central since breaking into the big leagues last season.

**BACK TO BUSCH:** Tonight is the first time the Pirates will play in St. Louis since the fifth and deciding game of the 2013 National League Division Series (Gerrit Cole also started that game for the Bucs)...The Pirates are scheduled to return to St. Louis two more times this year (July 7-10 for a four-game series and for three games from September 1-3).

**ROOKIE BALL:** **Brandon Cumpton** had his 20.0 inning scoreless streak dating back to last season come to an end yesterday after allowing a pair of runs in the sixth inning...It was the longest scoreless streak by a Pirates rookie since **Zach Duke** tossed 22.0 scoreless frames in 2005.

**FEELING AT HOME:** **Jose Tabata** has hit safely in 24 of his 26 games at Busch with a plate appearance, going 35-for-108 (.324)...**Andrew McCutchen** has a .343 (37-for-108) lifetime batting average here at Busch Stadium, including a .364 clip (8-for-22) in his last six games.

**THIS SERIES:** The Pirates have posted a 12-10 record against the RedBirds since the beginning of last season...In those 22 games, the Bucs have outscored the Cards 100-96...Earlier this month at PNC Park from April 4-6, Pittsburgh took two of three games from the Cards while scoring a season-high 12 runs in the April 4 contest.

**HITTIN' THE ROAD:** Tonight the Pirates are scheduled to begin a six-day, five-game road trip...In addition to this three game series in St. Louis, Pittsburgh will also visit Baltimore beginning Tuesday night (off day Monday)...The Bucs have gone 3-6 on the road this season.

**CENTRAL PARK:** This is the final three games of a stretch that has Pittsburgh playing each of its first 26 games of the season within the division...The Pirates will return to action against the Central two weeks from tonight when St. Louis makes its second visit of the season to Pittsburgh.

**WHAT TO WATCH FOR:** Earlier this month Pirates catcher **Russell Martin** went 3-for-7 with three RBI in two games against the Cardinals at PNC Park...Last season Martin hit six homers against the RedBirds, which was the most by any player in the big leagues...In 2012, Pittsburgh's **Pedro Alvarez** went deep seven times against St. Louis, which was also the most by any player in the Majors.

**EARLY YARD WORK:** The Pirates have homered in four of their last five games and have 28 home runs so far this season, which is tied for the most among all National League clubs...The Bucs hit a total of 26 homers during the month of April last season...The club record for most home runs hit in March/April is 33, set in 1996.

**THE PITTSBURGH KID:** **Neil Walker** went 2-for-3 with a walk and run scored yesterday and is now 8-for-22 (.364) in his last five games...Walker is one of two second basemen in the big leagues to hit six home runs this year (also Minnesota's Brian Dozier).

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** First baseman **Stetson Allie** of the Double-A Altoona Curve hit his fourth home run in three games last night to increase his league lead to six...Allie also leads the Eastern League in RBI (16), ranks second in slugging percentage (.702) and third in OPS (1.122)...Triple-A outfielder **Gregory Polanco** fell a triple shy of hitting for the cycle last night while raising his average to an International League leading .420 on the season.

**KEEPING THEM CLOSE:** The Pirates have posted a 7-5 record in their 12 one-run games this season and 16 of Pittsburgh's first 23 games have been decided by two runs or less...The Pirates have gone 3-1 in one-run games on the road this season, losing for the only time on April 12 at Milwaukee.

**A YEAR WITHOUT A LONG BALL:** Bucco reliever **Mark Melancon** has the longest current streak of innings pitched without allowing a home run (74.0ip) among all Major League pitchers...He surrendered his only home run last season on April 14; a solo shot to Cincinnati's Joey Votto at PNC Park.

**FOUR SCORE:** The Pirates are 7-3 this season when scoring four or more runs in a game; they went 69-17 in such games last year.

### ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

April 25, 2011: Pedro Alvarez homered in both games of Pittsburgh's doubleheader split against Colorado at PNC Park, becoming the first Pittsburgh player in the last 22 seasons to hit home runs for the Pirates in two games played on the same day. The other player to do that for the Bucs over that span was Rob Mackowiak on 5/28/04.

**FRANCISCO LIRIANO:** The 30-year-old lefthander will be making his sixth start of the season tomorrow afternoon...Had a no decision (7.0ip/5r/4er) in his last start Monday vs. Cincinnati in a 6-5 walkoff win at PNC Park...Started the Season Opener and pitched 6.0 scoreless innings in a no-decision vs. Chicago...Lost each of his next three starts from 4/5-16 after receiving a total of three runs of support when he was in the game...Has worked at least 6.0 innings in each of his first five starts...Was named the N.L. Comeback Player-of-the-Year in 2013 after going 16-8 with a 3.02 ERA.

**vs. ST.
