## MAKING A CASE FOR #MVP

♦ **Paul Goldschmidt** is tied for ninth in the Majors (also: Corey Seager) with a 5.6 WAR behind Jose Altuve (7.0), Anthony Rendon (6.7), Aaron Judge (6.5), Joey Votto (6.4), Charlie Blackmon (6.3), Kris Bryant (6.2), Giancarlo Stanton (6.0) and Jose Ramirez (5.7) [source: FanGraphs.com].

♦ He ranks among NL leaders in RBI (2nd, 115), home runs (T-3rd, 35), extra-base hits (4th, 71), walks (4th, 88), total bases (4th, 304), AVG with RISP (5th, .376), OBP (5th, .414), OPS (6th, .998), SLG (7th, .585) and AVG (10th, .308).

♦ Goldschmidt's numbers through his first 144 games this season and in his NL MVP runner-up campaigns in 2013 and '15:

## HERE'S THE STORY...

♦ The D-backs are 20-6 (.769) in their last 26 games, the second-best winning percentage in the Majors since August 21, behind the Indians (.893; 25-3).

♦ The D-backs' 87 wins through 149 games are tied for the third most in club history (also: 2011), behind the 2002 (92) and 1999 (90) teams.

♦ **Patrick Corbin**, who is 6-1 with a 2.12 ERA (11 ER in 46.2 IP) in his last 7 starts, needs 1 win to set a career high.

♦ **J.D. Martinez** is hitting .424 (25-for-59) with 11 homers and 22 RBI over his last 14 games.

♦ **A.J. Pollock** is 9-for-23 (.391) with 5 doubles, 1 home run and 10 RBI over his last 6 games.

## YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- ♦ The D-backs lost the series finale @ Giants, 7-2.
- ♦ **J.D. Martinez** hit his 40th home run of the season, a 2-run shot off Chris Stratton in the sixth inning.
- ♦ **Chris Iannetta** went 3-for-4.
- ♦ **Taijuan Walker** suffered the loss (4 ER in 5.0 IP).

## MARTINEZ WINS FOURTH WEEKLY AWARD OF SEASON

♦ **J.D. Martinez** (.435, 3 HR, 6 RBI, 1,427 OPS) was named NL Player of the Week for the second consecutive week and fourth time this season, the first player since the award began in 1973 (1975 for AL) to claim 4 weekly awards in a single season.

- ♦ The D-backs' 9-game road winning streak, which tied the club record (also: Aug. 3-17, 2002), ended yesterday @ Giants.

## WINNING WAYS VS. WEST - PART ONE

- ♦ For the second time in team history, the D-backs are assured of winning records vs. each team in the NL West (also: 2001):
- **2017 VS. NL WEST:** COL - 11-8; LAD - 11-8; SD - 10-6 (with 3 games remaining); SF - 10-6 (with 3 games remaining).
- **2001 VS. NL WEST:** COL - 13-6; LAD - 10-9; SD - 12-7; SF - 10-9.

## WINNING WAYS VS. WEST - PART DUEX

- ♦ Arizona is 42-28 vs. NL West this season, the fifth-most, intra-divisional victories in club history:
- **MOST D-BACKS WINS VS. NL WEST:** 45 - 2001; 44 - 2008; 43 - 2002 & 2011; **42 - 2017.**
- ♦ Arizona is 17-5 in its last 22 games vs. NL West opponents.

## WINS, WINS AND MORE WINS

- ♦ The D-backs are 1 of 3 teams to feature 3 pitchers with 14+ wins (**Patrick Corbin**, **Zack Greinke** and **Robbie Ray**)...the Indians (Trevor Bauer, Carlos Carrasco and Corey Kluber) and Nationals (Gio Gonzalez, Max Scherzer and Stephen Strasburg) are the only other teams to accomplish the feat.
- ♦ There are 20 teams in the Majors without a 14+ game winner.
