TODAY'S GAME: The Cardinals continue their 10-game/11-day road trip (NYM 2-1, MIA 2-1, CIN 3) with the final game of four against the Miami Marlins today in the Cardinals lone visit to Marlins Park this season...the Cardinals are in the midst of 17 games over a 17-day stretch, matching their 2nd-longest consecutive games/days log on the 2016 schedule (also 6/24-7/10); St. Louis will play 20 games over a 20-day stretch from 9/2-21.

LAST GAME: The Marlins shutout the Cardinals 11-0, as St. Louis matched their largest loss margin of 2016...Jaime Garcia lasted 3.1 innings on short rest, allowing six runs in the loss...Kolten Wong recorded two hits and Yadier Molina stretched his hit streak to a team season-high 14 games with a double.

START ME UP: Since July 1, the St. Louis starting rotation paces Major League Baseball in wins (13), 3rd in strikeouts (137) & win percentage (.684), T4th in fewest losses (6) and 4th in innings pitched (152.0)...last Sunday (7/24 vs. LAD) marked the first and only time all season St. Louis has used a starting pitcher who was not a part of the team's starting five on Opening Day...only the Chicago Cubs have used a 6th starter just one other time, while Toronto Blue Jays have done so twice.

MIKE MATHENY: Mike Matheny is in his 5th season as the Cardinals manager, having taken his teams to the postseason in each of his first four seasons, the only manager in MLB history to do so...Mike has managed 43 postseason games, and has 21 postseason wins since 2012, 3rd-most wins among current Major League managers...in 2012 Matheny became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history and in 2013 he took his team to the World Series in just his second season at the helm with a league-best 97-wins...in 2014, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Central title and their 4th-straight trip to the NLCS...he led an injury-riddled team in 2015 to 100 wins, the best in the majors, and the N.L. Central Division title for a 3rd-straight season...Matheny, 45, had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252).

❑ **REDBIRD RUNDOWN:** The 2015 N.L. Central Champion St. Louis Cardinals are in their 125th season of play in the National League...St. Louis enters tonight in second place, 3.0 games ahead of PIT and 6.5 games behind first-place CHI in the N.L. Central...the Cardinals are 17-13 in their last 30 games, 13-7 in last 20, 6-4 in their last 10 & 3-2 in their last five...St. Louis' 16 July wins lead the Majors...St. Louis holds a +90 run-differential, 3rd in MLB behind the CHI (+163) & WSH (+114).

❑ **SHUTOUT LOSSES:** Last night's 11-0 loss to the Marlins was the largest shutout loss for St. Louis since falling 11-0 to the Reds last September 10 at Great American Ball Park...it was the 5th shutout loss for the team this season...the team won and lost 15 games via shutout in 2015 (15-15).

❑ **ONE STEP CLOSER:** St. Louis will send shortstop Jhonny Peralta and infielder Matt Carpenter on rehab assignments today...Peralta will begin his rehab assignment at High-A Palm Beach while Matt Carpenter will play at Double-A Springfield...Peralta injured a ligament in his left thumb and has been on the disabled list since July 18 after starting the season on the D.L. (4/2-6/7, surgery left thumb ligament during spring training)...Carpenter injured his right oblique taking a swing on July 6 and has been on the D.L. since July 7...outfielder Brandon Moss is currently at Springfield on rehab and has played in two games (0-5, walk) recovering from a left ankle sprain.

❑ **MOLINA STREAKS:** Yadier Molina extended his hitting streak to a team high 14 games yesterday with a double in the 4th inning and is one game shy of his career high 15-game streak in 2014 (4/7-25)...his 2014 streak is the last time a Cardinals had a streak at least 14 games long and the last time a St. Louis player had a longer streak was David Freese's 20 game streak in 2013 (5/17-6/11)...Yadi is hitting .385 (20-52) during his current streak with seven doubles and two home runs, with five multi-hit games.

❑ **WONG HITS:** Kolten Wong has gone 5-9 over his last two games at Miami and his hitting .278 (25-90) since his return from an option to Triple-A on June 18 (.222, 28-126 prior).

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

#18 CARLOS MARTINEZ • RHP • 6-0 • 191 • 24 yrs

TODAY'S GAME:

- ◆ Is making his 20th start of the season and 57th career start.
- ◆ Tied for 8th in the National League with 10 wins.
- ◆ Earned the win in Game 1 of a DH at NY Mets last Tuesday (7/26), a 3-2 team win. Martinez threw 106 pitches in 5.0 innings.
- ◆ Leads STL with nine starts of 7.0 innings or more (6-1, 1.49 ERA).
- ◆ Has only allowed three extra base hits to a right-handed batter this season (1 HR, 2 2B); his .186 OPP AVG bs. RHP ranks 5th in MLB.
- ◆ Leads ML with .211 opp. SLG pct. vs. RHP. It currently is the 10th-lowest single-season mark in MLB history (TOR's Mark Eichhorn holds record of .165 mark, 1986).
- ◆ Limiting the opposition to a .164 average (11-for-67) in the 1st inning of starts, the 4th-lowest mark among NL starting pitchers.
- ◆ Leads all National League pitchers with 21 double plays induced, his new single-season high.
- ◆ Is 4-3 with a 2.91 ERA (52.2 IP), 55 strikeouts and .221 OPP AVG in 8 day starts this season.

VS. MIAMI MARLINS:

- ◆ Is facing the Marlins for the 1st time in 2016 and 3rd time in career.
- ◆ Faced the Fish in a pair of starts last season, going 1-1 with a 5.25 ERA (12.0) and 14 strikeouts.
- ◆ Is a lifetime 7-3 with a 2.93 ERA (73.2 IP) and 62 strikeouts in 24 career games (10 starts) against the N.L. East.

2016 SEASON & CAREER:

- ◆ Since dropping a career-high five in a row, is 6-1 with a 1.76 ERA (66.1 IP/13 ER) and 57 strikeouts in his last 10 starts (since 5/30) including three scoreless outings.
- ◆ Has allowed nine home runs in 119.1 innings, ranking 10th in the N.L. with 0.68 HR/9 IP.
- ◆ Has pitched 8.0 innings on three occasions (4/26 at ARI, 5/30 at MIL, 6/11 at PIT), T5th among N.L. pitchers in starts of 8.0 IP or more.
- ◆ Ranks 4th among MLB pitchers with a .263 BA and T4th with 10 hits.
- ◆ Despite stoppage for bloody nose, logged 7.0 IP in 4-2 win over SD in 1st game of DH on 7/20, winning his 2nd straight decision. Three of the 4 hits and both runs he allowed came in 1st inning.
- ◆ Won for the first time in five starts in a 8-1 win at MIL on 7/9 in his final start before the ASB. The Cardinals had lost his previous four starts (6/18-7/4) despite his 1.33 ERA (27.0 IP) in that span.
- ◆ Matched his career high with 11 strikeouts in his 7/9 win over MIL, allowing one run in 5.0 IP; snapped streak of seven quality starts.
