### St. Louis Cardinals (87-68) vs. Cincinnati Reds (71-84)

Game #156 ♦ Busch Stadium ♦ September 21, 2014

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Cardinals play the final regular season game tonight when they host the Cincinnati Reds...first pitch set for 7:05 p.m. CDT with national television coverage by ESPN...the Cardinals are hosting the Rockies (3-0), Brewers (2-1) and Reds (2-0) during this 9-game, 10-day stand...the first place Redbirds improved to 7-1 on the homestand with an 8-4 win last night...the Redbirds have gone 7-3 in their last 10 games and are 44-28 vs. NL Central clubs in 2014...the Cardinals are 14-5 in September, tops in the Majors along with Baltimore, and moved into sole possession of 1st place for the first time all season on Sept. 1... the club is 35-24 since the All-Star break, 2nd behind the Nationals (39) for the most wins since the ASB in the N.L. ...St. Louis travels to Chicago following tonight's game for the final regular season road-trip in which the team will play six games over seven days with three vs. the Cubs, followed by three in Arizona vs. the Diamondbacks.

**MIKE MATHENY:** Mike Matheny, who in 2012 became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history, took his team to the World Series in his second season at the helm with a league-best 97-win season in 2013...in 2012, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Championship round of the playoffs...he is the first Cardinals manager to lead his teams to the postseason in each of his first two seasons, having already managed 30 postseason games in his first two seasons...Matheny, 43, had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the N.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252) and once held MLB record for consecutive errorless chances (1,565)...he served as the N.L. Manager for the 85th MLB All-Star Game in Minneapolis, Minn.

**BIRD WATCHING:** The 2013 National League Champion St. Louis Cardinals are concluding their 123rd season of play in the National League...St. Louis stretched its win streak to four games with a 8-4 win last night, as Tony Cruz, Kolten Wong and Randal Grichuk homered. **STANDINGS SNAPSHOT:** St. Louis remains in 1st place in the N.L. Central, 3.5 games in front of 2nd place Pittsburgh with a Magic Number of 5 to clinch their 2nd-straight NL Central title...the Cardinals are three wins back of Washington (90) & one back of the LA Dodgers (88) for the top win total in the N.L. **POSTSEASON TICKET PUNCHED:** The Cardinals locked up their fourth-straight postseason appearance by virtue of Milwaukee's loss to Pittsburgh earlier today and are guaranteed a Wild Card berth at the very least.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** The Cardinals lost last Tuesday was their first at home in a Sept./Oct. game since 9/14/13 vs. SEA, snapping a 13-game win streak in Sept./Oct. home dates...despite that loss, the Cardinals are a remarkable 33-8 (.805 win pct.) in Sept/Oct. home dates since 2012, and they are a sizzling 23-3 (.885) dating to last season...the Cardinals notched their 24th season of 50 or more home wins on Friday...they had a Busch Stadium III home record 54 wins last season. **RED MENACE:** The Cardinals are 48-24 (.667 win pct.) against the Reds at Busch Stadium III, and they've now won eight straight home series against Cincinnati dating to 2011.

**MATHENY'S THREE-PEAT:** Mike Matheny (2012-14) has joined Ron Gardenhire (2002-04), Larry Dierker (1997-1999), Ralph Houk (1961-63) and Hughie Jennings (1907-09) as the only managers to have guided their teams to the postseason in each of their first three seasons (*Elias*).

**WINNING WITH LESS:** The Cards have won a franchise-best four games this season when collecting 4 hits or less and their 10 wins with 5 hits or fewer are the club's most since 1914 & 1915 (also 10 wins). (*Orf, SABR*). **KEEPING THE BROOM CLOSED:** The Cardinals are attempting to complete a full season without having been swept in a series of three or more games for the first time since 2005. (*Elias*)

## TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

**LANCE LYNN • RHP • 6-5 • 240 • 27 yrs • #31**

⇒ Is set to make his team-leading 32nd start of the season, one shy of his career best (33 in 2013); and 5th against the Reds in 2014.  
 ⇒ Has allowed 3 runs or less in 27 of 31 starts this season.  
 ⇒ Looking to join Adam Wainwright (2010 & 2012), Chris Carpenter (2010) and Shelby Miller (2013) as only Cardinals pitchers to post 10 wins at Busch Stadium III in a single-season; won 9 in 2012 & 2013.  
 ⇒ Is 3-1 with a 3.12 ERA in four starts this season vs. CIN. Won first three starts and is 2-0 with a 3.46 ERA in 2 starts at home vs. Reds.  
 ⇒ Has won each of his four home starts vs. the Reds at Busch Stadium (4-0, 2.25) in his career. Made one relief appearance at home vs. CIN (7/5/11) with 2.0 scoreless innings.  
 ⇒ Has career marks of 6-2, 3.66 ERA in 10 starts (13 app.) vs. CIN.  
 ⇒ Became the second pitcher in MLB, joining Max Scherzer, as one of 3 pitchers (Zack Greinke) with 15 wins in each of the last 3 seasons.  
 ⇒ Has 167 strikeouts this year and became the 16th MLB pitcher to strikeout 150 batters in each of the last three seasons.  
 ⇒ Posted a 9-3 record with a 2.39 ERA in 17 home starts this season. The nine home wins rank T4th in the N.L. and 2.39 ERA is 6th.  
 ⇒ Is 6-2 in 13 starts vs. NL Central clubs this season, 2.98 ERA with the two losses vs. Pittsburgh and Cincinnati.  
 ⇒ Compiled a 3-0 mark with 1.99 ERA (6th, NL) in August.  
 ⇒ The 3-0 mark in August 2014 joins April 2013 (4-0), July 2012 (3-0) and April 2012 (4-0) as months in which Lynn has gone undefeated with 3 or more wins.  
 ⇒ Ranks among N.L. pitchers in wins (15, T6th), ERA (2.68, 6th) and strikeouts (167, 16th). His 104.4 pitches/game, is 3rd most in N.L.  
 ⇒ Is 7-3 with a 1.89 ERA since 7/4, the top ERA on the Cards staff and 3rd-best in the N.L. (Kershaw, LA, 1.62; deGrom, NY, 1.81).  
 ⇒ Has allowed 2 earned runs or less in 12 of his last 14 starts (7/4-present) except for 3 runs 8/10 at BAL and 9/1 vs. PIT (3R, 1ER, 9/6).  
 ⇒ Has 2nd fewest home runs allowed/9 IP (0.42) in N.L. (Wainwright, 0.41). Seven of eight home runs allowed have come on the road.  
 ⇒ Has six scoreless starts this season; five 7.0 IP and one 6.2 IP.  
 ⇒ Is 27-11, 2.76 ERA in 56 career appearances/46 starts at Busch Std.  
 ⇒ STL is 61-34 in his 95 career games started.  
 ⇒ Tossed 7.0 innings allowing one run in a no decision, a game the Cardinals lost 3-2 in 12 innings vs. MIL (9/16), in his last start.  
 ⇒ Suffered 1-0 loss in his start at CIN 9/11, a complete game effort allowing a run in the bottom of the 8th, and only three hits.  
 ⇒ Earned win #15 at MIL 9/6 w/6.0 IP, 3 runs (1ER) in 5-3 win.
