PITTSBURGH PIRATES (12-12) vs. ST. LOUIS CARDINALS (17-6) MAY 3, 2015 AT BUSCH STADIUM --- GAME #25, ROAD #15 RHP VANCE WORLEY (2-2, 4.50 ERA) vs. RHP MICHAEL WACHA (4-0, 2.42 ERA)

THE PIRATES... have lost back-to-back games and four of their last five after winning five straight...Have gone 9-6 in their last 15 games...Matched their season high with 14 hits in Wednesday's 8-1 win in Chicago...Scored a season-high 10 runs on 4/12 in Milwaukee...Were 9-15 after 24 games last season (10-15 after 25).

HEADIN' HOME: Following today's tilt and a day off tomorrow, the Pirates are scheduled to begin a six-game homestand Tuesday night with the first of three games against the Reds...The Cardinals close out the homestand with three games next weekend...The Bucs have gone 6-4 at PNC Park this season and have won 107 home games since the start of the 2013 season; the second-highest win total among Major League teams at home behind St. Louis (114).

SEE YA NEXT WEEKEND: The Bucs and Birds will be meeting again next weekend in Pittsburgh, where the Pirates have gone 16-9 against the Cardinals since 2012...The Pirates have gone 13-5 and have posted a 2.65 ERA vs. St. Louis in the last 18 games played at PNC Park...On the flip side, the Pirates have gone 3-15 in their last 18 games played at Busch Stadium.

DAY GAMES: The Pirates have gone 5-3 in day games this season (3-0 at home and 2-3 on the road)...**Gregory Polanco** had two hits yesterday afternoon and is among the N.L. leaders with a .455 batting average in day games this season.

DAYDRO: Since the beginning of the 2012 season, **Pedro Alvarez** leads all National League players with 37 home runs hit during day games...He has hit three of his four home runs this season in games played prior to 5:00pm.

STEWIE: Bucco backstop **Chris Stewart** ranked third among National League players last year with a .319 batting average from the eighth spot of the lineup (min: 110 AB), trailing only Alcides Escobar (.330) and David Murphy (.328)...Stewart has three hits in his last six at bats and the Pirates have gone 4-0 this season in games that he has started...Behind the plate, Chris has posted a 1.18 catcher's ERA and has not had an earned run charged against his pitcher in his last 24.0 innings.

TURNING TWO: Pittsburgh's defense has turned 10 double plays in the last five games.

BEEN CAUGHT STEALING: The Pirates catchers and pitchers lead all Major League teams with 12 caught stealings...They have caught five of the last nine runners attempting to steal against them.

LIMITING THE LONG BALL: Bucco pitchers have gone 10 straight games and 92.0 consecutive frames without giving up a home run...The staff has surrendered just two home runs in the last 15 games, dating back to 4/17; the Cubs hit a pair of homers at PNC Park on 4/21...Among all Major League teams, the Pirates have given up the fewest amount of home runs (10), followed closely by the Cardinals (11).

PITCHING POWER: Entering today's action the Pittsburgh pitching staff ranks second in the Major Leagues in ERA (2.84), trailing only St. Louis (2.28)...In the last three games, the Bucco starting pitchers have been charged with just one earned run in 20.0 innings of work (0.45 ERA).

BUCS ON THE ROAD: The Pirates have gone 4-4 on this 10-day, nine-game road trip to Arizona (3-0), Chicago (1-2) and St. Louis (0-2)...The Bucs are 6-8 on the road so far this season.

ANGST BY THE ARCH: The Bucs went 2-8 at Busch Stadium last year and have gone 5-16 the past three seasons, winning their lone series in 2013 (April 26-28)...Since winning back-to-back games April 27-28, 2013, they have gone 3-15 in St. Louis...Pittsburgh's last three losses at Busch Stadium, and five of the last eight, have been of the walkoff variety.

1,002 & COUNTING: **Andrew McCutchen** collected his 1000th career hit Wednesday night, becoming the 33rd different Pittsburgh player to collect at least 1000 hits...His 1002 career hits rank 33rd on the all-time list, seven behind **Johnny Ray** and his 1009...**Jack Wilson** was the last player to pick up his first 1000 career hits in a Pittsburgh uniform, doing so in 2007.

A STARLING SHINING BRIGHTLY: With six home runs, **Starling Marte** is tied with Miami's Giancarlo Stanton and San Diego's Justin Upton for the league leader in homers among outfielders...Marte has hit safely in nine of his last 11 games, going 14-for-42 (.333) with three home runs and eight RBI.

SEAN ROD: **Sean Rodriguez** went 2-for-2 Friday night and has three hits in his last seven at bats overall...He has hit safely in all four of his starts, going 5-for-14 with a home run and two RBI...Rodriguez is batting .533 (8-for-15) against RHP, .417 (5-for-12) on the road, .444 (4-for-9) with runners on base and .800 (4-for-5) with two outs.

ON THE MARK: Bucco closer **Mark Melancon** has converted each of his last three save opportunities...With 54 career saves in a Pirates uniform, Melancon ranks ninth on the all-time list, two behind **Bill Landrum** (56).

THE BIG BULL BLASTING AWAY: With his next home run, **Pedro Alvarez** will tie Hall-of-Famer **Paul Waner** and former outfielder **Bill Robinson** for 17th place on Pittsburgh's all-time home run list with 109...**Bobby Bonilla** is 16th on the list with 114 and current Bucco outfielder **Andrew McCutchen** is 12th with 130.

ELEMENTARY FOR WATSON: Since the start of the 2012 season, Bucco All-Star **Tony Watson** leads all Major League left-handed relief pitchers in appearances (227)...He also leads N.L. lefty relievers in ERA (2.02) since 2013 and ranks second in the Majors in that time behind New York's Andrew Miller (1.97)...Watson has been scored upon just once in his last 12 games (13.1ip/6h/1r) and has made seven straight scoreless appearances on the road (7.1ip).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 3, 1985: The Pirates beat the Dodgers, 16-2, at Three Rivers Stadium, but the story of the night was the return of Pirates broadcaster Bob Prince to the radio booth. The 17,628 fans in attendance rose to their feet, chanting, "Gunner, Gunner." Prince began his play-by-play duties in the fourth inning, and the Pirates responded by shelling Rick Honeycutt and Tom Brennan for nine runs.

JEFF LOCKE: The 27-year-old lefthander will be making his fifth start of the season when he takes the mound vs. Cincinnati Tuesday night...His last start was a 6-2 loss to Travis Wood at Wrigley Field Tuesday (3.2ip/8h/6r/5er/3bb/5so)...His first two starts were both victories over the Brewers at PNC Park on 4/18 (8.0ip/1er) and in Milwaukee on 4/10 (6.0ip/2er)...Went 7-6 with a 3.91 ERA in 21 starts with the Pirates last year after winning a career-high 10 games in 2013...Was a 2013 N.L. All-Star and Pittsburgh's 2012 Minor League Pitcher-of-the-Year.

vs. CINCINNATI: 2-1 with a 2.75 ERA (36.0ip/11er) in seven career starts...Went 0-0 with a 2.19 ERA in two starts last season; was the victim of a blown save on 6/19 at PNC Park (Pirates won 4-3 in 12 innings) and another blown save on 7/11 at GABP (Pirates lost 6-5)...Has been charged with two earned runs or less in six of his seven career starts.
