PITTSBURGH PIRATES (59-56) vs. SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS (66-51)

AUGUST 15, 2016 at AT&T Park, San Francisco, CA --- GAME #116/ROAD #58

RHP RYAN VOGELSONG (1-2, 2.67 ERA) vs. LHP MATT MOORE (7-8, 3.99 ERA)

THE PIRATES... have won three of their last four games and six of their last nine...Have gone 22-15 in their last 37 games and have posted a 25-17 record since June 24 (the second-best record in the National League in that time)...Won a season-high seven straight games from 6/29 to 7/6...Were a season-high nine games over .500 following their win against the Rangers in Texas on 5/27 (28-19)...Were 69-46 after 115 games in 2015 (69-47 after 116).

A HOMECOMING OF SORTS: After spending the last five seasons (2011-2015) playing with the Giants, **Ryan Vogelsong** tonight is making his first appearance against his former club since 5/1/05 and his first start since 8/12/04 (both coming at PNC Park with the Pirates)...In addition to winning a career-high 14 games with the Giants in 2012, he captured World Series championships with San Francisco in 2012 and 2014 and was a National League All-Star in 2011.

"V" IS FOR VOGELSONG: **Ryan Vogelsong** is making his third start tonight since being reinstated from the 60-day disabled list; he gave up two unearned runs in 6.0ip vs. San Diego last Wednesday and one run in 6.0ip in Atlanta on 8/4...Vogelsong was on the D.L. with facial fractures since 5/24 after being hit in the left eye while batting on 5/23...In his four starts with the Pirates this season, Ryan has gone 0-1 with 18 strikeouts and a 0.95 ERA (19.0ip/2er).

MERCER MERCER ME!: **Jordy Mercer** has homered twice in his last three games and now has eight this season - four shy of his career-high of 12 set in 2014...Mercer is hitting .308 (32-for-104) against the teams from the N.L. West division this season, going 17-for-54 (.315) with three home runs in 12 games in the N.L. West ballparks.

THE BUCS BY THE BAY: The Pirates won all three games played in San Francisco last season, sweeping a three-game set here from June 1-3...The Bucs have gone 5-1 in their last six games played at AT&T Park and are 8-3 in their last 11.

DIALED IN AT AT&T: In 10 career games at AT&T Park, **Jordy Mercer** has gone 11-for-30 (.367) with four home runs and five RBI...He has homered in each of his last three starts in San Francisco while going 5-for-11 at the plate.

SOUTHPAW SUCCESS: The Pirates are facing a left-handed starter for the second straight day; they beat Brett Anderson at Dodger Stadium yesterday...Pittsburgh has posted a 17-8 record this season in games started by an opposing LHP, winning each of the last seven instances...**Josh Harrison** has gone 27-for-82 (.329) against lefthanders this season while left-handed hitting **Adam Frazier** has gone 7-for-11 in limited action against southpaws.

WALKING IN L.A.: The Bucco batters walked five times Sunday afternoon in Los Angeles after receiving a season-high 11 free passes on Saturday - the club's highest base on balls total in a game since 6/14/09 vs. Detroit (also 11).

AND THE WHIFF: LHP **Felipe Rivero** has recorded 13 strikeouts over his last seven appearances (7.0ip) and has punched out a total of 66 batters in 56.2 innings of work this season.

MARTE ON THE MOVE: **Starling Marte** recorded his 40th stolen base of the season Saturday afternoon and the 153rd of his career...Marte had a career-high 41 stolen bases in 2013 and is the first Pirates player with a pair of 40-SB seasons since **Tony Womack**, who had 60 steals in 1997 and 58 in 1998...Since the beginning of the 2012 season, Marte's 153 stolen bases rank third among all National League players.

STEWART ON REHAB: Catcher **Chris Stewart**, who has been on the disabled list since 7/2 with left knee discomfort began a rehab assignment with Double-A Altoona Friday night...He went 1-for-2 with a walk and an RBI while catching seven innings Friday night and 0-for-2 with a walk on Sunday while also playing seven innings.

GO WEST, YOUNG MAN: The Pirates have gone 19-11 against teams from the National League West division this season, which includes an 8-5 record on the road...Last year the Bucs went 27-6 against the N.L. West (14-3 on the road).

COMFORT ZONE: **Josh Harrison** has led off eight of the last nine games and has gone 13-for-35 (.371) with a homer and eight runs scored...In 14 games as the leadoff hitter this year, J-Hay is hitting .356 (21-for-59) with 12 runs scored...Harrison has produced a .308 (220-for-715) batting average, 14 homer, 56 RBI and 111 runs in 177 career games from the top spot.

FREESE WARNING: **David Freese** has gone 7-for-20 (.350) in his last six games and the Pirates have produced a 47-32 record in the 79 games he has started (34-21 at third base and 13-11 at first base).

DIGGING FOR GOLD: **Starling Marte** recorded his National League leading 13th outfield assist Friday night; he led the league with 16 outfield assists last season en route to capturing his first Rawlings Gold Glove award...**Jordy Mercer** leads all National League shortstops in fielding percentage (.989), having made five errors in 463 total chances...Dating back to 5/17, Mercer has made just one error (on 7/19) in his last 74 games.

IT'S ELEMENTARY: **Tony Watson** has earned five saves in six opportunities since assuming the closer's role on 7/30...Beginning with the action on 6/7, Watson has posted a 1.08 ERA (25.0ip/3er) and a .188 batting average against (16-for-85)...Since the start of the 2012 season, Watson leads all Major League left-handed pitchers with 341 appearances.

CUTCH CHASING BONDS: **Andrew McCutchen** ranks fifth on Pittsburgh's all-time home run list with 167; **Barry Bonds** is fourth with 176...In Pittsburgh's 130 seasons of play in the National League, only two right-handed batters have hit more home runs than McCutchen; Hall-of-Famers **Ralph Kiner** (301) and **Roberto Clemente** (240).

August 15, 1970: Light-hitting infielder Jose Pagan homered twice while going 4-for-4 with five RBI as the Pirates beat the Padres, 9-3, at Three Rivers Stadium. It was the third career two-homer game for Pagan, who homered just 52 times in over 1300 career games in the big leagues. Bill Mazeroski also homered and lefty Bob Veale struck out 12 batters while tossing a complete game.

Ryan underwent surgery to repair facial fractures on 6/2 (surgery performed at Allegheny General Hospital by Dr. Randall Beatty). In addition to his rehab starts listed in the next column, he threw 40 pitches in a simulated game on 7/1 at Oakland and 61 pitches (4.0 innings) in his second simulated game on 7/5 at St. Louis.
