HOMETOWN GLORY

» Cleveland beat Toronto by a score of 10-7 on Sunday afternoon at Progressive Field to earn a 4-game series split with the Blue Jays.
 » The Indians scored first on a solo HR by **JASON KIPNIS** (3) in the 3rd inning, but were quickly saddled with a 5-run deficit to overcome following Toronto's 6-run rally in the 4th...Cleveland responded with 9 runs over the club's next 3 turns at the plate (innings 4-5-6), putting up a 6-spot of their own in the 5th.
 » Kipnis collected a game-high 4 hits, his third career game w/ 4+ hits and one shy of his career-high...Kipnis was also one of 4 Indians to drive in a pair of runs...**MARC RZEPczynski** (1.0IP) was credited with his first win since June 4, 2012 at New York-NL - also his first as a member of the Indians...ended a streak of 166 relief appearances w/o a win.

TURNING TABLES

» Sunday marked the first time for the Indians to be involved in a game that included a rally of 6+ runs by the offense, as well as a rally of 6+ runs by their opponent, since April 17, 2012 at Seattle...the Mariners posted a 6-run rally in the bottom of the 4th, while the Indians responded with 7 runs in the top of the 5th on the way to a 9-8 victory at Safeco Field.
 » **Cleveland has now won 50 consecutive games in which the club's offense has had at least one single-inning rally of 6+ runs...** last loss when plating 6+ runs in an inning came back on April 11, 2008 vs. Oakland.

WINS & LOSSES

» At 9-15 (.375) and 6 games below the .500 mark, Cleveland is 7 wins shy of club's high-water mark this season (+1G, 2-1 on April 9) and sits one loss shy of the club's low-water mark (-7G, 3x).
 » Cleveland has won 2 of 3 and 3 of the club's last 5 games, but has still dropped 6 of last 9...Tribe is 7-10 since April 15...**the Indians are 6-2 when scoring first, but just 3-13 when their opponent draws first blood.**
 » The Indians are 3-14 when allowing 3-or-more runs in a game...**Cleveland has allowed 24 combined runs in the club's 9 wins (2.7RPG)** - pitching staff has posted a 2.56 ERA (81.0IP, 60H, 24R-23ER, 29BB, 113SO, 8 HR) in those 9 wins, but has a 5.94 ERA (130.1IP, 168H, 96R-86ER, 57BB, 112SO, 13 HR) in the club's 15 losses.

» **The Indians have won consecutive games just once this season** (April 8 & 9 at Houston), while the club's longest losing streak of the season is 4 games, done twice (April 10-14 & April 25-38)...**club is 1-7 following a win**, 8-7 following a loss.

A.L. CENTRAL STANDINGS

» Cleveland is tied with Chicago-AL (8-14) for 4th place in the A.L. Central standings, 7.0 games behind first-place Detroit (17-9)...Kansas City (-0.5G, 16-9) holds 2nd place, followed by Minnesota (-3.0G, 14-12) in 3rd place...the Indians have spent 13 days of the season in 3rd place, 5 days in 4th place and 11 days in 5th place.
 » The Indians played 17 consecutive games within the division from April 10-29, going just 5-12 during that stretch...the Tribe went 39-37 within the division in 2014.

SERIES STUFF

» Coming off a 4-game series split with Toronto, Cleveland has gone 1-5-2 through the club's first 8 series of 2015...lone series victory came in Houston to start the season (took 2 of 3 from Astros)...the series split with the Blue Jays snapped a streak of 4 consecutive series losses for Cleveland, longest for the club since dropping 5 straight set Sept. 7-23, 2012.
 » **Cleveland has gone just 1-7 in series openers to start the year** with the club's lone victory coming in a 13-1 win on April 24 at Detroit...**the Indians are 4-4 in series finales and 1-3 in rubber matches.**

WE'RE GETTING CARELESS WITH OUR LOVE

» Cleveland has outscored opponents 60-24 (+36) in the club's 9 victories, while getting outscored 42-96 (-54) in the club's 15 losses.
 » **Just 8 of Cleveland's 24 decisions this season (33%) have been decided by two-or-fewer runs - fewest in the Majors** (Tribe is 4-4 in those games)...Arizona & Los Angeles-NL are next with 9 each...by comparison, the Indians had 70 one-or-two run decisions in 2013 (43%) and 85 one-or-two run decisions in 2014 (52%).

CHASING PAVEMENTS | THREE IN KC

» The Indians went 3-4 on their just completed 7-day, 7-game homestand against Kansas City (1-2) and Toronto (2-2)...Cleveland is set to meet the Royals again for a brief 3-game road trip here at Kauffman Stadium...**the Royals (.345/.387/.491) outscored the Indians (.219/.324/.406), 22-14 in that 3-game series last week.**
 » Cleveland went 4-5 at Kauffman Stadium last season, however the Indians have won each of the last 4 tilts at this ballpark - the club's longest winning streak in KC since Sept. 4, 2011-April 15, 2012 (also 4 games)...**Tribe enters tonight's series opener looking for their first 5-game winning streak here at The K since reeling off 5 straight from Sept. 30, 2007-May 30, 2008.**

BROKEN ARROWS

» Cleveland's starting rotation has posted a 7.77 ERA (38ER/44.0IP) with just 32 K's, 21 BB's and one quality start over the club's last 9 games (3-6) since April 25, this after beginning the season with a 3.95 ERA (36ER/82.0IP) with 105 K's, 28 BB's and 9 quality starts over the club's first 15 games (6-9) from April 6-24.
 » Tribe rotation's 5.29 ERA overall is 4th-highest in the A.L., while 137 K's are still 2nd-most behind the league behind Seattle (140).

DOING MY OWN THING

» **JASON KIPNIS** fell a triple shy of hitting for the cycle on Sunday afternoon, going 4-for-5 with one double, one HR, 2 RBI and 3 runs scored...in 8 games since being moved into the lead-off spot on April 26, Kipnis is 11-for-32 (.344) with 2 doubles, 3 home runs, 7 RBI, 6 walks and 8 runs scored, posting a .462 OBP and .688 SLG pct. (1.149OPS).
 » **Kipnis now leads the Indians with 27 base hits this season**, still 13 shy of Houston's **Jose Altuve** (40) for the A.L. lead.
 » According to Elias, Sunday marked the first time for an Indians lead-off man to collect at least 4 hits with 2 of those going for extra-bases since Aug. 21, 2008 vs. Kansas City when **GRADY SIZEMORE** went 4-for-5 with one triple, one HR and 7 RBI in a 10-3 win over the Royals.

MR. SOUL

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** ranks 7th in the A.L. with a .352 avg...despite missing several games early in the season due to lower back soreness, Brantley ranks among team leaders with 8 doubles (1st), 25 hits (2nd) and 12 RBI (3rd)...**he has hit safely in 12 of his 16 games since returning to the lineup on April 17** at .381 (24-63) with 7 doubles, one HR and 11 RBI.
 » **Brantley has driven in at least one run in 4 consecutive games** (6th time w/ streak of 4+G's), one shy of his career-high: 5 straight, **Sept 21-26, 2013.**
 » **In terms of clutch-hitting categories, Brantley ranks among A.L. leaders in batting avg:** with men on base (1st, .481, 13-27), with RISP (2nd, .556, 10-18), with 2 outs (3rd, .444, 12-27) and with RISP+2 outs (1st, .667, 4-6).
 » Brantley hit just .255 (25-98) last season in March/April (27 games) before finishing the year at .327, 3rd-highest in the A.L. and Majors, on the way to a Top 3 finish in A.L. MVP voting.

EXPECTING TO FLY

» The Indians have smacked 19 home runs over the club's last 16 games since April 17, this after going deep in just 2 of the team's first 8 games (4 HR total)...Tribe's 23 HR's are T8th-most in the A.L. and T12th-most in the Majors.
 » Cleveland has clubbed 15 of the club's 23 HR's on the road (8 at Progressive Field).

RUMOUR HAS IT

» The Indians announced today that **OF JERRY SANDS** has accepted his assignment to Triple-A Columbus and was scheduled to report to the Clippers today...Sands was DFA'd on April 29, cleared waivers and was outrighted to Columbus on May 3.

FOR WHAT IT'S WORTH | MISC. NOTES

» Series finale win vs. Toronto marked Cleveland's first Sunday win of the season.
 » Cleveland's 4-game winning streak here at Kauffman Stadium is the club's longest active winning streak at any road venue in the Majors (STATS).
 » **DANNY SALAZAR** is looking to become the first Indians pitcher to win each of his first 4 starts to begin a season since **Justin Masterson** went 5-0 across his first 5 assignments of the 2011 season.
 » **RYAN WEBB** has tossed 5.0 scoreless innings over a pair of relief appearances since having his contract purchased from Triple-A Columbus on Thursday.
 » **NICK SWISHER** has gone 9-for-24 (.375) with 2 doubles, one home run, 5 RBI and 5 runs scored thru 6 games on rehab assignment with Triple-A Columbus.
 » Today marks the 48th birthday of former Tribe right-hander and current Special Asst. to the GM, **CHARLES NAGY.**

» Today the Indians announced that the club will introduce an exclusive, Season Ticket Holder-only entrance beginning this Friday, May 8...STH's will now have the ability to skip the lines at other gates with access to their own entrance adjacent to the New Era Store at the new Right Field Gate for expedited entry into Progressive Field.

» With the Cleveland Cavaliers advancing to the second round of the NBA Playoffs, WMMS is scheduled to broadcast Indians games Wednesday (May 6), Friday (May 8) and Sunday (May 10) exclusively in the Cleveland market, while WTAM will broadcast the Cavs games on those dates.

TONIGHT'S START

» The 25-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his fourth start of the 2015 season tonight in the opener of this 3-game series against the Kansas City Royals, also the 34th start/game of his career.

» Will be pitching on 5 days' rest after the Tribe's off day on Monday...tied a career-high with his third consecutive victory in a 7-5 Cleveland win last Wednesday, April 29 against KC...threw 6.0 innings (6H, 4R-ER, 0BB, 1HR), tallying 7 strikeouts, **his career-best sixth straight start with at least 7 K's (began on Sept. 13, 2014 at Detroit).**

» Will be making his seventh career start/appearance against Kansas City, as he is 3-3 with a 5.45 ERA (20ER/33.0IP) over those starts...is 1-0 this season against the A.L. Central foe after his victory on April 29...**set to make back-to-back starts against the same opponent for the first time in his career.**

» Will make his 2015 debut at Kauffman Stadium...the right-hander is 2-1 lifetime here in KC, posting a 3.50 ERA (7ER/18.0IP)...earned the win in his last start at Kauffman Stadium on Aug. 29, 2014 in a 6-1 victory for the Indians, tossing 5.0 scoreless innings (4H, 2BB, 3SO).

» **Is looking to set a new career-high 4-game winning streak, as he has won 3 consecutive games to start 2015...also achieved a 3-game winning streak from July 22-Aug. 1, 2014.**

LAST START

» Helped the Indians snap a 4-game skid, notching his third straight win in as many starts since being recalled from AAA Columbus in the Indians 7-5 victory over Kansas City on April 29 at Progressive Field...struck out 7 batters in 6.0 innings of work (6H, 4R-ER, 1HR, 0BB), marking a career-high sixth straight start with at least 7 K's...allowed a home run, which Salazar has now done in each of his 3 starts of 2015.

» The right-hander did not walk a batter for the 5th time in his career, the first time he has not allowed a free pass since Sept. 3, 2014 against Detroit...Cleveland's offense has scored 21 runs in support of Salazar (9.95 RSA), the highest of any Tribe starter...if he qualified, the 9.95 RSA would rank 3rd in the Majors among qualifying starters behind Toronto's Mark Buehrle (11.89) and Drew Hutchison (11.49).

WE MEET AGAIN | VS. KANSAS CITY

» Salazar will be making his seventh career and second consecutive start/appearance against the Kansas City Royals, the most starts he has made lifetime against any opponent...he is 3-3 with a 5.45 ERA (20ER/33.0IP) over those contests...has won 3 of his last 4 starts against the division rivals and earned the victory in his last outing on April 29 in the Indians 7-5 win (6.0IP, 6H, 4R-ER, 1HR, 0BB, 7SO, 96 pitches/65 strikes)...**marks the first time in his career that he will face the same opponent in back-to-back starts.**

» Went 2-2 with a 5.14 ERA (12ER/21.0IP) in 4 starts/appearances against KC in 2014 (21.0IP, 26H, 13R/12ER, HR, 7BB/2IBB, 24SO, .292AVG)...Salazar's career ERA of 5.45 (20ER/33.0IP) against the Royals is the highest of any A.L. Central opponent, but the right-hander has allowed just 2 home runs to KC hitters, the lowest number among division rivals...the Tribe is 3-3 when Salazar has started against the Royals.

AT KAUFFMAN STADIUM | ON THE ROAD

» Making his 4th career start at Kauffman Stadium, tying Comerica Park for his most starts at a road ballpark...is 2-1 with a 3.50 ERA (7ER/18.0IP) here in KC and has won 2 consecutive starts...his last start at Kauffman Stadium (Aug. 29, 2014) ended in a 6-1 Indians victory as Salazar picked up the win, throwing 5.0 scoreless innings (4H, 2BB, 3SO)...marked the third time in the right-hander's career that he held an opponent scoreless on the road.

» Carried a 3-4 record with a 4.39 ERA (26ER/53.1IP) in 10 starts on the road last year...2 of those 3 wins were attributed to the Royals, as the right-hander went 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA (3ER/12.0IP) in 2 starts at Kauffman Stadium in 2014...**the 2.25 ERA ranked 3rd-lowest among starting pitchers at Kauffman Stadium in 2014,** trailing teammate Corey Kluber (1.93) and Chicago-AL's John Danks (2.08).

» Enters today riding a career-best 3-game winning streak on the road, a run that began here in KC on Aug. 29, 2014, Salazar's most recent start at Kauffman Stadium.

2015 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

» Was promoted from AAA Columbus on April 18 and made his 2015 Major League debut that same day in a 4-2 Tribe victory, earning the win after tossing 6.0 innings (6H, 2R-ER, 1HR, 2BB, 10SO).

» Struck out a career-high 11 batters in his second start on April 24 at Detroit (7.0IP, 6H, 1R-ER, 1HR, 3BB, 115 pitches/74 strikes)...marked the first time in Salazar's career that he has tossed at least 6.0 innings and has allowed 2-or-fewer runs in back-to-back games...also recorded double-digit K's in consecutive games for the first time in his career (10 K's on April 18 at MIN).

» Matched a career-best 3-game winning streak on April 29 against Kansas City in a 7-5 Cleveland victory...threw 6.0 innings (6H, 4R-ER, 1HR, 0BB), striking out at least 7 batters for a career-best sixth straight game.

MINOR LEAGUE NUMBERS

» Salazar appeared in one Minor League game with the Columbus Clippers to start the year after being optioned to AAA Columbus on Friday, March 27...the right-hander earned the win in his lone start with Columbus, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings at Indianapolis on April 10 (4H, 0BB, 7SO, 80 pitches/57 strikes)...was originally scheduled to make his second start on Thursday, April 16 at Toledo but was scratched 30 minutes before first pitch with the intention of being recalled to start the April 18 game at Minnesota.

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» Right-hander is in his 9th season with Cleveland after signing as a non-drafted free agent out of Santo Domingo, DR in 2006.

» Made 7 starts at A Lake County in 2010 before being shut down for the season with right elbow soreness that eventually required reconstructive right elbow surgery.

» Spent the first four months of the 2011 season rehabbing out of the Goodyear, AZ Player Development Complex before making a combined 8 starts between the AZL Indians and Lake County.

» Opened 2012 in High-A Carolina rotation and was promoted to Double-A Akron on August 3, making his final 6 starts of the season for the Aeros...named the 7th-best prospect in the Indians system by *Baseball America* entering the 2013 season.

» Enjoyed a rapid ascent to the Major Leagues in 2013, beginning the season as AA Akron's Opening Day starter and concluding the season with a postseason start with the Major League club...recorded 65 strikeouts in his first 10 career starts with the Tribe, the most since Herb Score had a club record 92 K's in 81.0 innings pitched...was the club's starting pitcher in the Indians first postseason game since 2007, losing to the Tampa Bay Rays, 4-0, in the A.L. Wild Card Game...joined Zach McAllister and Alex White as Tribe prospects who have made their Major League debut as the club's starting pitcher over the last 3 seasons...made his Major League debut on July 11, 2013 against Toronto (W, 6.0IP, 2H, 1R/ER, BB, 7SO).

» Made his first Opening Day rotation in 2014, going 6-8 with a 4.25 ERA (52ER/110.0IP) over 20 starts...went 1-4 with a 5.53 ERA (25ER/40.2IP) in 8 starts from April 4-May 15...turned his season around in the second half, going 5-4 with a 3.50 ERA (27ER/69.1) in 12 starts.
