IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: RHP Yhonathan Barrios (right shoulder strain), RHP Zack Jones (right shoulder strain), OF Rymer Liriano (facial fractures) and LHP Sean Nolin (left elbow soreness) are currently on the 60-day disabled list....LHP Chris Capuano (left elbow soreness), RHP Michael Blazek (right elbow impingement) and OF Domingo Santana (right elbow soreness) are currently on the 15-day disabled list.

BREWERS IN THE STANDINGS (72 days): The Brewers have spent the following number of days alone or tied at each position in the NL Central: **FIRST:** 0, **SECOND:** 1, **THIRD:** 1, **FOURTH:** 47, **FIFTH:** 23....the team is currently in fourth place, trailing the first-place Cubs by 14.0 games....the Brewers trail the second-place Cardinals by 5.5 games and the third-place Pirates by 2.5 games....are ahead of the fifth-place Reds by 5.0 games.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Brewers are 6-9-6 in series play this season....**Game 1:** 9-13, **Game 2:** 7-14, **Game 3:** 11-6, **Game 4:** 3-1....**Sweep Wins (2):** at Atlanta (3g, 5/24-5/26) and vs. Oakland (2g, 6/7-6/8)....**Sweep Losses (2):** at Chicago-NL (2g, 4/26-4/28) and at New York-NL (3g, 5/20-5/22).

BREWERS AT HOME: The Brewers are 19-17 at home this season, going 5-4-3 in series play....the team has two season-high 3-game home winning streaks (5/1-5/3 and 6/1-6/8) and a season-high 3-game home losing streak (4/21-4/23)....the team went 34-47 at home last season, going 8-15-3 in series play.

BREWERS ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 11-17 on the road this season, going 1-5-3 in series play....the team had a season-high 4-game road winning streak from 5/24-6/2....the team went 34-47 on the road last season, going 8-17-1 in series play.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 18 replay challenges, going 10-8....their last challenge (lost) came on 6/10 vs. New York-NL as an out call involving Ramon Flores at third base was confirmed....the team went 16-14 in replay challenges last season.

GARZA AT A GLANCE: Matt Garza, 32, is making his season debut....Garza was placed on the 15-day disabled list on 4/5, retroactive to 4/2, with a right lat strain....he was transferred to the 60-day DL on 4/28....he was sent to Class-A Wisconsin on rehab assignment on 5/31 and went 0-2 with a 4.76 ERA in 3 starts (11.1ip, 13h, 7r, 6er, 1bb, 10k, 1hr)....he last pitched for the Timber Rattlers last Thursday vs. Clinton and took the loss (5ip, 7h, 3r, 3er, 0bb, 7k)....he went 1-0 with a 4.50 ERA in 6 Spring Training starts (22ip, 25h, 12r, 11er, 12bb, 14k, 4hr).... Garza was signed as a free agent on 1/26/14....he is signed through the 2017 season with a vesting option for 2018....bio is on p. 81 of the media guide.

LAST SEASON: Garza went 6-14 with a 5.63 ERA in 26 games, including 25 starts....he made 10 quality starts....opponents batted .294 (176-for-598, 23hr)....the team went 9-16 in his starts....he was on the 15-day disabled list from 7/6-7/20 with right shoulder tendinitis, retroactive to 7/3....he was removed from the starting rotation after his 9/5 start and did not pitch again in 2015.

CAREER: Is 81-89 with a 3.99 ERA in 247 games, including 243 starts (1494.1ip, 663er)....is in his 11th Major League season....Garza has pitched for Minnesota (2006-07), Tampa Bay (2008-10), Chicago-NL (2011-13), Texas (2013) and Milwaukee (2014-current)....has gone 14-22 with a 4.59 ERA in 53 games (52 starts) as a Brewer (312ip, 159er).
