St. Louis Cardinals (85-76) vs. Pittsburgh Pirates (78-82)

TODAY'S GAME: The Cardinals continue their final regular season homestand today (2:15 p.m. CT) when they host the Pittsburgh Pirates in the final game of a 3-game weekend series to conclude the 2016 regular season schedule...The Cardinals need a win today and a loss by the San Francisco Giants to force a tie-breaker game #163 tomorrow in St. Louis...the Redbirds split their 4-game series with the Cincinnati Reds to begin the week and they're now 4-2 on the homestand...will be trying to win four consecutive home games for the first time since July 18-22 (5 straight)

YESTERDAY: The Cardinals overcame an early 3-0 deficit and pulled out a 4-3 win yesterday, as Jedd Gyorko belted a two-out homer (#30) in the 8th inning...six Cardinals relievers combined for 8.0 scoreless innings, including 3.0 from Trevor Rosenthal... Kevin Siegrist earned the win and Seung Hwan Oh was credited with his 19th save...**COMING UP:** If the season requires a tie-breaker game to determine the N.L.'s 2nd Wild Card team, that game would be played tomorrow (Oct. 3) in St. Louis at a time to be determined.

WILD CARDS: St. Louis entered the day in third place in the NL Wild Card standings, two games behind the New York Mets and one game back of the San Francisco Giants...the Cardinals split their season series with the Mets, 3-3, and they were 4-3 in head-to-head meetings with the Giants.

MIKE MATHENY: Mike Matheny is in his 5th season as Cardinals manager, having taken his teams to the postseason each of his first four seasons, the only manager in MLB history to do so...in 2012 he became the 49th manager in St. Louis history, took his team to the World Series in 2013, guided the Cardinals to the NL Central title and 4th-straight trip to the NLCS in 2014 and led an injury-riddled team in 2015 to a MLB best 100 wins and the NL Central Division title for a 3rd-straight season...Matheny, 45, had a 13-year Major League career with MIL, TOR, STL, SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252).

REDBIRD RUNDOWN: The 2015 N.L. Central Champion St. Louis Cardinals are concluding their 125th season of play in the National League...St. Louis began the day in second place in the N.L. Central, 17.5 games behind the 2016 N.L. Central Division Champion Chicago Cubs and 6.5 games in front of Pittsburgh...the Cardinals are 15-15 in their last 30 games, 10-10 in last 20, 5-5 in their last 10 & 4-1 in their last five...St. Louis holds a +61 run-differential, 5th best in the N.L.

ROCK 'EM, SOCK 'EM REDBIRDS: The Cardinals upped their NL league-leading home run total to 224 yesterday, the 2nd highest total in team history...they've had a team-record five games having hit 5 or more home runs...the Redbirds have had six players hit 20 or more homers, tying the NL single-season record held by the Braves (2003 & 1965) & the Nationals who also matched the feat in 2016...the Cardinals have hit a Busch Stadium III single-season record 103 HR's...St. Louis has hit a ML single-season record 17 pinch HR's...St. Louis is 73-45 (.619 win pct.) when hitting at least one home run.

BATTLING THE BUCCOS: Since 2013, the year they met in the NLDS, the Cardinals hold a slim 39-36 edge over the Pirates, going 24-13 in games at Busch Stadium...the Cardinals are concluding their season at home against Pittsburgh for the first time since 1995 when they won 2-of-3...they swept the Pirates at PNC Park in 2007 in their last season-ending series against Pittsburgh, as they did the last time (2013 vs. Chicago Cubs) they concluded a season at home.

CATCHING CONSTANT: Cardinals catcher Yadier Molina has caught a single-season high 145 games this season, the most by a Cards receiver since Ted Simmons caught a team single-season record 154 games in 1975...Yadi is one hit shy of tying Bill Freehan (Mike Matheny's college coach at Michigan) for 25th all-time in hits by a catcher with 1,591.

NO. 4 AIMING FOR 5: Molina, hitting a team-leading .304 overall this season, is aiming for his 5th season with a .300+ season batting mark: .304 in 2008; .305 in 2011; .315 in 2012; .319 in 2013...there have only been eight other catchers to have ever done so - Ivan Rodriguez-7 seasons, Mike Piazza-7, Ted Simmons-7, Mickey Cochrane-7, Joe Mauer-6, Victor Martinez-5, Thurman Munson-5, Bill Dickey-5 (min. 502 plate appearances).

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#50 ADAM WAINWRIGHT • RHP • 6-7 • 235 • 35 yrs

TODAY'S GAME:

- ◆ Makes team-leading 33rd start of the season and 254th of his career (320th career appearance). Most starts since making 34 in 2013.
- ◆ Needs a win tonight to pass Dizzy Dean (134) for sole possession of 6th place all-time in Cardinals history. Is 7.1 innings away from reaching the 200 inning plateau for the 6th time in his career (last was 2014).
- ◆ Ranks among National League leaders in innings pitched (192.2, 9th), starts (32, T5th) and 12th in fewest HR/9 IP (1.03).
- ◆ Ranks 3rd in the NL in double plays (27) and 2nd in GDP/9 IP (1.26).
- ◆ Has a 3.21 ERA (98.0 IP) in 15 home starts (6.18 ERA in 17 road starts).
- ◆ Earned second straight win in is last start (9/27) vs. CIN, scattering 10 hits (2 HR) for five runs over 5.2 innings in St. Louis' 12-5 victory.
- ◆ Is 26-10 with a 3.34 ERA in 43 career Sept./Oct. starts (58 app.). Leads all active pitchers with 26 wins in Sept./Oct., and has the 2nd-highest Sept./Oct. win pct. (.722) among active pitchers (min. 25 dec.).
- ◆ Is 55-32, 3.26 ERA career post-All-Star Break & ranks 5th in ERA and 3rd in winning pct (.632) among active National League pitchers.
- ◆ Ten of his 13 hits this season have gone for extra bases (7 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs).
- ◆ With double on 9/5 at PIT, became first pitcher in modern MLB history to produce extra-bases on nine consecutive hits, passing record owned by current teammate Mike Leake, who recorded extra bases on eight straight hits from 2014-15 (w/ CIN) (Elias).
- ◆ Is first Cards pitcher in franchise history to record four three-RBI games in one season, and the first in MLB since Don Newcombe had four in 1955 (Wes Ferrell, 5, 1931, MLB record). His 18 RBI are most by Cards pitcher since Bob Gibson's 19 in 1965 and 1970.
- ◆ Leads MLB pitchers in RBI (18), doubles (7), extra-base hits (10) and is T3rd in homers (2). Leads all active pitchers in career hits (116), doubles (8), and RBI (57) and is T3rd in AVG (.200) (min. 300 at-bats).

VS. PITTSBURGH PIRATES:

- ◆ Makes his 5th start vs. PIT this season (his most vs. any opp. in 2016). Has a 2-1 record with a 4.07 ERA (24.1 IP) with three quality starts.
- ◆ Posted a 13-7, 4.26 ERA in 27 career starts (32 app.) vs. the Pirates. His 13 career wins vs. PIT rank 2nd among active pitchers (Johnny Cueto, 19) and are T11th-most in Cardinals history (Jesse Haines, 30).
- ◆ At Busch, is lifetime 7-3, 3.42 ERA in 16 games (14 starts)...St. Louis is 12-4 in his starts. Pitched 6.0 or more inn. in his last 7 outings (6 quality).
- ◆ Swatted a pinch-hit, two-RBI double in 12th inning at PIT (6/10) as part of a six-run inning as the Cardinals won 9-3.
- ◆ Did not get a decision in the team's 6-4 win 5/7 at Busch. Went 6.1 innings allowing three runs, Matt Carpenter hit 2-run, walk-off homer.
- ◆ Made his 5th career Opening Day start on 4/3 at PIT in MLB's first game of the season. Allowed three runs in 6.0 IP, suffering a 4-1 loss.
- ◆ Did not make a start against the Pirates in his injury-shortened 2015 season, but pitched 1.0 inning at PIT on 9/30 [1] in his first app. off of the disabled list (2 H, 1 R).
