**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Giants kick off a nine-game road trip tonight with the first of a three-game series against the Phillies...the Giants are 29-23 (.558) on the road this season, however have gone 2-8 in their last 10 road games.

**TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS:** **OF Mac Williamson** has been placed on the 15-day disabled list with a left shoulder strain (retroactive to yesterday)... **IF Ehire Adrianza** (#1) has returned from his rehab assignment and has been reinstated from the 60-day DL... **LHP Matt Moore** (#45) and **LHP Will Smith** (#13) will also be added to the Giants' 25-man roster tonight...corresponding roster moves will be announced later today.

**MORE MOVES:** **IF Grant Green** has cleared waivers and has accepted his outright assignment to triple-A Sacramento... **IF Ruben Tejada** has also cleared waivers and has accepted his assignment at triple-A.

**THE NEW GUYS:** The Giants were busy at the trade deadline yesterday, acquiring **LHP Matt Moore** (#45) from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for IF Matt Duffy and minor leaguer IF Lucius Fox and RHP Michael Santos...SF also acquired **LHP Will Smith** (#13) from the Brewers for RHP Phil Bickford and C Andrew Susac.

**ON THE MOUND:** **LHP Madison Bumgarner**, who turned 27 years old yesterday, is 0-2 over his last three starts, though he's allowed just seven earned runs over 21.0 innings (3.00 ERA) over that span while striking out 24 batters...the Giants have managed just four runs in his last three starts.

**1-2 PUNCH:** **LHP Madison Bumgarner** and **RHP Johnny Cueto** have combined for a 23-9 record and a 2.36 ERA, with the team going 26-12 in their starts this season...the other Giants starters have combined for a 17-22 record and a 4.98 ERA, with SF going 28-28 in those games.

**DID YOU KNOW:** The last time the Giants traded a homegrown player off their 25-man roster was Nate Schierholtz in the deal that also sent Tommy Joseph and Seth Rosin to the Phillies in exchange for **OF Hunter Pence**.

**STILL ONE OF TOP TEAMS:** Despite a rough start to the second half, the Giants still have the third-best record in the National League at 61-44 (.581)...only the Cubs (63-41, .606) and Nationals (62-44, .585) have better records than the Giants.

**SECOND HALF STRUGGLES:** During SF's current 4-11 run, the team has batted .243 while averaging 3.3 runs per game...the pitching staff has a 4.43 ERA (starters at 5.42 and relievers at 2.84)...SF has committed 14 errors in this span.

**WITH RISP:** The Giants are hitting .139 (19-for-137) with runners in scoring position over their past 14 games...the team has struggled in these situations the entire month of July, batting just .156 (33-for-212).

**QUALITY OUTINGS:** Giants starting pitchers have logged just three quality starts in the second half (three out of 15 games)...SF is 44-13 (.772) this season when their starter gives them a quality outing.

**HOME RUNS ALLOWED:** Since the start of the second half, the Giants have allowed 25 home runs in 15 games, 20 of which have been given up by the starting staff...the Royals are the only team that have given up more homers since the break with 26.

**Ozzie Virgil** drove in three runs and **Juan Marichal**, making his first relief appearance of the year, picked up his 17th win, as the Giants defeated the Mets, 5-4...the win moved the Giants (63-44) back ahead of the Dodgers and Pirates by a game.

#### MANAGER BRUCE BOCHY

**Bruce Bochy** is in his 10th season at the helm of the Giants...his only predecessors to reach double figures were **John McGraw** (1902-32), **Bill Terry** (1932-41) and **Dusty Baker** (1993-2002)...SF has posted an 812-751 (.520) record during his 10-year tenure...his 1,763 victories are the highest total by an active manager and rank 16th on the all-time list...is six wins shy of matching Jim Leyland for 15th place on the all-time list...Bochy is one of 10 managers in ML history to win three World Series titles...the other nine are in the Hall of Fame.

• Last pitched on Wednesday versus Cincinnati and wound up with the loss despite allowing two runs (one unearned) in 8.0 innings of a 2-1 loss...gave up a go-ahead solo HR to Jay Bruce in the seventh, marking the first time a left-handed hitter hit a go-ahead homer in the seventh inning or later off Bumgarner.

• SF is 13-9 in his outings this year, however have lost six of his last eight trips to the hill, including his last three...the Giants have not lost four consecutive Bumgarner starts since Aug. 7-Sept. 3, 2013 (lost six in a row).

• Has received a total of just four runs of support in his last three starts, during which he's 0-2 with a 3.00 ERA (7er, 21.0ip)...his run support average of 4.30 overall this season is the lowest on the staff.

• Has tossed at least 6.0 innings in his last 19 starts, the longest such streak of his career...the last Giants pitcher with a streak of 19-or-more consecutive games of 6.0+ innings is **Ryan Vogelsong**, who had 22 such starts from 2011 to 2012.

• Was named to his fourth-consecutive All-Star team, but was not eligible to pitch because he started the Sunday before the break.

• The most one-hit shutouts (9+ IP) since 1990: **Madison Bumgarner** (four), Mike Mussina (four), Randy Johnson (four).

• Over his last 16 starts, opponents are 9-for-67 (.134) in at-bats with runners in scoring position...his .151 avg. against with RISP overall is the third best in the Majors (Archie Bradley, .123 & Danny Salazar, .149)...the opposition is 4-for-40 (.100) off him with RISP and two outs.

• Has allowed just six extra base hits to left-handed batters this season...lefties are 19-for-103 (.184) off him with 36 strikeouts...has allowed just three home runs to lefties all year (MIL's Scooter Gennett, OAK's Yonder Alonso and CIN's Jay Bruce).

• For every batter that Bumgarner strikes out this season, Carhartt will donate \$500 to "Helmets to Hardhats," a program assisting military vets transitioning to civilian life...so far his 170 strikeouts this year has generated \$85,000.

**HITTING NOTES:** Bumgarner, Jake Arrieta and Noah Syndergaard are the only pitchers in the big leagues with two home runs this season...his 13 career home runs are the most of any active pitcher...Bumgarner has 29 RBI over the last three seasons...next-most as a P: Mike Leake with 15...batted for himself in his start at Oakland on June 30...since 1973, the only pitchers to bat for themselves in the starting lineup when a DH was available are Ferguson Jenkins (TEX) in 1974, Ken Holtzman (OAK) in 1975, Ken Brett (CHW) in 1976 and Andy Sonnanstine (TB) in 2009 (although Sonnanstine was unintentional).

**NOTES:** Two-time All-Star (2014, 2016) has gone 13-3 with a 2.63 ERA, four complete games, 131 strikeouts and 30 walks in 21 starts...the Giants are 17-4 in his outings this season...SF has dropped two of his last three starts after winning 16 of his 18 outings of the season...took the loss in his last outing in the Giants' 4-2 loss to the Nationals last Thursday...allowed three runs in 5.0 innings of work, which matched his shortest outing of the season...is 1-4 with a 5.46 ERA in 10 starts against Philadelphia...his 5.46 ERA against the Phillies is the highest against any opponent he has made more than five starts against.
