BOSTON RED SOX (7-5) vs. BALTIMORE ORIOLES (7-5)

STATE OF THE SOX: Today the Red Sox and Orioles conclude a 4-game wrap-around series at Fenway Park...Boston trails the series 1-game-to-2, winning the opener on Friday night, 3-2, in walk-off fashion (9 innings)...This series ends an 8-day, 7-game homestand, Boston's first at Fenway Park in 2015, which began with a 2-1 showing against the Nationals.

- Boston has lost 3 of its last 4 following a 6-2 start... In the last 2 days (11th and 12th games), the club has dropped back-to-back contests for the first time in 2015...It marked the latest into any season Boston went without back-to-back losses since the 2001 team went 22 games before losing games 23 and 24.
- The Red Sox have taken all 4 series openers in 2015, are 3-0 in 1-run games, and 5-0 when scoring first.

SERIES BUSINESS: A win today would prevent Boston's first series loss of the season...The club won its previous 3 series, taking 2 of 3 at PHI, at NYY, and vs. WSH.

- This year was the first in which Boston won its first 3 series of any season since the 1952 team won its first 6 sets: 2-1 at WSH, 3-0 vs. PHI, 2-1 vs. WSH, 2-0 vs. NYY, 1-0 vs. DET, and 2-1 vs. SLB.

IN THE STANDINGS: At 7-5, Boston is tied with Baltimore for the top spot in the AL East standings, 1.0 game ahead of New York (6-6).

- The Red Sox have held at least a share of first place in 12 of 14 days since the club's first game day, including each of the last 11 days beginning on 4/9...Last year, Boston held at least a share of first place for just 1 day (following play 4/3/14).

FACING EAST: On Friday night, the Red Sox began a stretch of 7 consecutive series and 22 consecutive games against AL East opponents...This east-facing portion of the schedule ends when the Sox visit Oakland on 5/11.

- Boston is 1-2 thus far during the 22-game stretch and is 3-3 overall this year against divisional foes.

STOP, THIEF: The Red Sox have stolen 8 bases this season without being caught, tied for the 2nd-highest total among the 4 remaining major league teams that have not been caught stealing (CIN is 13-for-13 in stolen base attempts).

- It marks the Red Sox offense's longest streak of games without a CS to begin a season since the 2007 club was caught for the first time in its 15th game, but that team only stole 4 bags before being nabbed...Since 1914, no other Red Sox team has stolen as many as 8 bases with 0 CS through 12 games.

HOME SWEET: The Sox have won 3 of their 6 home games this season despite being outscored here, 29-35...The club's last 2 home wins were 1-run victories...Boston is 6-5 in its last 11 games at Fenway Park dating back to 9/24/14.

HITTING THE ROAD: Boston begins its 2nd road trip of the season tomorrow, a 6-game trek...The Sox play 3 games in Tampa Bay before heading to Baltimore for the weekend.

- The Sox are 4-2 on the road thus far in 2015...Since 8/10/14, Boston's 17-12 (.586) road record ranks 4th among AL teams.

FACING THE O'S: The current 4-game Patriot's Day series marks the 1st of 6 sets between Boston and Baltimore this year...The Sox make their first trip to Camden Yards next weekend, with a 3-game series from 4/24-26.

- The Sox dropped 11 of 19 meetings with the O's in 2014, losing a 3rd straight season set to Baltimore for the first time since a 4-season slide from 1964-67.
- Friday night's win snapped a streak of 5 straight losses against the O's at Fenway Park, but Boston has lost 7 of its last 8 home games to the Birds dating back to the 2nd game of a doubleheader on 7/5/14.

PATRIOTS' DAY: Today's game is at 11:05 a.m., as is the tradition on Patriots' Day, a holiday in Massachusetts and Maine that celebrates the anniversary of Paul Revere's ride and the battles of Lexington and Concord in 1775...The day is also marked by the running of the Boston Marathon, which goes through nearby Kenmore Square.

- Patriots' Day at Fenway Park has traditionally been a single game with an 11:00/11:05 a.m. start since 1968 with a few exceptions, last in 2007 (10:05 a.m. scheduled start)...On a number of occasions prior to that time, the Sox played a split doubleheader on Patriots' Day with 2 admissions...Fans would watch the finish of the Boston Marathon between games.
- Boston has been scheduled to play at home on Patriots' Day every year since 1959, with games postponed due to weather (1959, 1961, 1965, 1984) and players strike (1995).

PATRIOTIC SUCCESS: The Sox are 68-51 (.571) all-time on Patriots' Day, with 26 doubleheaders between 1903 and 1966...Boston has won on 10 of the last 14 Patriots' Days beginning in 2001.

- The Red Sox are 4-2 in 6 previous Patriots' Day matchups against the Orioles, who defeated the Red Sox 7-6 in last year's Patriots' Day game on 4/21/14.

MARATHON MONDAY: The 119th Boston Marathon begins at approximately 9:30 a.m. resulting in a number of street closures, including parts of Commonwealth Ave., Beacon St., and Kenmore Square...Fans attending the game are encouraged to use public transportation.

EARLY STARTS: Both of today's starters have previously won Patriots' Day games at Fenway Park...Justin Masterson is making his 2nd career Patriots' Day appearance for the Red Sox...He started and won on 4/20/09 (5.1 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 2 BB, 3 SO), outdueling Mark Hendrickson for the 12-1 win over Baltimore at Fenway Park.

- Baltimore's Wei-Yin Chen started a won last year's Patriots' Day game (5.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 3 BB, 5 SO), a 7-6 Red Sox loss.

FENWAY MAGIC: The Red Sox won Friday night's series-opener against the Orioles on a walk-off 9th-inning single by Xander Bogaerts that scored Mike Napoli from 2nd base...At 22 years old, Bogaerts was the youngest Red Sox player with a walk-off RBI since Jim Rice, at 22, on 7/31/75 vs. DET (G2)...Rice's game-winning single scored Denny Doyle from 2nd base in the bottom of the 10th inning.

- Friday night's victory marked Boston's first walk-off win since 9/5/14 vs. TOR...The Sox have now won in walk-off fashion on 21 different occasions since the start of 2013, tied with ARI, CLE, and PHI for the major league in that time.

SCORING STORY: The Red Sox have been held to 7 runs over the last 3 games (1-2), but still rank T-6th among major league teams with 63 runs scored, having crossed the plate at least 6 times in 6 of their first 8 games of the year.

- This marks the club's most runs scored over its first 12 games of a season since 2005 (also 63).
- Only 1 opposing pitcher has thrown a quality start against the Red Sox this season (PHI's Aaron Harang on 4/8 at PHI)...No team has seen fewer QS this year.

TODAY'S START:

🔴 Making his 3rd start of the season and 2nd at Fenway Park...Is aiming to improve to 2-0 for the 5th time in his career, having done so in 2011 and 2013 with CLE and in 2008-09 with the Red Sox...BOS has not lost in either of his 2015 starts.

🔴 Among AL starting pitchers in 2015 (min. 10.0 IP), ranks 5th in GB% (64.5), T-4th in GB/FB ratio (5.00), and 14th in SO/9.0 IP (9.28).

🔴 Has allowed 1 XBH this season, a double to WSH's Ian Desmond on Tuesday...Is 1 of 6 AL starting pitchers (1 of 12 in MLB) that have allowed 1 or fewer XBH in 2015... Is 1 of 7 AL East pitchers with a sub-.300 opponent SLG (.286).

🔴 Owns a 10-5 record and 4.82 ERA (60 ER/112.0 IP) in 42 career appearances (14 starts) at Fenway Park, including an 8-2 mark and 4.14 ERA (40 ER/87.0 IP) in 37 games (9 starts) as a member of the Red Sox (2008-09, 2015).

🔴 Is seeking his 1st win as a BOS starting pitcher at Fenway since 4/26/09 vs. NYY.

🔴 Has produced a 21-25 record, 3.84 ERA (164 ER/384.1 IP), and .249 opponent AVG in 82 career day games (58 starts).

🔴 In 35 career games (31 starts) in March/April, has gone 12-8 with a 4.05 ERA (86 ER/191.0 IP)...From 2008-14, posted a sub-3.20 ERA in the month of April in 4 of his 7 ML campaigns (2008-09, 2011, 2013).

Last start: Did not factor into the decision after allowing 7 ER on 8 H, 3 BB in 4.2 IP (4 SO) in his 2015 home debut on Tuesday night vs. the Nationals.

🔴 Marked his 1st Red Sox appearance at Fenway since 7/29/09 vs. OAK.

VS. THE ORIOLES:

🔴 Owns a 6-6 record and 5.53 ERA (44 ER/71.2 IP) in 16 career games (12 starts) vs. BAL...In 2 starts against the Orioles in 2014, went 0-1 with an 11.74 ERA (10 ER/7.2 IP) and .441 opponent AVG (3 HR).

🔴 Last faced BAL on 8/8/14 at Camden Yards with CLE, taking the loss after allowing 5 ER on 7 H, 3 BB in 2.0 IP (2 SO).

🔴 Has not lost to the Orioles as a member of the Red Sox, going 2-0 in 5 games (1 start) while posting a 4.05 ERA (6 ER/13.1 IP) from 2008-09.

🔴 Only prior start with BOS vs. BAL was also on Patriots' Day on 4/20/09 (W, 12-1)...Earned the win after going 5.1 IP (3 SO) and permitting just 1 ER on 4 H, 2 BB.

2014 & CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

🔴 Went 7-9 with 116 SO in 128.2 IP and a career-worst 5.88 ERA in 28 outings (25 starts) between CLE and STL...Acquired by the Cardinals at the trade deadline after missing most of July due to injury...Had a 59.2% ground ball rate, 2nd highest in the majors behind HOU's Dallas Keuchel (min. 120.0 IP)...Induced 21 ground ball double plays, T-12th in MLB.

🔴 Leads all major leaguers with a 57.3% ground ball rate in his career since the start of 2009 (min. 1,000.0 IP).

🔴 Among pitchers that have faced at least 1,500 right-handed batters since 2008, none have produced a better opponent SLG (.301) and only LAD's Clayton Kershaw has posted a better opponent AVG (.215).

🔴 In his career, has held right-handed batters to a .220/.306/.301 line and a .607 OPS.

🔴 Has posted a 2-1 record and 3.95 ERA (12 ER/27.1 IP) in his last 5 starts against AL East teams.

🔴 Took the loss in his Fenway debut on Wednesday vs. WSH...Gave up 7 ER on 5 H (1 HR) and 3 BB while recording just 1 SO in 2.1 IP.

- 🔴 Has reached base safely in 7 of his last 8 games with a plate appearance, recording at least 1 hit in 6 of those.
- 🔴 On Monday vs. WSH, became the 1st Sox leadoff hitter with at least 1 HR, 4 RBI, and 2 SB in a game since RBI became official in 1920...Made a HR-saving catch on a fly ball by Bryce Harper in the 1st inning, then hit a 3-run HR in the 2nd...Also stole 2nd and 3rd base on the same play in the 1st inning with WSH in a shift for David Ortiz, marking only the 12th time since 1915 (including postseason) a player stole 2 or more bases on the same play (Source: Trent McCotter, SABR).
- 🔴 Drove in the game-winning run on 4/10 at NYY with a sacrifice fly in the 19th inning.
- 🔴 Named to the 1st Opening Day roster of his career...At 22 years old, became youngest Red Sox player with an Opening Day HR since Tony Conigliaro (20 in 1965)...Also became BOS' youngest Opening Day leadoff hitter since Rico Petrocelli (21 in 1965) and youngest Opening Day CF since Conigliaro (19 in 1964).
- 🔴 In 2014, climbed from Double-A to Triple-A and made ML debut at 21 years old...Hit .291 (55-for-189) with 12 2B, 3B, and 5 HR in 52 games over 3 stints with BOS...Took over as Boston's leadoff hitter on 9/6 and batted .305 (25-for-82) with a .387 OBP in that role over the last 21 games of the season.

- 🔴 In Friday's win vs. BAL, broke up the Orioles' no-hitter with a 1-out single in the 5th inning and delivered a walk-off single to RF in the 9th...Marked his 1st career walk-off RBI...Became the youngest Red Sox player with a walk-off RBI since Jim Rice singled home Denny Doyle vs. DET on 7/31/75 at 22 years old.
- 🔴 Leads the Red Sox in hits (15)...Ranks 15th in the AL in AVG...Has 5 multi-hit games this season, tied for 5th-most in the AL.
- 🔴 Is batting .324 (47-for-145) in his last 36 games (since 8/31/14), the 13th-highest mark in the majors in that span (min. 125 AB).
