**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Giants begin a six-game road trip in the first game of this three-game series at Pittsburgh...San Francisco is coming off their first sweep of the season, as they took three-straight from Colorado to finish their homestand.

**FOR THE RECORD:** The Giants' 30-51 record stands as their worst record through 81 games in SF-era history (since 1958)...despite winning their last three contests, SF has still lost 12 of their last 16 games and 21 of their last 29 overall.

**ON THE MOUND:** RHP **Johnny Cueto** owns a 19-4 record with a 2.10 ERA (45er, 192.2ip) in 29 career starts against Pittsburgh...he has gone 8-0 with a 1.56 ERA (15er, 86.2ip) in his last 12 outings against the Pirates...Cueto does not have a losing decision against the Pirates since May 30, 2012, a 2-1 loss while he was pitching for the Reds.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Giants are 13-30 (.302) this season on the road, which ranks as the second-lowest winning pct. on the road in the Majors...SF has dropped seven of their last eight away from home.

**QUALITY STARTS:** San Francisco starting pitchers have 44 quality outings this season, which are tied for the second-most in the big leagues with the Red Sox and Cardinals behind the Nationals (51)...35 of those 44 quality outings have come with Bumgarner on the disabled list.

**IN THE 'PEN:** SF relievers have combined to throw 13.1-scoreless innings over their last three games.

**WITH THE BATS:** The Giants are averaging 5.3 runs per game over their last seven games and are hitting .328 (22-for-67) with runners in scoring position during this stretch...SF's 3.84 runs per game this season, rank as the second-fewest in the Majors.

**JUST SCORE FOUR:** San Francisco is 24-13 this season when scoring at least four runs in a game, compared to a 6-38 record when scoring fewer than four.

**REHAB AT SAC:** LHP **Madison Bumgarner** (bruised ribs/left shoulder AC sprain) is scheduled to make his second rehab start, his first with triple-A Sacramento, tonight night at Raley Field as the River Cats host the Fresno Grizzlies...Bumgarner most recently pitched for the Giants' rookie-level Arizona team this past Sunday, throwing 3.0 no-hit innings.

**FUTURES GAME:** OF **Bryan Reynolds**, the Giants's top pick in the 2016 draft, will participate in the All-Star Futures Game on July 9...in 64 games with Class A Advanced San Jose, Reynolds owns a .310 batting average with 15 doubles, seven triples, four home runs and an .812 OPS.

**Bruce Bochy** allowed pitcher **Madison Bumgarner** to hit for himself in the Giants' game at Oakland instead of using a DH...Bumgarner doubled off Dillon Overton in the 3rd inning, sparking a six-run outburst, as the Giants went on to win, 12-6.

#### MANAGER BRUCE BOCHY

**Bruce Bochy** is in his 11th season at the helm of the Giants, the longest stint by a Giants manager in SF-era history and the second-longest in franchise history behind **John McGraw** (31 years)...his 1,819 career victories are the highest total by an active manager and the 15th-most all-time...is 17 wins shy of passing Lou Piniella for 14th on the all-time wins list.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#47 RHP Johnny Cueto**  
**5-11, 225, 31 years old (February 15, 1986)**  
**5-7 Record, 4.20 ERA**

- The two-time All-Star (2014 and 2016) is slated to make his 17th start of the season...the Giants are 8-8 in his starts, going 4-3 at home and 4-5 on the road...the Giants have lost six of Cueto's last eight starts.
- Has pitched extremely well in his past two starts, fashioning a 1.93 ERA (3er, 14.0ip) and a .200 (10-for-50) opponents average against in that span.
- Will be seeking his first win since May 28 vs. Atlanta...has gone 0-3 with a 3.82 ERA (13er, 30.2ip) in five starts since his last victory.
- Received a no decision in his last outing on Saturday versus New York-NL in the Giants' 5-2 defeat...his only mistake was a solo homer allowed to Wilmer Flores in the 4th inning...left with the game tied at 1-1.
- His 19 wins and 2.10 ERA against Pittsburgh lead all active pitchers.
- Has also been impressive here at PNC Park, going 11-2 (.846) with a 1.88 ERA (24er, 115.0ip) and a .194 (79-for-408) opponents avg. against in 17 starts (12 quality outings)...has allowed two earned runs or fewer in each of his last 12 starts here, logging a 1.36 ERA (13er, 86.0ip).
- His 11 wins in this facility are the most of any opponent who have never worn a Bucs uni.
- In 100.2 innings this season, he has surrendered 18 home runs, three more than he did in 219.2 innings last season...his 18 homers allowed this year are tied for the fourth-most in the NL.
- The opposition is hitless in their last 19 at-bats with RISP off Cueto...overall, he's holding opponents to a .163 average (14-for-86) in these situations and has been even better in his last seven games, holding opponents to a .029 clip (1-for-34).
- Cueto has been even better with RISP and two outs holding opponents to a .154 figure (6x39).
- Cueto has gone 23-12 (.657) with a 3.23 ERA in 48 starts (five complete games) in his brief career with the Giants, with the team going 31-17 (.646) in those starts.

**2017: 3-8, 6.04 ERA / Career: 48-41, 4.18**

**NOTES:** 28-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 17th start of the season...the Giants are just 4-12 in his starts, going 2-5 at home and 2-7 on the road...the Giants have won just once in his last seven starts...allowed five runs over 4.2 innings in an 8-2 loss that completed a three-game sweep by the Mets at AT&T Park in his last outing on Sunday...allowed two home runs to backup catcher Rene Rivera...enters his start with the fourth-highest ERA of any big league player with a 6.04 figure...has an 8.39 ERA (41er, 44.0ip) in nine road starts compared to a 3.77 ERA (19er, 45.1ip) in seven starts at home...his road ERA is the highest in MLB...has faced the Pirates just once in his career and it came last season on Aug. 15 at AT&T Park in an 8-5 Giants loss...threw 6.0 innings and allowed five runs on six hits in a matchup against Ryan Vogelsong.
