TODAY'S GAME: Is Game 4 (1-2) of an 11-game road trip to St. Louis (1-2), Cincinnati (3g) and Chicago-NL (4g).....following this trip, the team returns to Miller Park for the final homestand of the season vs. Pittsburgh (3g) and Cincinnati (3g).

IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: RHP Yhonathan Barrios (right shoulder strain), OF Rymer Liriano (facial fractures), LHP Sean Nolin (left elbow soreness) and LHP Chris Capuano (left elbow soreness) are on the 60-day disabled list.

BREWERS IN THE STANDINGS (162 days): The Brewers have spent the following number of days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central: **FIRST:** 0, **SECOND:** 1, **THIRD:** 1, **FOURTH:** 136, **FIFTH:** 24.....the team is currently in fourth place, trailing the first-place Cubs by 27.5 games, second-place Cardinals by 12.5 games and third-place Pirates by 7.0 games.....are ahead of the fifth-place Reds by 3.5 games.

BREWERS AT HOME: The Brewers are 39-36 at home this season, going 10-10-4 in series play.....the team has had three season-high 4-game home winning streaks (6/11-6/25, 7/28-7/31 and 8/14-8/24) and a season-high 6-game home losing streak from 8/25-8/30.

BREWERS ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 24-43 on the road this season, going 3-14-4 in series play.....the team had a season-high 5-game road winning streak from 8/21-9/8 and had a season-high 7-game road losing streak from 8/7-8/20.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 37 replay challenges, going 17-20.....their last challenge (won) came on 9/8 at St. Louis as a pickoff attempt involving Randal Grichuk was overturned.....the team went 16-14 in replay challenges last season.

MANAGER: Craig Counsell is in his second season as manager of the Brewers (124-155) and first full season.....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he went 61-76 last season.....bio is on p. 48 of the media guide.

COACHES: Returning from the 2015 staff are hitting coach Darnell Coles (2nd season), third base coach Ed Sedar (10th season, 6th as 3B coach) and bullpen coach Lee Tunnell (4th season).....new to the staff are pitching coach Derek Johnson, coach Jason Lane, bench coach Pat Murphy and first base/infield coach Carlos Subero.

TODAY'S STARTER: #27 - RHP ZACH DAVIES (25gs, 10-7, 4.01)

DAVIES AT A GLANCE: Zach Davies, 23, is making his 26th start of the season and third against the Cardinals.....Davies last started on Monday vs. Chicago-NL and took a 7-2 loss (6.2ip, 6h, 3r, 2er, 2bb, 3k, 1hbp).....he has made a team-leading 14 quality starts.....the team is 12-13 in his starts.....opponents are batting .261 (147-for-563, 18hr).....Davies was recalled on 4/17 from Triple-A Colorado Springs, where he went 0-0 with a 2.00 ERA in 2 starts.....he was optioned back (did not pitch) on 7/6 to make room for a hitter (1B/OF Andy Wilkins) prior to the All-Star break.....Davies was acquired from Baltimore on 7/31/15 for OF Gerardo Parra..... bio is on p. 78 of the media guide.

LAST SEASON: Davies entered 2015 as the sixth-best prospect in the Orioles organization according to *Baseball America*.....he went 6-8 with a 3.30 ERA in 24 games (23 starts) between Triple-A Norfolk (Orioles) and Triple-A Colorado Springs (Brewers).....Davies went 3-2 with a 3.71 ERA in 6 starts with the Brewers as he made his Major League debut after a 9/1 promotion.....opponents batted just .211 (26-for-123, 2hr).....he made 4 quality starts.....he finished the season on a 15.0-inning scoreless streak.

CAREER: Is 13-9 with a 3.95 ERA in 31 starts for the Brewers from 2015-16 (180ip, 79er).

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Davies is 28-31 with a 3.53 ERA in 98 games (88 starts) during five seasons (510.1ip, 200er).....he pitched in the Orioles organization at Class-A Delmarva (2012), Class-A Frederick (2013), Double-A Bowie (2014) and Triple-A Norfolk (2015).....he pitched in the Brewers organization at Triple-A Colorado Springs (2015-16).

CAREER AT MILLER PARK: Is 7-6 with a 3.89 ERA in 19 starts (113.1ip, 49er).....is 7-5 with a 3.67 ERA in 17 starts this season (103ip, 42er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 6-3 with a 4.05 ERA in 12 starts (66.2ip, 30er).....is 3-2 with a 4.81 ERA in 8 starts this season (43ip, 23er).

CAREER vs. CARDINALS: Is 1-0 with a 1.88 ERA in 2 starts, both this season (14.1ip, 3er).

CAREER AT THE PLATE: Is batting .082 (5-for-61).....has not homered.....has no walks and 22 strikeouts.....**THIS SEASON:** Is batting .083 (4-for-48) with 1 RBI.....has 19 strikeouts..... has 6 sacrifice bunts.
