**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants and Cardinals play the final game of this four-game series today, with the Giants leading the set, 2-games-to-1...SF is just 2-4 on this seven-game homestand against the Padres (0-3) and Cardinals (2-1).

**IN THE STANDINGS:** The Giants (79-69) currently trail the Los Angeles Dodgers (82-63) by 5.0 games in the National League West...San Francisco enters today tied with the New York Mets (79-69) for the top wild-card slot and two games ahead of the Cardinals (77-71) in the race for the two National League wild-card spots.

**DECIDING GAME:** At stake in this series is home field advantage in a possible wild-card tie-breaker should the Giants and Cardinals finish the regular season in a tie...home field will go to the team that has the better head-to-head record during the regular season...the Cardinals' win last night evened that count at 3-3.

**LATE INNING STRUGGLES:** Since Aug. 13, Giants relievers own a 6.19 ERA (22er, 32.0ip) in the ninth inning or later, compared to a 1.45 ERA (11er, 68.1ip) in all other innings during this stretch.

**LATE LOSSES:** The Giants have lost eight games this season in which they led at the end of 8.0 innings, which is more than they lost in the previous two seasons combined (seven such losses over 2014-2015)...that total of eight losses when leading at the end of 8.0 innings is tied for the Giants' highest total in a single season; they also had eight losses of that kind in 1945 and 1999 (*Elias*).

**GOING FOR A HOME SERIES WIN:** San Francisco has just three series wins in the second half, going 3-12-3 (win-lost-split) in 18 sets...a win today and they would have just their second series win at home since the All-Star break.

**SUAREZ ON THE HILL:** RHP **Albert Suarez** will be seeking his first win since June 23 at Pittsburgh...Suarez has made 10 starts with the Giants this season, limiting the opposition to three runs or fewer in all 10 outings.

**PENCE HIT STREAK REACHES 11:** OF **Hunter Pence** has hit safely in a season-high 11-straight games and is batting .465 (20-for-43) with 12 runs, five doubles, two home runs and seven RBI during this span.

**ON DECK:** Following today's game the Giants will travel to Los Angeles to begin their final regular season road trip, a six-game tour against the Dodgers (three games) and Padres (four games)...the Giants have gone 7-6 against the Dodgers this season, with eight of the 13 games being decided by just one run.

**GIANTS WITH RISP:** The Giants are hitting .227 (118-for-519) with runners in scoring position in the second-half...SF has been held to three hits or fewer with runners in scoring position in 45 of 57 games since the break...the Giants' .227 clip with RISP this half ranks as the fourth-lowest in the Majors.

**FLASHING THE LEATHER:** SF has been one of the best defensive teams in the Majors this season, posting the highest fielding percentage in the bigs (.988)...SF has committed just three errors in their last 31 games and 279.2 innings.

**SELLOUT STREAK AT AT&T PARK:** The Giants have sold out their last 482 regular season games at AT&T Park, dating back to Oct. 1, 2010 vs. San Diego...the Giants' sellout streak is the longest active home streak in the Majors and ranks as the second-longest consecutive regular season sellout streak in MLB history behind the Boston Red Sox (794 dates).

#### MANAGER BRUCE BOCHY

**Bruce Bochy** is in his 10th season at the helm of the Giants...he owns an 830-776 (.517) record during his 10-year tenure and his 830 wins as a Giants manager rank as the third-most in franchise history behind **John McGraw** (2,583) and **Dusty Baker** (840)...his 1,781 victories are the highest total by an active manager and rank 15th on the all-time list...Bochy is one of 10 managers in ML history to win three World Series titles...the other nine are in the Hall of Fame.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#56 RHP Albert Suarez**  
**6-3, 235, 26 years old (October 8, 1989)**  
**3-3 Record, 4.20 ERA**

- 26-year-old rookie is slated to make his 11th Major League start...has gone 3-3 with a 4.20 ERA over 20 appearances (10 relief outings and 10 starts) with SF.
- Received a no-decision on Sept. 13 in the Giants' 6-4 loss to the Padres...allowed one runs on six hits and two walks with one strikeout in 5.0 innings of work.
- Was recalled on Aug. 27 to take the rotation spot of **RHP Jake Peavy**, who was placed on the 15-day disabled list today (retro to Aug. 21) due to a low back strain...marked his third call-up by the Giants this season.
- Has posted a 1-2 record with a 4.15 ERA (24er, 52.0ip) in his 10 starts with the Giants this season...has allowed three earned runs or fewer in each of his outings.
- Has thrown more than 5.0 innings in only three of his 10 starts.
- Is the first Giants starting pitcher to hold opponents to three runs or fewer in each of the first 10 starts of his career since 2001, when **Ryan Jensen** did so in his first 11 starts.
- Is 2-1 with a 4.30 ERA (11er, 23.0ip) in 10 relief appearances.
- Opponents are hitting .240 (46-for-192) against him as a starter, but have posted a .308 clip (28-for-137) against him as a reliever.
- Owns a 3.12 ERA (12er, 34.2ip) at AT&T Park, compared to a 5.13 ERA (23er, 40.1ip) on the road.
- Had his contract purchased from triple-A Sacramento on May 6 and made his Major League debut May 8 against Colorado.
- A Venezuela native, Suarez signed with Tampa Bay at 16 years old in 2006...his made his professional debut in 2008, but he never pitched above double-A by the time the Rays released him after the 2014 season.
- Was signed by San Francisco as a minor league free agent this past offseason and has stepped into the swingman role vacated by **Yusmeiro Petit** in the offseason, serving as the team's primary long reliever and as the rotation's sixth man.

**NOTES:** Four-time All-Star will make his 32nd start of the season... is 14-9 with a 2.66 ERA, 231 strikeouts and 52 walks in 31 starts... last pitched Wednesday vs. San Diego and wound up with his ninth loss of the season after yielding just three runs on seven hits in 6.2 innings of a 3-1 Giants loss...tomorrow will mark the 10th regular-season matchup between LHP's **Madison Bumgarner** and Clayton Kershaw (third this season)...both pitchers have received seven decisions in these meetings; Kershaw going 3-4 with a 2.18 ERA (16er, 66.0ip) and Bumgarner 4-3 with a 2.88 ERA (18er, 56.1ip).

- 25-year-old was recalled from triple-A Sacramento on Sept. 1...has made one appearance (Sept. 5 at Colorado).
- Posted a 14-7 record with a 3.43 ERA (62er, 162.2ip) in 26 starts with triple-A Sacramento this season.
- His 14 wins tied the River Cats single season record (also: Graham Godfrey, 2011 and Justin Duchscherer, 2003).
