TONIGHT'S GAME: After evening the series with their walkoff win yesterday, the Giants turn to **RHP Jake Peavy** to help win this series...San Francisco is a MLB-best 20-8 (.714) since May 11 and have gained 5.0 games on the Dodgers.

ELIAS SAYS: Yesterday marked the second time in the last five weeks that the Giants won a game after falling behind in extra innings (also in 13.0-inning victory vs. Colorado on May 7)...San Francisco had only one such win in their previous seven seasons (2009-2015), when they defeated Colorado 6-5 in 10.0 innings on **Angel Pagan's** inside-the-park home run (*Elias*).

MR. CLUTCH: Following his third career walkoff hit yesterday, **C Buster Posey** is now hitting .370 (10-for-27) in Late-Inning Pressure situations this season... Posey is the only player in the Majors to have batted .300 or better in Late-Inning Pressure Situations in each of the last five seasons (*Elias*).

ONE RUN WINS: The Giants are 14-7 (.667) in one-run games this season...that's the second-best record in the National League, trailing only the Phillies' 15-5 (.750) record.

ON THE MOUND: **RHP Jake Peavy** makes his second-consecutive start on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball... Peavy enters tonight's game with 149 career wins and is looking to become just the sixth active pitcher in the Majors with 150 career wins.

AGAINST THE NL WEST: The Giants are 23-13 (.639) against the NL West this season, compared to a 14-13 record against the rest of baseball...SF has won 18 of their last 22 games within the division.

VS. THE DODGERS: San Francisco has gone 3-0-1 (win-lost-split) in their last four series against Los Angeles-NL here at AT&T Park and look to avoid losing their first series to the Dodgers in SF since Sept. 12-14, 2014...the Giants have won 12 of their last 16 games on the Shores of McCovey Cove against the Dodgers.

STARTING HAS BEEN STRONG: Since May 11, Giants starting pitchers have gone 13-4 with a 2.18 ERA (43er, 177.2ip) while giving up more than an earned run just nine times.

WITH THE BATS: San Francisco is hitting just .193 (70-for-362) in their last 11 games and is averaging 3.7 runs per games...the only team with a lower batting average than the Giants during this span is the Dodgers (.182).

BIRTHDAY WISHES: Happy birthday to Giants' **RHP George Kontos**, who turns 31 years old today.

UPDATED MILWAUKEE PROBABLES: The Giants host the Brewers for a three-game series starting tomorrow night...Milwaukee has adjusted their rotation and SF will now face RHP Chase Anderson (Monday), RHP Matt Garza (Tuesday) and RHP Jimmy Nelson (Wednesday).

SELLOUT STREAK AT AT&T PARK: The Giants have sold out their last 439 regular season games at AT&T Park (dating back to Oct. 1, 2010 vs. San Diego)...the Giants' sellout streak is the longest active home streak in the Majors.

This Date in Giants History: June 12, 2004

Barry Bonds hit a home run, the 675th of his career, and Rafael Palmeiro hit his 536th and 537th to move past Mickey Mantle into 11th place on the career list... it marked only the third time in Major League history that two players with 500 homers connected in the same game...**Willie Mays** and **Ernie Banks** did it in 1970, and **Mays** and **Hank Aaron** both homered in a game in 1971.

MANAGER BRUCE BOCHY

Bruce Bochy is in his 10th season at the helm of the Giants...his only predecessors to reach double figures were **John McGraw** (1902-32), **Bill Terry** (1932-41) and **Dusty Baker** (1993-2002)...SF has posted a 788-733 (.518) record during his 10-year tenure...his 1,739 victories are the highest total by an active manager and rank 16th on the all-time list...Bochy is one of 10 managers in ML history to win three World Series titles...the other nine are in the Hall of Fame.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#22 RHP Jake Peavy
6-1, 180, 35 years old (May 31, 1981)
2-6 Record, 6.41 ERA

- 2007 NL CyYoung Award winner and three-time All-Star is slated to make his 13th start of the season... is 2-6 with a 6.41 ERA (43er, 60.1ip) in his first 12 starts.
- Took the loss last Sunday in the Giants' 6-3 loss to St. Louis...allowed just one run in first 5.0 innings before yielding three runs in the sixth without recording an out.
- Enters tonight's game with 149 career wins...is looking to become just the sixth active pitcher in the Majors with 150 career wins (NYM's Bartolo Colon - 223, NYY's CC Sabathia - 218, CHC's John Lackey - 172, DET's Justin Verlander - 163 and ARI's Zack Greinke - 150).
- Is just 2-6 with a 6.41 ERA (43er, 60.1ip) in 12 starts this year, but has thrown better in his last three outings allowing just five runs in 18.2 innings of work (2.41 ERA).
- Peavy's 2.50 career ERA (55er, 198.0ip) against the Dodgers is the second-best mark among active pitchers (min. 75.0ip)...his 14 career wins vs. LA-NL are the most in MLB.
- Has gone 7-2 with a 3.86 ERA (34er, 79.1ip) in his last 14 starts at AT&T Park dating back to last season... SF has gone 11-3 in those 14 contests.
- His 35 extra base hits allowed are the second-most in the NL, while his 43 earned runs allowed are tied for the eighth-most in the National League.
- Opponents are hitting .359 (23-for-64) against with runners in scoring position, which is the fifth-highest mark in the NL.
- Since 2014, Peavy is 3-18 with a 5.16 ERA (114er, 199.0ip) before the All-Star break, compared to 14-7 and 2.94 ERA (57er, 174.2ip) after the break.
- Leads the Giants' rotation with a .222 avg. (4-for-18) this season.

- Is 0-2 with a 5.19 ERA (5er, 8.2ip) over his last nine appearances, going 2-for-3 in save chances during that span.

- Seven of his eight runs allowed this season have come here at home where he has a 4.20 ERA (7er, 15.0ip).
- Right-handed batters are 10-for-56 (.179) off him with 19 strikeouts.

- Has inherited 23 runners this season and has allowed two to score.
- Has faced 582 LH batters as a Giant and has allowed three HRs (Pedro Alvarez, Freddie Freeman, Corey Seager).
- His 802 appearances are the third-most among active players behind Francisco Rodriguez (883) and Chad Qualls (806).
