TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 3** (0-2) of a 3-game series vs **Red Schoendienst's Cardinals** and **Game 6** (1-4) of the Reds' first road trip of the 2015 championship season, an 11-day, 10-game jaunt to Chi's **Wrigley Field** (1-2), StL's **Busch Stadium** (0-2) and Mil's **Miller Park** (4g)...following this road trip the Reds return to **Great American Ball Park** for a pair of **3-game series** vs the **Cubs** and **Brewers** before the second road trip takes them on another 11-day, 10-game visit to **Atl** (4g), **Pit** (off day, 3g) and **WSox** (3g)...the Redlegs opened the season with a **4-2 homestand** vs the **Pirates** (3-0) and **Cardinals** (1-2).

SERIES NOTES: Including this one, in the **last 16 series vs StL** the Reds went **2-14**...including this one, Cin has lost the **last 14 3-game series** to the Cardinals, though the Reds earned a **4-game series win** (3-1) at Great American Ball Park **last September**...including this one, in the **last 34 series in St. Louis** since the start of the **2003** season the Reds are **3-29-2** - their only series wins here in **May 2003**, **June 2006** and **September 2011** - and in their **last 23 series in St. Louis** beginning **August 2006** the Reds are **1-21-1**...dating back to that **September 2011** Reds series win and including this one, the Cards have won the **last 9 series** under the **Gateway Arch**...in the **last 8 series** at **Great American Ball Park**, Cin went **2-6 vs StL**...**Reds vs Cardinals** info is on media guide **Page 312**.

ARCH ENEMIES: **Billy Hamilton** is **7-for-7** in stolen base attempts with Platinum & Gold Glover **Yadier Molina** catching, including **5-for-5** the last 2 seasons...Mil's **Carlos Gomez** has an active streak of **9 straight** successful stolen bases vs **Molina**, the most steals by any player overall vs the **All-Star catcher** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau)...beginning **4/11/12**, **Aroldis Chapman** has posted **1 win** and **11 saves** over **20 scoreless apps** vs the **Cardinals** (20.1ip, 6h, 5bb, 35k).

UPCOMING BREWERS SERIES NOTES: Since a **3-game Brewers sweep** at **Great American Ball Park** from **9/16-9/18, 2011**, the Reds won or tied **11** of the previous **17 series** vs Mil...the Brewers have won 14 of the last 22g vs Cin at **Miller Park**...in games vs the Brewers at **GABP**, the Reds have won **14** of the last **20g** and **32** of the last **45g**...**Reds vs Brewers** information is on media guide **Page 308**.

MILWAUKEE'S BEST: In **46 career games** at Miller Park, **Joey Votto** is batting **.319** (51-160, 9hr, 30rbi)...among hitters with a minimum of 160 plate apps, he ranks among all Brewers opponents at Miller Park in on-base pct. (**.444, 2nd**), walks (**36, 4th**), batting average (**4th**) and slugging (**.556, 5th**).

RUNNIN' REDLEGS: **Reds baserunners** are **12-for-12** in stolen base attempts, their best start on the basepaths since the **1987 club** started **15-for-15** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau)...**Billy Hamilton** leads the Major Leagues with **8 steals**...he became the first Reds batter with at least 1 stolen base in each of his first 4 apps of a season since Hall of Famer **Barry Larkin** began the **1988 season** with a steal in each of his first 6g (7sb).

RIGHT SIDE: **1B Joey Votto** & **2B Brandon Phillips** have made **849 starts together**, the most on the right side of the infield for any tandem in Reds history and second-most among active players behind Phi's **1B Ryan Howard** & **2B Chase Utley** (1,087)...**1B Frank McCormick** & **2B Lonny Frey** rank second in club history with **774 starts together**.

DOT, DOT, DOT...: The Reds will play 25 of their first 29g vs National League Central Division opponents and 20 of their first 32g on the road...**RHP Anthony DeSclafani** yesterday celebrated his **25th birthday**...bullpen coach **Mack Jenkins** turns **51** on Wed...on **4/29**, Major League Baseball will announce its media credentialing process for the **All-Star Game**.

STRAIGHT TO THE TOP: In last Sun's 11-inning, 7-5 loss vs StL, starting pitcher **RHP Raisel Iglesias** (pronounced rye-Sell) became first Reds player since **RHP Mike Leake** in **2009** to play in the Major Leagues without appearing in a minor league game and the **eighth Reds player** to do it...**Iglesias** and **C Bryan Pena** became the first Reds pitcher/catcher battery **born in Cuba** since **P Dolf Luque** threw to **C Manuel Cueto** in **1918** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau)...in anticipation of **Homer Bailey** coming off the disabled list to start **yesterday** and fill that spot in the rotation, **Iglesias** was optioned to Class AAA Louisville following his only start...his spot on the pitching staff was filled by relievers, first by **RHP Josh Smith** and then by **RHP Pedro Villarreal**, before **Bailey** came off the DL yesterday.

LINEUPS: In each of the first 5 games of this season Reds manager **Bryan Price** started his "projected" lineup of **C Devin Mesoraco**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Todd Frazier**, **SS Zack Cozart**, **LF Marlon Byrd**, **CF Billy Hamilton** and **RF Jay Bruce**...that lineup streak was snapped in **Game 6** on **Sun vs StL**, when **Bryan Pena** caught and **Brennan Boesch** played LF, and hasn't played together since then...for the **first time since 1989**, the Reds used the **same 8 starting position players** for the **first 5 games** of a season...only **12 times** in 2014 did the Reds start their "projected" lineup of **Mesoraco**, **Votto**, **Phillips**, **Frazier**, **Cozart**, **LF Ryan Ludwick**, **Hamilton** and **Bruce**...went **6-6** in those games and scored **69 runs** (5.75 r/g)...that 2014 "projected" lineup didn't play together after a 1-0 loss at SD on **6/30**...in 2014 the Reds used **130 lineups**, seventh-most in the National League and T14th-most in the Major Leagues.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER - RHP MIKE LEAKE

RED HOTS

Mike Leake doesn't turn 28 years old until November but already has made **5 Opening Day rosters**...tonight is making his **150th career appearance** and **145th career start**...with a career record of **53-42, 3.93** is 1 of only the 51 Reds pitchers with **50 victories**...since a relief appearance on **5/13/11 vs StL** has made **116 consecutive starts** (42-36, 3.79, 729.2ip, 307er)...his **69 career hits** are the most by any Major League pitcher since his debut in 2010...twice in his career led **National League pitchers** in batting average (**.356** in 2010, **.305** in 2012)...has 12 career multi-hit games, including **three 3-hit games** (7/9/10 at Phi, 4/17/13 vs Phi, 7/24/13 at SF) and nine **2-hit games**...has **4 career home runs**.
