**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Cardinals conclude their 10-game homestand tonight with the finale of a three-game weekend series with the Los Angeles Dodgers... tonight's nationally televised game on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball will begin at 7:08 p.m. CT, where 12,000 ticketed-fans, ages 15 & younger, will receive a Build-a-Bear Workshop Cardinals Bear upon entry.

**THIS HOMESTAND:** St. Louis is 6-3 during its current 10-game homestand against Miami (1-2), San Diego (4-0) & Los Angeles (1-1)...the homestand equals the longest in 2016 (also 4/29-5/8)...the Cardinals are in the midst of 17 games over a 17-day stretch, matching their 2nd-longest consecutive games/days log on the 2016 schedule (also 6/24-7/10); St. Louis has 20 games over a 20-day stretch from 9/2-21...tonight's homestand finale also mark's St. Louis' National League-leading 55th home game (25-29 record), which trails only Boston (56).

**LAST GAME:** The Cardinals ended a season-high five-game home winning streak with a 7-2 defeat to Los Angeles last night...Matt Adams hit a solo home run, while Stephen Piscotty recorded his team-leading 30th multi-hit effort.

**ON DECK:** The Cardinals begin a 10-game, 11-day, road swing through New York (NL), Miami and Cincinnati tomorrow, equaling their longest road trip this season (9/15-25 at SF, COL, CHI)...19 of their next 25 games (and 28 of their next 40) are on the road...the Cardinals are 27-16 (MLB-best .628 win percentage) on the road in 2016.

**MIKE MATHENY:** Mike Matheny is in his 5th season as the Cardinals manager, having taken his teams to the postseason in each of his first four seasons, the only manager in MLB history to do so...Mike has managed 43 postseason games, and has 21 postseason wins since 2012, 3rd-most wins among current Major League managers...in 2012 Matheny became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history and in 2013 he took his team to the World Series in just his second season at the helm with a league-best 97-wins...in 2014, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Central title and their 4th-straight trip to the NLCS...he led an injury-riddled team in 2015 to 100 wins, the best in the majors, and the N.L. Central Division title for a 3rd-straight season...Matheny, 45, had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252).

**REDBIRD RUNDOWN:** The 2015 N.L. Central Champion St. Louis Cardinals are in their 125th season of play in the National League...St. Louis enters tonight in second place, 2.0 games ahead of Pittsburgh and 6.5 games behind first-place Chicago in the N.L. Central...the Cardinals are 17-13 in their last 30 games, 12-8 in last 20, 7-3 in their last 10 & 4-1 in their last five...St. Louis' 12 July wins are tied for the most in the Majors (PIT, MIA, BOS, MIN)...the Cardinals hold a +98 run-differential, 3rd in the Majors behind Chicago (+149) & Washington (+113).

**MAYERS MAKES MLB DEBUT:** Mike Mayers (MY-ers), the Cardinals 2013 third round draft pick out of the University of Mississippi, had his contract purchased today and will make his MLB debut...the 24-year-old right-hander has made 18 starts (106.2 IP) between Memphis (AAA) and Springfield (AA) this season, where he was recognized as a 2016 Texas League Mid-Season All-Star and ranks among Cardinals minor leaguers in wins (T1st, 8), ERA (3rd, 2.62) and strikeouts (5th, 86)...the Grove City, Ohio native, will become the first pitcher to make a start for the Cardinals this season who was not a part of the team's starting five from the Opening Day roster...Mayers is the first Cardinals pitcher to make a start in his MLB debut since left-hander Tim Cooney (April 30, 2015 vs. Philadelphia)...to make room on St. Louis 25-man roster, reliever Miguel Socolovich was optioned to Memphis; the right-hander made two relief outings for St. Louis since his recall July 19, including 2.0 scoreless innings last night against the Dodgers.

**SUNDAY NIGHT LIGHTS:** The Cardinals, who are playing their 3rd ESPN Sunday Night game of the season this evening, are 50-45 all-time on the nationally televised Sunday Night game of the week and 5-3 all-time against the Dodgers (1-1 at home)...this season, the Cardinals were 5-2 winners at Dodger Stadium on May 15 and topped the Giants, 6-3, at Busch Stadium on June 5.

**START ME UP:** Since July 1, St. Louis' starting rotation leads MLB in ERA (3.16), strikeouts (118), win percentage (.769) & innings pitched (119.2), is T1st in wins (10, Boston) and fewest losses (3, Toronto), and T3rd in quality starts (11).

**AWESOME ALEDMYS:** Aledmys Diaz has reached base safely in a team-high 26 consecutive games since June 19...Diaz, Dustin Pedroia and Josh Donaldson are tied for the 2nd-longest active in MLB, trailing Jayson Werth's 27-gamer...Diaz's streak is the longest by an MLB rookie this season and a Cardinals rookie since Albert Pujols, who had streaks of 30 & 48 games in 2001...over the 26-gamer, Diaz is hitting .356 (36-101) with five homers, two triples, seven doubles, 20 RBI, 18 walks and 17 runs scored.

**DEEP THOUGHTS:** St. Louis has homered in a season-high 14 straight games (27 HR, 7/6-present), their most since a franchise-record 19 in a row 7/1-23/06 (31 HR); the active HR streak is T2nd-longest (BOS) behind SD's 21-gamer...St. Louis 135 jacks lead the N.L. and are two shy of last year's total (137)...St. Louis leads MLB with 51 HR in the 7th inning or later...214 of the Cardinals 498 runs scored have been via the long ball (43%) & their 29 July bombs rank 3rd in MLB...St. Louis' 18 HR since the homestand began July 15 lead MLB...Matt Holliday's career 22 HR vs. the Dodgers rank 2nd among active players (Paul Goldschmidt, 24).

## TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

**#59 MIKE MAYERS • RHP • 6-3 • 200 • 24 yrs**

### TONIGHT'S GAME:

- ◆ Makes his Major League debut tonight, the first Cardinals pitcher not among the starting five to begin the season, to make a start in 2016.
- ◆ Name is pronounced MY-ers.
- ◆ Is the first Cardinals pitcher to make his Major League debut in a start since Tim Cooney vs. PHI (4/30/15). Looking to become the first Cardinals pitcher to earn a win at home in his first MLB start since Jason Simontacchi (5/4/02) vs. ATL. Last Cardinals starting pitcher to win his MLB debut was Tyler Lyons at San Diego (5/22/13).
- ◆ Made 18 starts between Springfield (AA) and Memphis (AAA) with nine at each level. Combined to go 8-5 with a 2.62 ERA in 106.2 IP.
- ◆ Was scheduled to pitch in Memphis (AAA) last night, but was purchased today and starts on five days rest. Last start was at El Paso (7/18), tossing 5.0 innings allowing four runs on six hits with seven strikeouts in an 11-5 Redbirds loss.
- ◆ Was 3-3 with a 2.94 ERA (52.0 IP) at Memphis and 5-2 with a 2.30 ERA (54.2 IP) for Springfield.
- ◆ Threw 7.2 innings in his longest start of the season at Springfield vs. Midland (5/26), fanning a career-high 10 batters on 100 pitches.
- ◆ Threw 6.0 or more innings in five starts at Memphis and five at Springfield. Topped out at 101 pitches in his longest outing at Springfield (5/21 at Arkansas).
- ◆ Batted .200 (2-10) with two walks and two sacrifices in 14 plate appearances this season at Memphis.

### VS. LOS ANGELES DODGERS:

- ◆ Did not face the Dodgers Triple-A club (Oklahoma City) this season.

### 2015 SEASON & CAREER:

- ◆ Received an invitation to Major League Spring Training in 2015.
- ◆ Was 2-5 with a 4.87 ERA over 12 starts in 2015 between Springfield and the Gulf Coast League while recovering from two disabled list stints with right elbow strain injuries.
- ◆ Threw first professional shutout at Arkansas (5/2/15) allowing just four hits over 9.0 innings while at Springfield (AA).
- ◆ Ranked among 2014 Cardinals minor league leaders in starts (26, T2nd), innings (154.0, 3rd), strikeouts (117, T4th) and ERA (3.39, 6th).
- ◆ Earned four wins in his last four starts at Springfield in 2014, earning a promotion to make a start in Memphis and one in the Pacific Coast League playoffs vs. Omaha (9/6).
- ◆ Cardinals 3rd round draft pick in 2013 (93rd overall) out of the University of Mississippi. Was 12-9 with a 3.43 ERA in his college career with the Rebels. Made two appearances in the 2012 College Station Regional, including a win in a start against host Texas A&M, facing current Dodgers pitcher Ross Stripling.
