### St. Louis Cardinals (58-33) vs. New York Mets (47-44)

Game #92 ♦ Busch Stadium ♦ July 19, 2015

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Cardinals wrap up a three-game series against the New York Mets with the third and final game this afternoon at 1:15 p.m...the first 25,000 fans 16 and older entering today's game will receive a Kurt Warner St. Louis Rams V-Neck t-shirt as part of Christian Day...the Cardinals are 33-11 at Busch Stadium and 25-22 on the road this season...the team will hit the road for a quick two-game set in the Windy City against the Chicago White Sox for the first time since 2006, before returning to play a make-up rainout game vs. Kansas City (7/23) from June 14, then continue the homestand vs. Atlanta (3 games, 7/24-26), Cincinnati (3, 7/27-29) and Colorado (4, 7/30-8/2).

**MIKE MATHENY:** Mike Matheny is in the midst of his 4th season as the Cardinals manager, having taken his teams to the postseason in each of his first three seasons and becoming just the 15th manager in MLB history to record 275 or more wins in his first three years...won his 300th game on May 17 in game no. 523 to become the 6th quickest to 300 wins in MLB history...Matheny in 2012 became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history and in 2013 he took his team to the World Series in just his second season at the helm with a league-best 97-wins...in 2014, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Central title and their 4th-straight trip to the NLCS...he is the only Cardinals manager & just the 5th in MLB history to lead his teams to the postseason in each of his first three full seasons, having already managed 39 postseason games...Matheny, 44, had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL & SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252).

**BIRD WATCHING:** The 2014 N.L. Central Champion St. Louis Cardinals are in the midst of their 124th season of play with an 19-7-4 series record and are in 1st place in the N.L. Central, 4.5 games ahead of Pittsburgh...the Cardinals tied their season-high for runs in a 12-2 win over the Mets as Jason Heyward was 5-for-5 and Randal Grichuk reached base five times hitting two home runs with six RBI on the night...John Lackey improved to 8-5 with the win...the Cardinals are 25-games above .500 and own the majors top winning pct. (.637) and top run differential (+102)...they were a season-high 27 games over .500 (51-24) on June 28.

**"MEET THE METS...MEET THE METS...":** The Cardinals are 18-7 against the Mets at Busch Stadium since 2008, averaging 5.5 runs/game and 10.3 hits, and are 12-2 when rapping out double-digit hits against the Metropolitans over that span...during that stretch, the Cardinals have won or split every home series vs. the Mets with one three-game series sweep on Apr. 21-23, 2009.

**ROCKIN' RANDAL'S BIG NIGHT:** Randal Grichuk was 3-for-3 with 2 HR and 6 RBI last night...he became the first Cardinals rookie since David Freese (4/29/10 vs. ATL) to post 6 RBI and the first Cardinals rookie with 2 multiple-HR games in a season since Matt Adams in 2013...he reached base safely five times via 2 HR, 1B, IBB, HBP and became the first Cardinals player since Les Bell (4/18/1925 vs. CHI) to post that statline in one of his first 108 games.

**SPLIT DECISIONS:** Tim Cooney has not registered a decision since his first four starts of his career...he is the first Cardinals starting pitcher since Omar Olivares (8/18-9/8/1990) to not register a decision in his first four MLB starts and would be the first Cardinals pitcher with five in club history...he would tie Vincent Velasquez of the Houston Astros who also did not register a decision in his first five starts in the 2015 season.

**MORE MOLINA:** Yadier Molina has caught 11,597.1 innings in his career, currently ranking 2nd among active catchers behind A.J. Pierzynski (15,412.0)...he ranks 26th among all catchers all-time and is only 8.2 innings from passing former Cardinals catcher and current broadcaster, Hall of Famer, Tim McCarver (11,606.0) to move into 25th place all-time.

#66 **TIM COONEY** • LHP • 6-3 • 195 • 24 yrs

### TODAY'S GAME:

- ◆ Rookie left-hander is making his 5th Major League career/season start.
- ◆ Previous four MLB starts have all resulted in a no decision (STL 1-3).
- ◆ Today will be just his 2nd day start, as he threw 2.1 innings in his debut on 4/30. Is 0-0 with a 3.31 ERA in three night game starts this season (16.1 IP).
- ◆ Was added to the roster on July 2 when LHP Jaime Garcia was slowed by a left groin strain that eventually resulted in DL.
- ◆ Started the final game of the first half for St. Louis on Sunday night baseball, 7/12 at PIT. Did not get a decision after allowing 3 runs in 5.0 innings - a game the Pirates came back to win 6-5 in 10 innings.
- ◆ Was named to the Pacific Coast League All-Star Team along with teammate RHP Sam Tuivailala.

### VS NEW YORK METS:

- ◆ Is making his first career appearance/start vs. the Mets.

### 2015 SEASON:

- ◆ Threw 5.1 innings in Game 2 start of day-night doubleheader at CHI (7/7), allowing one run and left with a 2-1 lead before taking a no-decision in the Cardinals 5-3 loss.
- ◆ Had ND in the Cards' 5-2 loss in 11 innings to White Sox on 7/2, allowing 3 runs on 4 hits (2 HR's) in 6.0 IP.
- ◆ Lasted 2.1 innings in his 4/30 ML debut vs. PHI, throwing 52 pitches and allowing 3 runs. Took a no-decision in the Cardinals 9-3 win.
- ◆ Made 14 starts for Memphis, nine of which are quality starts. Allowed one earned run or less in eight starts.
- ◆ Pitched a complete game 6/2 vs. Las Vegas. Shut out the 51's 6-0 allowing 4 hits and 2 walks, with 4 K's in the 9.0 innings.
- ◆ His CG followed 7.0 shutout innings at Fresno (2H, 0BB, 2K) on 5/27.
- ◆ Was named PCL Pitcher of the Week on May 18 after allowing one run over two starts during the week of May 11-17. Had a no decision 5/11 vs. New Orleans, allowing one run over 7.0 innings in a 2-1, 10-inning win & earned the win 5/16 vs. Omaha with 7.2 shutout innings giving up just one hit.
- ◆ At the time of his recall, his 0.87 WHIP led all PCL pitchers and his 2.74 ERA at Memphis ranked 6th-best in the PCL.

### CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

- ◆ Was a 3rd round (117th overall) selection by St. Louis in the 2012 June first-year player draft.
- ◆ Led the Pacific Coast League with 14 wins in 2014, the first Memphis pitcher to lead the PCL in wins since St. Louis changed it's Triple-A affiliation in 1998.
- ◆ Carries a perfect fielding record through his minor league career, over four different classifications with 68 total chances.
