TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants visit the New York Yankees in the second game of this three-game series and the last leg of this three-city road trip... SF is winless in the first six games of the trip (0-3 at SD, 0-2 at BOS and 0-1 at NYY).

LOSING STREAK: SF has lost a season-high six-straight games, which is their longest losing streak since dropping seven-straight from Aug. 29-Sept. 4, 2015...the Giants are now just the second team to lose its first six games after the All-Star Game after being in first place at the break...the other team to do that was the 1991 Dodgers, who lost their first seven games after the break, finishing the season a game back of the Braves in the N.L. West (*Elias*).

INTHE STANDINGS: Despite their six game losing streak, the Giants' 57-39 (.594) record is the second-best in the Majors behind only the Chicago Cubs 58-37 (.611)...SF still holds a 4.0 game lead over the Dodgers in the NL West.

PITCHING STRUGGLES: San Francisco pitchers have struggled since the All-Star break, posting a 6.06 ERA (33er, 49.0ip)...they have surrendered 14 home runs during this span, which are second-most in the Majors since the break...SF had allowed just 81 long balls in the first half of the season, which were the third fewest among all clubs.

WITH RISP: The Giants are just 7-for-53 (.132) with runners in scoring position to begin the second half and are hitting just .136 (14-for-103) in these situations over their last 11 contests.

TOO MANY MISCUES: San Francisco has committed 10 miscues in their last seven games and 26 errors in their last 28 contests...the Giants committed only 29 miscues in their first 68 games of the season.

ONTHE MOUND: RHP **Johnny Cueto** has gone 14-6 with a 2.68 ERA (53er, 178.0ip) in 28 career Interleague outings...his 2.68 ERA in Interleague play is the third-lowest all-time among starters (min. 25 starts)...Cueto is 2-1 with a 2.25 ERA (6er, 24.0ip) in four career starts against New York-AL...he has made two career starts at the new Yankee Stadium, going 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA (4er, 12.0ip).

WITH THE DH: San Francisco designated hitters have combined to hit .478 (11-for-23) this season, which leads all Major League clubs.

JUST SCORE FIRST: The Giants are just 23-25 when their opponent scores first, compared to a 34-14 mark when they jump ahead...SF has not scored first once during their six-game losing streak.

REHAB UPDATE: **OF Hunter Pence** (hamstring) had a planned day off yesterday from his rehab and is slated to play today with triple-A Sacramento...**IF Joe Panik** (concussion) also received a day off, but continued doing side work with Sacramento...**IF Ehire Adrianza** (foot) has been transferred to triple-A Sacramento after hitting .333 with five HRs in nine rehab games with San Jose (A)...**IF Matt Duffy** (achilles) has been running comfortably the last four days during his rehab work in Arizona and could be ready for a rehab assignment next week...**RHP Cory Gearrin** (shoulder) is throwing with max effort and could also begin a rehab assignment next week.

MANAGER BRUCE BOCHY

Bruce Bochy is in his 10th season at the helm of the Giants...his only predecessors to reach double figures were **John McGraw** (1902-32), **Bill Terry** (1932-41) and **Dusty Baker** (1993-2002)...SF has posted an 808-746 (.520) record during his 10-year tenure...his 1,759 victories are the highest total by an active manager and rank 16th on the all-time list...is 10 wins shy of matching Jim Leyland for 15th place on the all-time list...Bochy is one of 10 managers in ML history to win three World Series titles...the other nine are in the Hall of Fame.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#47 RHP Johnny Cueto
5-11, 220, 30 years old (February 15, 1986)
13-2 Record, 2.64 ERA

- The two-time All-Star (2014 and 2016) has gone 13-2 with a 2.64 ERA, four complete games, 119 strikeouts and 27 walks in 19 starts...signed a six-year contract (through 2021) with SF this offseason (December 16).
- The Giants are 16-3 in his outings this season.
- Was named the NL's starting pitcher by manager Terry Collins for the 87th MLB All-Star Game here in San Diego...he became the eighth pitcher in Giants franchise history to start an All-Star game (ninth time).
- Took the loss in his first start after the All-Star break in the Giants' 5-3 defeat against the Padres...surrendered four runs on six hits and three walks with four strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...was battling the flu and sore left side during his outing...had his career-high streak of 10-straight winning decisions snapped.
- Has surrendered five home runs in his last four outings after allowing just two homers in his first 15 starts of the season.
- NL ranks entering today's games: Tied for first in wins, second in innings pitched and ninth in ERA.
- Is 8-1 with a 2.86 ERA (21er, 66.0ip) in 10 road starts this season...his eight road wins are tied with Jake Arrieta for the most among Major League pitchers/
- Has posted a 6.16 ERA (13er, 19.0ip) this season in the first inning, compared to a 2.07 ERA (27er, 117.1ip) in all other innings combined.
- Is averaging 106.0 pitches per start, which ranks second among NL pitchers (Bumgarner, 106.9).
- Is 2-1 with a 2.25 ERA (6er, 24.0ip) in four career starts against New York-AL...has made two career starts at the new Yankee Stadium, going 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA (4er, 12.0ip).
- Has gone 14-6 with a 2.68 ERA (53er, 178.0ip) in 28 career Interleague outings...his 2.68 ERA in Interleague play is the third-lowest all-time among (min. 25 starts).
