#### Pitching In

The Brewers have a Major League-best 2.25 ERA (128ip, 32er) with opponents batting just .211 (97-for-459), trailing only Seattle (.207) and Oakland (.210).

#### For Starters

Brewers starting pitchers have recorded a 2.60 ERA (90ip, 26er), trailing only Atlanta (1.80), Oakland (2.44) and Kansas City (2.58)....the starters have produced 10 quality starts in 14 games this season and opponents are batting just .228 (75-for-329).

#### Fine 'Penmanship

Brewers relievers lead the majors with a 1.42 ERA (38ip, 6er) and .169 opponent batting average (22-for-130)....the bullpen had a streak of 18.1 consecutive scoreless innings snapped last night.

#### Yikes!

The Brewers start the season by playing 16 of their first 19 games against 2013 playoff teams that had a minimum of 94 wins last season....this includes the world champion Red Sox and the National League champion Cardinals.

**TODAY'S GAME:** Is Game 6 (3-2) of a 6-game homestand vs. Pittsburgh (3-0) and St. Louis (0-2)....following this homestand, the Brewers travel to Pittsburgh for 4 games before returning to Miller Park for a 6-game, 7-day stay vs. San Diego (3g) and Chicago-NL (3g).

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** This season marks the first in which expanded replay is being used throughout Major League Baseball....the Brewers made their only challenge of the season on **4/9 at Philadelphia** (Revere safe call at second base overturned)....opponents have challenged twice this season: **3/31 vs. Atlanta** (Braun safe call at first base overturned) and **4/6 at Boston** (Bradley Jr. out call at first base confirmed)....opponents have also asked for one review: **4/12 vs. Pittsburgh** (Martin out call at first base confirmed).

**IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM:** LHP **Tom Gorzelanny** is on the 15-day disabled list recovering from offseason left shoulder surgery....he was placed on the DL on 3/30, retroactive to 3/21....

RHP **Brandon Kintzler** is on the 15-day disabled list with a strained right rotator cuff....he was placed on the DL on 4/12, retroactive to 4/9.

**BREWERS IN THE STANDINGS (16 days):** The Brewers have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 12, **SECOND:** 1, **THIRD:** 2, **FOURTH:** 1, **FIFTH:** 0....the team is currently in first place, 1.0 game ahead of the Cardinals.

**SERIES-LY SPEAKING:** The Brewers are 3-2-0 in series play, including the current series.... **Game 1:** 4-1, **Game 2:** 3-2, **Game 3:** 3-1, **Game 4:** 0-0....**Sweep Wins (3):** at Boston (3g, 4/4-4/6), at Philadelphia (3g, 4/8-4/10) and vs. Pittsburgh (3g, 4/11-4/13)....**Sweep Losses:** None.

**BREWERS AT HOME:** The Brewers are 4-4 at home, going 1-2-0 in series play, including the current series.

**BREWERS ON THE ROAD:** The Brewers are 6-0 on the road, going 2-0-0 in series play....the team is off to its first 6-0 road start since going 7-0 in 1987....the Brewers have already bested their longest road winning streak from last season (4g, 9/25-9/28)....the team has not won 7 in a row on the road since 7/18-8/2, 2008 (9g, franchise record - also 6/8-6/17, 1973).

**MANAGER:** **Ron Roenicke** (500g, 263-237, .526) is in his fourth season as a Major League manager, a position he was named to on 11/4/10, replacing **Ken Macha**....his contract runs through the 2015 season with a club option for 2016....his 2015 club option was exercised this Spring Training (3/22) and a club option was added for 2016....bio on p. 42 of the media guide.

**COACHES:** Each member of the 2013 staff returned for 2014: first base coach **Garth Iorg** (4th season), pitching coach **Rick Kranitz** (4th season), bench coach **Jerry Narron** (4th season), hitting coach **Johnny Narron** (3rd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (8th season, 4th as 3B coach), outfield coach **John Shelby** (4th season) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (3rd season)....coach **Mike Guerrero** was added to the 2014 staff during the offseason (9/28/13).

## TODAY'S STARTER: #38 - RHP WILY PERALTA (2gs, 1-0, 2.25)

**PERALTA AT A GLANCE:** Wily Peralta, 24, is making his third start of the season....he last started last Friday vs. Pittsburgh in a 4-2 win (7ip, 4h, 2r, 1er, 2bb, 4k, 1hr)....he is 8-7 with a 2.97 ERA over his last 19 starts dating back to last season (115.1ip, 38er)....Peralta was signed by Milwaukee as a non-drafted free agent on 11/26/05....bio is on p. 128 of the media guide.

**LAST SEASON:** Peralta went 11-15 with a 4.37 ERA in 32 starts last season, his first full season in the Major Leagues....he made 17 quality starts....the team went 14-18 in his starts....Peralta went 4-8 with a 6.08 ERA over his first 15 starts (80ip, 54er) but rebounded to go 7-7 with a 3.05 ERA over his last 17 starts (103.1ip, 35er)....he tied Kyle Lohse for the team lead in starts (32) and complete games (2).

**YOU COMPLETE ME:** On 7/9/13 vs. Cincinnati, Peralta notched his first career complete game in a 2-0 shutout (9ip, 3h, 4bb, 6k, 1hbp, 1wp)....it marked the Brewers' first complete game since 4/5/11 vs. Atlanta (Yovani Gallardo), snapping a Major League-record streak of 407 games without a complete game....Peralta recorded his second complete game in a 2-0 defeat on 8/11/13 at Seattle....he became the first Brewer with at least 2 complete games in a season since Yovani Gallardo had a pair in 2010.

**CAREER:** Is 14-16 with a 4.01 ERA in 40 games, including 39 starts (224.1ip, 100er)....made his Major League debut in 2012....last season was his first full season in the Major Leagues.

**CAREER AT MILLER PARK:** Is 9-8 with a 4.10 ERA in 21 games, including 20 starts (116.1ip, 53er)....went 7-8 with a 4.77 ERA in 17 starts last season (94.1ip, 50er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 5-8 with a 3.92 ERA in 19 starts (108ip, 47er)....went 4-7 with a 3.94 ERA in 15 starts last season (89ip, 39er).

**CAREER vs. CARDINALS:** Is 1-3 with a 7.71 ERA in 4 starts, all coming last season (21ip, 18er).

**CAREER AT THE PLATE:** Is a .127 (8-63) career hitter....has not homered (though he did twice this Spring Training) or driven in a run....has 1 walk and 27 strikeouts....batted .140 (7-50) last season with 9 sacrifice bunts....had 1 walk and 20 strikeouts....**2014 AT THE PLATE:** Is 0-for-2 with 2 strikeouts.
