TONIGHT'S GAME: The Cardinals conclude their six-game roadtrip tonight with the final of three games against the Los Angeles Dodgers...the team will look to avoid a sweep, the last time the Dodgers swept St. Louis was in 2012 at LA...the Dodgers scored 3 in the 5th last night to take the lead, and hold on for a 5-3 win...tonight ends this Los Angeles roadtrip vs. the Angels (3-0) and Dodgers (0-2)...first pitch is set for 7:05 p.m. CDT tonight as the featured game on ESPN Sunday Night baseball...St. Louis returns home following tonight's contest for a nine-game home-stand, opening the season with three straight home-stands with nine or more games...after an open date on Monday, the club will play three games each against Colorado, Arizona and Chicago Cubs.

MIKE MATHENY: Mike Matheny is in his 5th season as the Cardinals manager, having taken his teams to the postseason in each of his first four seasons, the only manager in MLB history to do so...Mike has managed 43 postseason games, and has 21 postseason wins since 2012, 3rd-most wins among current Major League managers...in 2012 Matheny became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history and in 2013 he took his team to the World Series in just his second season at the helm with a league-best 97-wins...in 2014, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Central title and their 4th-straight trip to the NLCS...he led an injury-riddled team in 2015 to 100 wins, the best in the majors, and the N.L. Central Division title for a 3rd-straight season...Matheny, 45, had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252).

▣ **REDBIRD RUNDOWN:** The 2015 N.L. Central Champion St. Louis Cardinals are in their 125th season of play in the National League...St. Louis enters the day 9.0 games back of 1st place Chicago & tied in 2nd place with Pittsburgh...the Cardinals are 6-4 in their past 10 games and 3-2 in their last five...the club holds a +46 run-differential, 3rd behind the Cubs (+110) and Boston (+58).

▣ **A PINCH OF THIS:** Jeremy Hazelbaker blasted his 3rd pinch-hit home run last night with a two-run shot in the 9th...his three pinch home runs lead the Majors (Chris Heisey, WSH & Matt Joyce, PIT) and the club's eight total pinch home runs pace MLB (Washington 6)...three pinch homers are the most a St. Louis Cardinals has hit in a single season, as Hazelbaker joins Matt Adams (2013), Marlon Anderson (2004), Ryan Ludwick (2007), Eduardo Perez (2002) and Gerald Perry (1993) for the Franchise record...the 1998 Cardinals recorded the most pinch homers in a single season at 10.

▣ **LOFTY HEIGHTS:** Catcher Yadier Molina played in his 1,500th career game yesterday, joining 25 active Major League players who have played 1,500 or more games...Matt Holliday ranks 14th on the list at 1,699 career games, while Alex Rodriguez leads active players at 2,739 games played...Molina is also just 16.0 innings shy of matching Ted Simmons' 12,335.0 innings caught for the Franchise record for innings caught...his current total of 12,319.0 innings as catcher ranks 20th on Major League baseball's all time innings caught list.

▣ **TAKE THAT TO THE DEAN:** Dean Kiekhefer made his Major League debut last night pitching 1.2 innings and struck out four before allowing a solo home run to Corey Seager...the last Cardinals pitcher with 4+ strikeouts in relief in his MLB debut was Kevin Siegrist on June 6, 2013 vs. Arizona who also fanned 4 in 1.2 IP (OR).

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- ◆ Makes his 8th start of the season, 180th start of his career (185 G).
- ◆ Will be making his 3rd start on ESPN Sunday night baseball. Has two previous starts while with CIN on Sun. night, both against St. Louis & Adam Wainwright: 5/25/14 vs. STL, 6.0IP, 2R and 4-0 STL win (Wainwright 8.0IP, OR) & 4/19/15 at STL, 8.0IP, 2R and 2-1 STL win (Wainwright 8.0IP, 1R).
- ◆ Earned his first win as a member of the Cardinals in last start vs. LAA (5/10). Allowed a season-low one run over a season-best 8.0 IP.
- ◆ Received team-low 30 runs of support this season; welcomed eight runs during his last start (5/10) after only 13 runs though his first six.
- ◆ Career 10-10 with 3.43 ERA, .271 OPP AVG in 31 May starts (34 app.)
- ◆ Signed as a free agent by St. Louis on Dec. 22, 2015, to a five-year deal with a mutual option for 2021.
- ◆ Attended Fallbrook Union (Calif.) High School, approximately 100 miles south of Dodger Stadium.

VS. LOS ANGELES DODGERS:

- ◆ Is career 3-4 with a 4.03 ERA (51.1IP) and 34 strikeouts in eight games (seven starts) vs. LAD since 2010 (w/ CIN & SF).
 - ◆ Was 1-1, 1.13 ERA (16.0 IP), .137 OPP AVG in 2 GS (w/ SF) in 2015.
 - ◆ Threw his first career shutout in his final start of 2015 vs. LAD (9/30) at AT&T Park. Allowed two hits and three walks with one strikeout the day after the Giants were eliminated from playoff contention.
 - ◆ Is career 14-12, 4.89 ERA in 37 games (35 starts) vs. the N.L. West.
- 2016 SEASON & CAREER:**
- ◆ Yielded four or more runs in his first six starts (6.03 ERA).
 - ◆ Started season 1-for-10 batting (.100), but ranks 2nd among active pitchers in career batting average (.209), trailing only Zack Greinke (.227) (min. 150 PA).
 - ◆ Allowed 4 runs on a pair of home runs over 5.0 IP in no-decision vs. PHI on 5/4. STL scored 2 in 9th for 5-4 win (first walk-off win of 2015).
 - ◆ Threw 7.0 innings in 5-4 loss to WSH (4/29), marking his second outing of at least 7.0 IP this season.
 - ◆ Cardinals won their first game in which he pitched on 4/24 at SD, an 8-5 victory (5.0IP, 7H, 5R, 3 ER, 4K, 2 BB).
 - ◆ Threw a season-high 7.0 innings in his 4/18 start vs. CHI, allowing four runs (3 ER) in a 5-0 loss at Busch Stadium.
