**TODAY'S GAME:** The 2015 National League Central Division Champions, who began their 125th season of play in the N.L. last Sunday, conclude a three-game weekend series against the Atlanta Braves with this afternoon's series finale at 12:35 p.m. CDT...today's game closes out a three-game series at ATL and a season-opening six-game roadtrip (0-3 at PIT, 2-0 at ATL)...the Cardinals open the home portion of their schedule tomorrow (April 11) when they will host the Milwaukee Brewers at 3:15 p.m. CDT.

**MIKE MATHENY:** Mike Matheny begins his 5th season as the Cardinals manager, having taken his teams to the postseason in each of his first four seasons, the only manager in MLB history to do so...Mike has managed 43 postseason games, and has 21 postseason wins since 2012, 3rd-most wins among current Major League managers...in 2012 Matheny became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history and in 2013 he took his team to the World Series in just his second season at the helm with a league-best 97-wins...in 2014, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Central title and their 4th-straight trip to the NLCS...he led an injury-riddled team in 2015 to 100 wins, the best in the majors, and the N.L. Central Division title for a 3rd-straight season...Matheny, 45, had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252).

▣ **REDBIRD RUNDOWN:** The 2015 N.L. Central Champion St. Louis Cardinals, who opened their 125th season of play in the National League last Sunday, meet the Braves today in the finale of a 3-game weekend series...the Cardinals, with a win today, would post their first 3-game series sweep in Atlanta since August of 1988...the Redbirds posted their first win of the 2016 campaign with a 7-4 come-from-behind win Friday night that featured a Major League record three pinch home runs...the Cardinals dropped all three games of their season-opening series at Pittsburgh, starting the season 0-3 for the first time since 2007.

▣ **FINAL TRIP TO "THE TED":** The Cardinals are playing their final regular season series at Atlanta's Turner Field this weekend...St. Louis is 26-43 (.377) all-time at "The Ted" which opened in 1997 after the Cardinals last played at Fulton County Stadium in the 1996 NLCS...the Cardinals are 2-0 in postseason play at Turner Field, winning in Game 3 of the 2000 NLDS and in their 2012 N.L. Wild Card game meeting.

▣ **HAPPY 10th BIRTHDAY BUSCH:** Busch Stadium III hosted its first Major League game on this date in 2006, as the Cardinals defeated the Milwaukee Brewers, 6-4, behind the pitching and hitting of starter Mark Mulder who gained the win and also homered...the Cardinals have won two World Titles (2006, 2011) & three N.L. pennants (2006, 2011, 2013) since moving into the downtown stadium and hosted Major League Baseball's All-Star Game in 2009.

▣ **FROSH PINCH:** Not only did the Cardinals set a Major League record with three pinch homers on Friday night, they also became just the second team ever to have a pair of rookies hit pinch homers in the same game, done once previously by the Mets' Clarence "Choo Choo" Coleman and Jim Hickman on 8/15/62 vs. Philadelphia. (Elias)

▣ **FAB FOUR:** The Cardinals matched their club high (3rd time) for homers in a game at Turner Field on Friday night (last done 9/9/10) with four, and for the first time in franchise history, they had four players, each with fewer than 100 career games played in the majors, homer in the same game (Elias)...of course Hard Hittin' Mark Whiten single-handedly hit four round-trippers himself at age 26 on 9/7/93 [2] at CIN.

▣ **DOING MORE WITH LESS:** The Cardinals 12-2 win last night was their first game scoring 12 or more runs with just three extra base hits and no home runs since also doing so in a 14-3 rout of the Giants in San Francisco on April 7, 2013 when they had 15 hits - 12 of which were singles.

▣ **KEEPING THEM GROUNDED:** Cardinals pitchers have yet to allow a home run in their first five games (44.1 IP), the only team in the majors to have not yet allowed a home run...it's the first time since 1970 that the Cardinals have started a season without allowing a HR in each of their first five games, having done so in their first nine games (82.0) that season before Bob Gibson allowed a pair of Cubs round-trippers to Ernie Banke and Johnny Callison at Wrigley Field on April 21.

- ▣ #4 YADIER MOLINA: Streak: 1G (1-5, .200) Series: 1-9, .111 Roadtrip: .200 (4-20)  
⇒ Made 12th straight Opening Day start, most every by STL catcher & most for STL since 13-straight by Lou Brock ('67-'79)...passed Ted Simmons this week for 1st in STL all-time games (1,441) & starts (1,383) as catcher...had 2 of 5 Cards hits last Sun.
- ▣ #37 BRANDON MOSS: Streak: 1G (1-3, .333) Series: 1-3, .333 Roadtrip: .182 (2-11)  
⇒ Loganville, GA native has HRed against every MLB team except ATL...was 4-for-7 (.571) w/2 2B's in series at ATL last Oct.
- ▣ #55 STEPHEN PISCOTTY: Streak: 2G (3-8, .375) HR Series: 3-8, .375, HR Roadtrip: .263 (5-19) HR  
⇒ Hit 1st HR of '16 on Fri. night...had 2 hits & OF assist at plate on Tue...had team-high .333 BA/17 hits in Spring...had sac fly for 1st career RBI in 1-0 win vs. ATL on 7/25/15...was 2015 STL Minor Lge Player of Year...had .393 BA w/RISP as rookie.
- ▣ #16 KOLTEN WONG: Streak: 4G (6-15, .400) Series: 4-9, .444 Roadtrip: .333 (6-18)  
⇒ Has reached base safely in 1st 5 games...signed 5-yr. contract ext. on March 2...had 3 hits & 3 runs in Sat. win at ATL...had .294 BA (5-17) vs. ATL in 2015...was first STL 2Bman w/back-to-back 10-HR seasons since Frankie Frisch (1927-28).

## TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#50 ADAM WAINWRIGHT • RHP • 6-7 • 235 • 34 yrs

### TODAY'S GAME:

- ◆ Will be making his 2nd start of the 2016 season today. Has 222 career starts, 287 appearances.
- ◆ Made his 5th career Opening Day start last Sunday at PIT in MLB's first game of the season. Allowed three runs in 6.0 IP, suffering a 4-1 loss.
- ◆ Snapped a 14.0 inning Opening Day scoreless streak when he allowed two runs to the Pirates in the 2nd. Is now 2-2 in five career Opening Day starts with a 2.37 ERA (8 ER/30.1 IP).

### VS. ATLANTA BRAVES:

- ◆ Has made 10 career starts in a total of 15 games against the Braves, holding an 8-2 career record with a 2.54 ERA.
- ◆ Did not start against the Braves last season, but pitched 1.0 scoreless inning each in two games at ATL during the final weekend of 2015.
- ◆ Is 4-1 in his 8 games/5 starts at Turner Field; has never allowed more than 3 ER in any of the games, with a 2.25 ERA.
- ◆ His last start against the Braves came on 5/7/14 at ATL when he pitched 8.0 innings and allowed a single run in a 7-1 win.

### SPRING TRAINING:

- ◆ Made a total of four official starts in Spring Training, (0-2, allowing 8 runs). Did start a 5th game on 3/29 vs. WSH, and pitched 3.2 innings before rain cancelled the game.
- ◆ Had only one scoreless spring start, his 1st start on 3/7 vs. NYM when he pitched 2.0 scoreless.

### 2015 SEASON & CAREER:

- ◆ Made four starts in 2015 before a ruptured Achilles injury in his right foot landed him on the DL (4/25).
- ◆ Missed 142 games before being activated on 9/30, and appearing in relief in Game 1 of a doubleheader at PIT. It was his first relief appearance since Game 5 of the 2006 World Series (10/27/06) and his first regular season relief appearance since 9/30/06 vs. MIL.
- ◆ Was the 2015 recipient of the prestigious Hutch Award.
- ◆ Became the 16th pitcher in Cards history to win 100 games (2014 Opening Day at CIN), and ranks 8th all-time in franchise history with 121 wins.
- ◆ Has two 20-win seasons (2010, 2014) and two 19-win seasons (2009, 2013).
- ◆ Has had three 200+ strikeout seasons (2009, 2010, 2013).

## TOMORROW'S STARTING PITCHER

#52 MICHAEL WACHA • RHP • 6-2 • 215 • 24 yrs

- ◆ Makes his 2nd start of the 2016 season tomorrow and his 60th career start, 65th career game.
- ◆ It will be his 2nd career home opener start for the Cardinals. Also started the club's home opener in 2014 vs. CIN, earning the win (5-3) after allowing a single run in 6.0 IP.
