St. Louis Cardinals (92-56) at Chicago Cubs (87-61)

Game #149 ♦ Wrigley Field ♦ September 20, 2015
Carlos Martinez (13-7, 3.02) vs. Jon Lester (10-10, 3.38)

TODAY'S GAME: The Cardinals play their final game of three at Wrigley Field and this season today and look for a win to avoid a sweep...it would be the first time the Cubs would sweep St. Louis since 2010... first pitch is 1:20 p.m...the Cardinals are ending their longest roadtrip of the year, a 10- game, 11 day trip to CIN (1-3), MIL (3-0) and CHI (0-2), including an off day last Mon. in Milwaukee...St. Louis is 5-5 in their last 10 games...St. Louis returns home for the final regular season homestand, seven games against CIN (3) and MIL (4)...St. Louis is 50-24 at Busch Stadium, the best home mark in MLB, and the franchise's 25th season with 50+ home wins...it is the 5th 50-win season at Busch III (2013-54 home wins, 2010-52, 2014-51, 2012-50); the all-time record for home wins was set in 1942 (60-17)...STL is 42-32 on the road, the best winning pct. (.568) in the Majors and tied with Chicago Cubs for MLB's best road mark.

SEPTEMBER STRETCH RUN: The Cardinals have 92 wins, reaching 90 wins for a 3rd-straight season, something they've done just once (2000-02) since 6-straight seasons from 1941-46...STL clinched a spot in the playoffs yesterday and have a magic number of 11 over the Pirates to clinch the NL Central title.

#54 JAIME GARCIA • LHP • 6-2 • 215

- ♦ Is making his 18th start of the 2015 season & 11th since his return from the DL on 7/27; he's been DL'd twice this season.
- ♦ Is 6-1 with a 3.02 ERA (10th NL) since August 1; Cardinals are 8-1 in his 9 starts during that span.
- ♦ Held on for a 5-4 win at MIL in his last start (9/16), pitching 6.1 innings and allowing four runs.
- ♦ Has thrown 6.0 or more innings in 16-of-17 starts this season with 13 quality starts and five starts without allowing an earned run.
- ♦ Cardinals have been shut out in all five of his losses.
- ♦ Was the first Cardinals pitcher to pitch into the 9th inning this season (8/14 vs. MIA).
- ♦ Is 10-4 with a 3.65 ERA in 16 career starts (18 app.) vs. Cincinnati.
- ♦ 7-1, 2.44 ERA over 9 career starts vs. CIN at Busch.
- ♦ Allowed a season-high 6 runs in a season-low 4.1 innings in his last start 9/10 at CIN, an 11-0 Cards loss.

BIRD WATCHING: The 2014 N.L. Central Champion St. Louis Cardinals are in the midst of their 124th season of play with a 29-13-4 series record & are in 1st place in the N.L. Central, 4.0 games ahead of Pittsburgh...the Cardinals scored 3 in the 9th, but lost 5-4 yesterday...Matt Carpenter hit his 24th HR, a 2-run shot in the 9th...St. Louis is 35 games over .500, owns the majors top winning pct. (.622) & the NL's best run differential (+109).

POSTSEASON BOUND: With a loss by San Francisco yesterday, the Cardinals are the first team in the Majors to clinch a spot in the postseason this year...the Cardinals have made the playoffs in a franchise record five consecutive seasons, extending the mark set last season when they reached the postseason in a record four straight...Manager Mike Matheny becomes the first manager in Major League baseball history to take his team to the playoffs in his first four seasons at the helm...he was the first Cardinals Manager to take his team to the playoffs in his first three seasons managing, 5th in MLB.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#18 CARLOS MARTINEZ • RHP • 6-0 • 185 • 23 yrs

TODAY'S GAME:

- ◆ Is set to make his 28th start in his 30th appearance of the season. It will be his 108th career game and 36th career start.
- ◆ Did not get a decision in the team's 3-1, 10-inning win last Tue (9/15) at MIL. Had an all-around excellent game, pitching 8.0 frames and allowing one run (solo HR K. Davis) on 4 hits with 9 K's, doubled and had a defensive gem on a sac bunt play.
- ◆ Ranks among the National League leaders in wins (13, T8th), winning pct. (.650, 8th), quality starts (19, T11th) & ERA (3.02, 1th)
- ◆ Leads Cardinals w/178 strikeouts (12th NL), 8th w/ 9.28 K's/9 IP.
- ◆ Has a 2.64 ERA since May 15, the 6th-lowest in NL.
- ◆ The Cardinals are 21-6 in his 27 starts this season, winning the first five, losing two, then winning 16 of the last 20.

VS. CHICAGO CUBS:

- ◆ Today is his first start at Wrigley Field. Has pitched six times in relief at the Friendly Confines (0-0, 2.84). Has pitched a total of 6.1 relief innings and allowed single runs in 2 separate occasions in Chicago.
- ◆ Is 1-0 with a 5.04 ERA in 13 app. vs. the Cubs; three starts all in 2015.
- ◆ Has faced the Cubs four times this season and is 1-0 with a 6.32 ERA in 3 starts (4 app.). Made a relief app. on Opening Day in CHI (4/5).
- ◆ Cardinals are 4-0 in the 4 games Martinez has appeared vs. CHI this year, including a 10-9 comeback win on 5/4 & 4-3 comeback win on 9/9, both in St. Louis.

2015 SEASON:

- ◆ Voted in by fans to the All-Star team as part of the Final Vote contest.
- ◆ Has induced a career-best 19 double plays this season (11th NL) and ranks 4th in the N.L. with a 55.1% ground ball percentage.
- ◆ Is 3-2 with a 2.38 ERA (15th NL) in 8 day starts/9 app. this season; 10-5, 3.31 in 20 games/19 starts. at night.
- ◆ Is tied for the N.L. lead among starting pitchers (Heston, SF) with a 28.6% SB rate, allowing just 2 SB this season in 7 ATT.
- ◆ 2nd among NL pitchers with .179 (28-156) Opp. BA w/RISP.
- ◆ Posted 11 straight quality starts from 5/20-7/25, 4th to Jake Arrieta (17, current), John Lackey (12) & Clayton Kershaw (12) for the longest streak during the 2015 season.
- ◆ Did not get a decision in the team's 4-3 win 9/9 vs. CHI in which he pitched 5.0 innings and gave up 3 runs. It was his 8th-straight start allowing 3+ runs & 5th time in his last 8 starts lasting just 5.0 innings.
- ◆ Took the loss 9/4 vs. PIT allowing four runs in 5.0 innings of a 9-3 loss.
- ◆ Earned his 13th win at ARI (8/27), allowing 3 runs on 4 hits over 6.0 IP with six strikeouts, in a 5-3 STL win.
