TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants and Pirates play game three of this four-game series, which is tied at one game apiece...after falling 1-0 in the opener, the Giants bounced back with a 15-4 win last night, recording a season-high in runs and hits (22).

WINNING WAYS: San Francisco enters tonight's game having won nine of their last 10 games...beginning May 11, they've gone 28-9 (.757) over their last 37 games, which is the best record in baseball.

GIANT INNINGS: The Giants scored seven runs in the fourth inning and five runs in the eighth inning last night...according to *Elias*, it marked the first time San Francisco had two innings with five or more runs in the same game since July 2, 2011, when they scored five runs in the first and third innings in a 15-3 win over the Tigers in Detroit.

GIANT HITS: The Giants' 22 hits last night were the most for any team in a game this season...it was the most hits they've had following a shutout loss since July 4, 1961, when they also rebounded with 22 hits against the Cubs.

ON THE MOUND: RHP Jeff Samardzija is coming off his eighth career complete game, allowing one run on four hits last Friday in SF's 5-1 win at Tampa Bay...Samardzija, who owns a 3-4 record with a 2.44 ERA (19er, 70.0ip) in 10 career starts against the Pirates, has fashioned a 1.26 ERA (7er, 50.0ip) in 11 games (six starts) here at PNC Park, the lowest ERA of any pitcher in the big leagues since 2008 with a minimum of 50.0 innings pitched in this facility.

STARTING HAS BEEN STRONG: Since May 11, Giants starting pitchers have gone 18-5 with a 2.13 ERA (56er, 236.2ip)...that's the lowest ERA by a starting staff in the big leagues since May 11.

WITH RISP: San Francisco is batting .319 (36-for-113) with runners in scoring position in their past 10 games.

DRAFT SIGNING UPDATE: The Giants have signed 24 of their 39 draft selections from the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, including inking 15 of their first 20 picks...top pick Bryan Reynolds remains unsigned.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Giants are 23-14 (.622) on the road this season, the third-best road winning percentage in the Majors behind Chicago-NL (22-12, .647) and St. Louis (22-12, .647)...beginning May 1, the Giants have won 19 of their last 26 road games.

BELOW .500: The Giants do not play a team that currently has a winning record until Boston - after the All-Star break...San Francisco's next 21 games are against teams under .500 (Pirates, Phillies, A's, D-Backs, Rockies, Padres)...SF is 30-14 (.682) against teams below .500 this season.

ROMO UPDATE: RHP Sergio Romo, who has missed the last 64 games with a right flexor strain, has made two relief appearances on a rehab assignment with Class A Advanced San Jose...he's tossed 2.0-scoreless innings with four strikeouts...Romo is slated to pitch again tonight with triple-A Sacramento.

This Date in Giants History: June 22, 1986

MANAGER BRUCE BOCHY

Bruce Bochy is in his 10th season at the helm of the Giants...his only predecessors to reach double figures were **John McGraw** (1902-32), **Bill Terry** (1932-41) and **Dusty Baker** (1993-2002)...SF has posted a 796-734 (.520) record during his 10-year tenure...his 1,747 victories are the highest total by an active manager and rank 16th on the all-time list...Bochy is one of 10 managers in ML history to win three World Series titles...the other nine are in the Hall of Fame.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#29 RHP Jeff Samardzija
6-5, 225, 31 years old (January 23, 1985)
8-4 Record, 3.14 ERA

- 2014 NL All-Star is slated to make his 15th start of the season...has posted an 8-4 record with a 3.14 ERA (33er, 94.2ip) over his first 14 outings.
- The Giants have posted a 9-5 record when he takes the mound and have won five of his last seven starts.
- Earned the win in his last start on Friday in Tampa Bay...threw his eighth career complete game (previous: Sept. 21, 2015 at DET), allowing just one run on four hits in the Giants' 5-1 victory over the Rays.
- Has allowed two runs or fewer in seven of his last nine starts, posting a 5-3 record with a 2.76 ERA (19er, 62.0ip).
- Opponents are are batting .220 (13-for-59) off him with runners in scoring position and are just 3-for-their-last-21 (.143).
- Has allowed an average of 1.90 walks per 9.0 innings, which ranks as the eighth-lowest figure in the league.
- Left-handed batters are just 5-for-their-last-27 (.185) off him.
- Owns a 4-4 record with a 2.25 ERA (21er, 84.0ip) in 21 career games (10 starts) against the Pirates... has received no runs of support in five of his last seven starts against Pittsburgh...faced the Pirates last season and received a no decision, despite allowing just two runs in 7.0 innings on June 18.
- Has pitched well at PNC Park over his career, posting a 4-2 record with a 1.26 ERA (7er, 50.0ip) and a .167 opponents average against...since 2008, his 1.26 ERA at PNC ranks as the lowest figure in the Majors (min. 50.0 innings pitched).

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP ALBERT SUAREZ

2016: 2-1, 3.69 ERA / Career: 2-1, 3.69 ERA

NOTES: 26-year-old rookie is slated to make his fourth Major League start against the Pirates...has gone 2-1 with a 3.69 ERA in six relief appearances and three starts...is taking the rotation spot of **RHP Matt Cain**, who was placed on the 15-day disabled list on June 14 due to a right hamstring strain...Cain suffered the injury in his start on May 27 at Colorado and reinjured the hamstring during his June 13 start against Milwaukee...Suarez relieved him and tossed 3.2 innings, allowing two runs on five hits (threw 56 pitches)...made his last start this past Saturday at Tampa Bay in the Giants' 6-4 win...tossed 4.2 innings, allowing three runs on five hits and two walks with four strikeouts...all the runs he surrendered came on three solo home runs...had not allowed a homer in his first eight career appearances...has posted a 4.50 ERA (8er, 16.0ip) in his three starts this season...has allowed three earned runs or fewer in each of his outings.
