### St. Louis Cardinals (81-73) at Chicago Cubs (98-56)

Game #155 ♦ Wrigley Field ♦ September 25, 2016

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Cardinals play their final road game of the regular season tonight at Chicago on ESPN Sunday Night game of the week, with a 7:08 CDT first pitch...St. Louis has traveled through San Francisco (2-2), Colorado (2-1) and Chicao (1-1) as part of this 10-game, 11-day trip...this trip is the team's 4th-straight 3-city trip and 5th of the season...the Cards own the top road record in Major League Baseball at 48-32, but are 33-41 at home.

**LAST GAME:** St. Louis won 10-4...Alex Reyes pitched 5.0 innings in the win (6H, 3R, 3BB, 6K)...they scored four in the first off a two-RBI double from Yadier Molina and two-RBI single from Randal Grichuk... Stephen Piscotty hit a solo homer in the 2nd and had three hits in the game (2RBI)...Johnny Peralta had three hits and scored three times...Yadier Molina drove in four runs total and had three hits... Randal Grichuk had three RBI and two hits.

**COMING UP:** The Cardinals return home to St. Louis following tonight's game for the final seven games of the regular season, all seven against N.L. Central opponents...the club will host the Cincinnati Reds for four games, Monday through Thursday, followed by three games vs. the Pittsburgh Pirates over the final weekend to end the regular season.

**WILD CARDS:** St. Louis enters the day in third place for the NL Wild Card spot, 0.5 game behind both the New York Mets and San Francisco Giants.

**MIKE MATHENY:** Mike Matheny is in his 5th season as Cardinals manager, having taken his teams to the postseason each of his first four seasons, the only manager in MLB history to do so...in 2012 he became the 49th manager in St. Louis history, took his team to the World Series in 2013, guided the Cardinals to the NL Central title and 4th-straight trip to the NLCS in 2014 and led an injury-riddled team in 2015 to a MLB best 100 wins and the NL Central Division title for a 3rd-straight season...Matheny, 45, had a 13-year Major League career with MIL, TOR, STL, SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252).

**REDBIRD RUNDOWN:** The 2015 N.L. Central Champion St. Louis Cardinals are in their 125th season of play in the National League...St. Louis began the day in second place in the N.L. Central, 17.0 games behind the 2016 N.L. Central Division Champion Chicago Cubs and 3.0 games in front of Pittsburgh...the Cardinals are 14-16 in their last 30 games, 10-10 in last 20, 5-5 in their last 10 & 3-2 in their last five...St. Louis holds a +60 run-differential, 4th in the N.L.

**UNDER THE LIGHTS:** The Cardinals have won nine of their last 13 night games vs. the Cubs at Wrigley Field, since July 14, 2013...St. Louis is 3-1 in 2016 in games played at night in the Friendly Confines.

**SUNDAY NIGHTS:** The Cardinals and Cubs have played 16 games on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball at Wrigley Field with the series tied at 8-8...Cardinals have won the last 7 games on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball at Wrigley...Manger Mike Matheny has never lost an ESPN Sunday Night Game at Wrigley Field (4-0).

**IN THE PINCH:** The Cardinals .329 average (75-228) in the pinch is tops among all MLB teams as their 75 hits far out pace the Rockies in 2nd with 58 hits...STL pinch hitters have collected 46 RBI (Pittsburgh 2nd w/37) and the team's 15 pinch home runs is a new MLB season record...the club has a .395 OBP and .596 SLG when pinch hitting.

**SHARING HOMERUNS:** When Matt Adams hit his 15th home run Tuesday he gave the Cardinals team eight different players with 15 or more home runs...that sets both a team and National League record (8 players with 15+ homers)...ten different N.L. teams have had seven players with 15 or more homers, the last being the 2009 Rockies...the 2000 St. Louis squad had seven players with 15 or more home runs (Drew, Edmonds, Lankford, McGwire, Paquette, Renteria, Tatis). *Orf*

**COMEBACK KID:** The Cardinals own the Major's best mark in wins when trailing after the 6th at 14-59 (.197 pct.).

# TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

#18 CARLOS MARTINEZ • RHP • 6-0 • 191 • 24 yrs

## TONIGHT'S GAME:

- ◆ Is making his 30th start of the season, a career high. It is his 66th career start (139th app).
- ◆ Leads all National League pitchers with 32 double plays induced and 1.58 GDP/9 IP. Is two GDP shy of the franchise record set by John Denny (34) in 1978...2nd the N.L. with a 57.5 ground ball percentage (Jaime Garcia leads at 58.2 & Mike Leake is 3rd at 53.7).
- ◆ Celebrated his 25th birthday last Wednesday (born 9/21/91 in Puerto Plata, Dominican Republic).
- ◆ Boasts an 9-1 record in 14 road starts (89.1 IP) this season, tops with the highest win pct (.900) in N.L. Has not suffered a road loss since 5/14 at LAD (is 5-0 with a 2.12 ERA since; STL is 6-3).
- ◆ Earned his career high 15th win at COL in his last start (9/19), pitching 5.0 innings in a 5-3 win. Allowed 2 runs on five hits and struck out six.
- ◆ Allowed 2 runs or less in 6 of his last 7 starts (5-1, 2.60 ERA, 45.0 IP, 47 K). Since 8/17, ranks 4th in wins among NL pitchers (3w/6 wins), 6th in strikeouts and 11th in ERA.
- ◆ Ranks T7th in the National League in wins (15), 13th in quality starts (18), 12th in ERA (3.16) and average against (.234).
- ◆ Has allowed only 14 HR this season (3 HR vs. RHB in 313 AB) and ranks 5th among N.L. pitcher in HR/9 IP (0.69) (Syndergaard, 0.56).
- ◆ Leads Cardinals with 13 starts of 7.0 innings or more (9-1, 1.79 ERA).
- ◆ Ranks 9th among N.L. pitchers with a .208 Opp. BA vs. RH batters, while ranking 1st in the circuit in Opp. Slug (.262) vs. RH batters.
- ◆ Limiting the opposition to a .150 BA (15-100) in the 1st inn. of starts.
- ◆ Ranks T4th among NL pitchers with 11 hit batsmen.
- ◆ Is 4th among MLB pitchers with a career-high 14 hits, T3rd in BA (.250) and T7th w/6RBI. Had 11 hits in 60 career AB's entering 2016.

## VS. CHICAGO CUBS:

- ◆ Is 3-2 with a 4.85 ERA in 18 career app. (8 GS) vs. Chicago. His last eight appearances since 5/4/15 have all been starts.
- ◆ As a starter, is 3-2 with a 5.56 ERA and 49 strikeouts (8GS, STL is 5-2). Logged a 2.61 ERA (10.1 IP/3 ER) and eight strikeouts in 10 career relief outings vs. CHI.
- ◆ Only three of his eight starts have come at night. Is 1-0 with a 6.23 ERA in those starts (team is 2-1), the last 2 have been quality starts.
- ◆ In his last start vs. CHI at Busch (9/14), allowed four runs in a 7-0 shutout loss, but struck out nine.
- ◆ Has just two starts at Wrigley and is 1-0 with a 3.55 ERA, with 2 QS.
- ◆ Has made just one start at Wrigley this season. Charged with three runs over 6.0 IP in no-decision in STL's extra-inning, 4-3 loss to the Cubs at Wrigley on 8/11. All three runs allowed came from five singles in the 6th inning.
