St. Louis Cardinals (32-17) vs. Los Angeles Dodgers (29-19)

Game #50 ♦ Busch Stadium ♦ May 31, 2015

TODAY'S GAME: The Cardinals play the final and rubber game of this 3-game series against the Los Angeles Dodgers...first pitch is 1:15 p.m. with all ticketed kids 15 and younger entering today receiving a pair of Cardinals elite socks...LA and STL will meet in just four days and play seven of the next 10 games on the schedule as the Cards travel to Los Angeles this coming Thursday-Sunday...Michael Wacha carried a no-hitter into the 6th, but allowed 4 runs in that frame as the Cards lost 5-1...St. Louis is 4-1 so far during the 9-game, 10-day homestand with games against Arizona (3-0), Los Angeles Dodgers (3 games) and Milwaukee Brewers (3 games)... Wednesday ended a stretch where the Cardinals played 36 games in 37 days (April 21-May 27), while the Birds are currently in a spot on the schedule in which they play 13 of 16 games against Western Division opponents, the first time facing the West this season.

MIKE MATHENY: Mike Matheny has begun his 4th season as the Cardinals manager, having taken his teams to the postseason in each of his first three seasons and becoming just the 15th manager in MLB history to record 275 or more wins in his first three years...won his 300th game on May 17 in game no. 523 to become the 6th quickest to 300 wins in MLB history...Matheny in 2012 became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history and in 2013 he took his team to the World Series in just his second season at the helm with a league-best 97-wins...in 2014, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Central title and their 4th-straight trip to the NLCS...he is the only Cardinals manager & just the 5th in MLB history to lead his teams to the postseason in each of his first three full seasons, having already managed 39 postseason games... Matheny, 44, had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252).

BIRD WATCHING: The 2014 N.L. Central Champion St. Louis Cardinals are in the midst of their 124th season of play with a 10-3-2 series record and are in 1st place in the NL Central, 6.0 games ahead of Chicago...St. Louis snapped a 5-game win streak with a 5-1 loss last night...Michael Wacha had a no-hit game until allowing 4 runs on 3 hits in LA's 6th...Cardinals scored their lone run after an error in the 1st...St. Louis is 19-6 at Busch Stadium & 13-11 on the road...the Cards own the Major's top winning pct. (.653) and the Major's best run differential (+58). **HOMEBODY:** The 19 wins with just 6 losses at home this season is the best start at home in Cardinals history.

EVERY DAY'S A HOLIDAY: Matt Holliday extended his on-base streak to a National League and Franchise best 44 games to begin the season with a walk in last night's contest...former teammate Albert Pujols had reached in 42-straight to begin 2008...the Yankee's Derek Jeter reached a Major League best 53-straight games to begin 1999...Jeter passed Frank Thomas' mark of 52-straight the Big Hurt set in 1996, the same year that Mark McGwire reached in 48-straight (3rd on MLB All-Time list)...over the past two seasons Matt's streak stands at 46 games, the longest Cardinals streak since Jim Edmonds reached in 47-straight games during 2004.

ONE YEAR AGO TODAY: On May 31, 2014, Cardinals top prospect Oscar Taveras made his Major League debut and gave his supporters proof of his talent with a solo blast in his second at-bat to give the team a 1-0 lead over San Francisco (eventual 2-0 win)...on October 12, last season during the N.L. Championship series, again facing San Francisco, Taveras pinch-hit in the bottom of the 7th and lifted a home run out of the park to right to tie the game at 3-3 and putting St. Louis on the path to a 5-4 win in Game 2, giving Taveras home runs in his first and last game at Busch Stadium...today, the team remembers what Taveras, who passed away in a car accident October 26, 2014, in the Dominican Republic, contributed to the club...his family (mother from the Dominican and father from Canada) will take part in a pre-game ceremony in which they will receive a commemorative hard-bound book with images of Oscar's time with the Cardinals...the Cardinals are renovating a baseball field in Oscar's hometown of Sosua.

PITCHING AT THE TOP OF THE CLASS: The Cardinals lead MLB with a 2.76 combined ERA...St. Louis starters lead all clubs with a 3.07 ERA, while Cardinals relievers rank 2nd in the Majors with their 2.18 ERA (KC 1.85)...the pitching staff has combined for 10+ strikeouts 18 times this season. **HITTERS GONNA HIT:** Four Cardinals rank among the top-14 National League players in batting with Matt Carpenter .318 (T6th), Matt Holliday .318 (T6th), Kolten Wong .311 (12th) and Jhonny Peralta .304 (14th)...St. Louis hitters combined .267 average is 2nd-best in the N.L. (SF .273).

#18 CARLOS MARTINEZ • RHP • 6-0 • 185 • 23 yrs

TODAY'S GAME:

- ◆ Is making his 10th start and 11th appearance of the season today.
- ◆ Is unscored upon in his past two starts, building a 13.1 scoreless innings streak - a season high for the Cardinals.
- ◆ The Cardinals are 7-2 in his nine games started this season, winning each of the first five.
- ◆ Is 3-2, 4.56 ERA (51.1 IP/26 ER) in 10 career starts at Busch Stadium; Cardinals are 7-3 in those 10 starts.

VS. LOS ANGELES DODGERS:

- ◆ Is 0-1 with a 5.14 ERA (14.0 IP, 13 K's) in four career games (3 starts) vs. the Dodgers.
- ◆ Cardinals are 1-2 in his three regular season starts vs. LAD, but 5-0 in his five career games pitched vs. Dodgers in the postseason.
- ◆ All five of his postseason appearances vs. Dodgers have been in relief; 0-0, 1.50 ERA (6.0 IP) with 2 Holds.

2015 SEASON:

- ◆ Is averaging 9.45 strikeouts/9.0 IP this season, 10th in the N.L. Also has 4.05 walks/9.0 IP which is 5th most among N.L. qualifying pitchers
- ◆ Has a 2.55 ground ball/fly ball ratio, ranking 8th among N.L. hurlers.
- ◆ Is averaging 6.08 runs of support per game, 6th in the N.L.
- ◆ Throws 16.6 pitches/inning, 10th most among N.L. qualifying starters (teammate Lance Lynn ranks 3rd, 17.3).
- ◆ Blanked ARI for 7.0 IP with 8 K's in Cards 3-2 win in 10 innings last Mon. (5/25) on Memorial Day, taking a no-decision.
- ◆ Improved his record to 4-2 with a 9-0 combined shutout of the Mets at Citi Field on 5/20.
- ◆ Allowed just 2 runs over 5.0 IP vs. Detroit on 5/15 for his second loss, leaving the game trailing 2-0 in a 10-4 Tigers' win.
- ◆ Allowed seven runs over 5.1 innings at PIT on 5/9, his first loss of the season, 7-5 at PNC Park. Second straight start allowing seven runs.
- ◆ Received a no decision after allowing a career-high seven runs on nine hits in his shortest MLB start (3.2 IP), vs. CHI 5/4. Threw a career-high 102 pitches, a game the Cardinals rallied to win 10-9.
- ◆ Picked up his 3rd-straight win in his 4th QS, 4/29 vs. PHI, a 5-2 win. Pitched 6.0 innings and allowed both Philly runs. Snapped an 11.1 inning scoreless streak from the final inning of his 4/18 start vs. CIN until he allowed a solo HR in the 4th to Ryan Howard.
- ◆ Pitched career high 7.0 shutout innings at MIL on 4/24 earning his 1st win against the Brewers, 3-0. Gave up 4 hits with 2 walks and struck out a career high 9 batters.
