### St. Louis Cardinals (65-57) at Philadelphia Phillies (58-66)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Cardinals play the final game of this three game series at Philadelphia, the final game of a 9-game (CHI 2-2, HOU 2-0, PHI 1-1), 11 day trip...the Cardinals began this trip with a split of a four-game series at Chicago Cubs and won both games of a two-game set at Houston...St. Louis enters today's game tied with Washington for the best road record in MLB (37-24)...the Cards have two roadtrips remaining after this trip (21 games), each one a three-city jog and have 20 home games (6 in August & 14 in Sept./ Oct.) remaining.

**LAST GAME:** Jeremy Hazelbaker hit a two-run home run in the 3rd but that was all the scoring the Cardinals would have, losing 4-2...Luke Weaver made his 2nd MLB start and allowed 3 runs over 5.0 IP, striking out six and walking none...Jhonny Peralta had his first 3-hit game of the season.

**COMING UP:** The Cardinals return home and will enjoy an open day Monday before beginning a six-game homestand vs. NYM (3 games) and OAK (3).

**WILD CARDS:** Entering today, St. Louis is 2.0 games behind Los Angeles in the N.L. Wild Card race.

**MIKE MATHENY:** Mike Matheny is in his 5th season as Cardinals manager, having taken his teams to the postseason each of his first four seasons, the only manager in MLB history to do so...Matheny has managed 43 postseason games, with 21 postseason wins since 2012, 3rd-most wins among current MLB managers...in 2012 he became the 49th manager in St. Louis history, took his team to the World Series in 2013, guided the Cardinals to the NL Central title and 4th-straight trip to the NLCS in 2014 and led an injury-riddled team in 2015 to a MLB best 100 wins and the NL Central Division title for a 3rd-straight season...Matheny, 45, had a 13-year Major League career with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252).

□ **REDBIRD RUNDOWN:** The 2015 N.L. Central Champion St. Louis Cardinals are in their 125th season of play in the National League...St. Louis began the day in second place in the N.L. Central, 13.0 games behind first-place Chicago and two games in front of Pittsburgh...the Cardinals are 17-13 in their last 30 games, 10-10 in last 20, 6-4 in their last 10 & 4-1 in their last five...St. Louis holds a +72 run-differential, 3rd in the N.L. behind CHI (+215) & WSH (+146).

□ **EXTRA EXTRAS:** With two doubles and a home run last night, St. Louis tied a team record with 13 consecutive games with at least three extra-base hits, also doing so May 3-16, 1959. *Orf*

□ **NINE WITH 10+ HOMERS:** Jeremy Hazelbaker's third-inning home run yesterday was his 10th on the season as he became the ninth Cardinals player with 10 or more home runs...nine players with 10+ homers ties the club record for a single season with the 2000 team who also had nine with 10+ (Will Clark, JD Drew, Shawon Dunston, Jim Edmonds, Ray Lanford, Mark McGwire, Craig Paquette, Edgar Renteria and Fernando Tatis) and is currently the most in the Majors...the MLB record is 11 players with 10 or more home runs done by the 2004 Detroit Tigers & 2015 Houston Astros.

□ **DOUBLE HOMERS:** The 2016 Cardinals tied the Major League mark and set the National League record with two or more home runs in nine straight games joining Cleveland-1962, Baltimore-1987, 1996 and New York Yankees-2009...the streak began August 9 vs. Cincinnati for St. Louis, who had 19 home runs during that span...the club also hit two or more homers in seven-straight road games, a club record...St. Louis has a current 10 game home run streak in tack, and homered in a season-high 17 straight earlier this season (7/6-26).

□ **A RECORD FEAT FOR GYORKO:** Jedd Gyorko became the first Cardinals to hit a home run while playing each of the four infield positions during a single season when he homered Friday as shortstop...only two other Cardinals have ever done so over multiple seasons during their career with St. Louis: Jake Flowers (1926-32) and Rogers Hornsby (1916-33).

⇒ DH Wed for 1st time (1-4) in '16 & just 2nd career (3-9)...has batted 3rd since Holliday DL, 7x in '16 (7-28)...ranks 5th among NL leaders in OPS (.941), 4th in OBP (.4004, w/ .537 slugging...6th in walks (64) and 8th triples (6)...leads NL w/ .353 avg in 7ing+...hit lead-off HR 8/10 vs. CIN (2nd season, 11th career) & also tripled...missed 24 G's 7/7-8/4 (right oblique)...has 18 multi-walk games...earned 3rd N.L. All-Star selection...had 18-game on-base strk (6/3-26)...NL Player of Week 5/30

□ **#15 RANDAL GRICHUK:** Streak: 0-3 Series: 3-8, .375 Road Trip: .345 (10-29) 3 HR  
⇒ Ended 7-gm hit streak yet, .385 (10-26) w/3HR...HR & Gwing RBI 2B part of 3-hit gm Fri...had 8-straight extra base hits 8/11-19...2-2B & 3B in HOU series...36 of 68 hits are extra-bases...hit 1st MLB grand slam on 25th birthday 8/13 at CHI...hit PH-HR (3rd career) 8/11 in 7th, 1st AB after recall from Memphis (AAA)...has 2 stints in Triple-A (23 G, .272, 6 HR, 18 RBI).

⇒ HR in 4 of last 7 GS & 3 of 4 in CHI series...4th season w/20+ HR...42 of 75 (56%) hits are XBH...had RBI in career high 5 straight 8/7-11 & has RBI in 9 of last 11 GS...has 25 two-out RBI, 2nd on team...leads NL with .710 SLG w/RISP...activated off DL (left ankle) on 8/2 and was 3-5 w/HR at CIN...T4th in MLB PH RBI (7), T2nd PH HR (3); 6-19 in PH role.

□ **#27 JHONNY PERALTA:** Streak: 3G (5-13, .385) Series: 4-9, .444 Road Trip: .240 (6-25)  
⇒ 1st 3-hit gm of season last night...1st PH of season 8/12 (5-25 career)...batting .314 (16-51, HR) in Aug...hit 200th career HR 8/10...missed 16 Gs (left thumb strain) 7/19-8/1 & missed 57 G to begin season (left thumb surgery)...33 starts at 3B, 7 at SS.

## TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#8 MIKE LEAKE • RHP • 5-10 • 170 • 28 yrs

### TODAY'S GAME:

- ◆ Makes his 25th start of the season (197th career GS/202nd app).
- ◆ Recorded his 100th strikeout in his last start giving him 6-straight seasons with 100 strikeouts.
- ◆ Did not get a decision in his start last Sunday (8/14), a 6-4 come-from-behind Cardinals win, pitched 6.0 innings and allowed 3 runs.
- ◆ Tops among National League pitchers with a 1.43 BB/9 IP ratio and 0.37 walks per batter faced.
- ◆ Did not walk a batter in the month of July (30.0 IP) as part of a career-best 36.0 inning streak without a walk issued, longest in MLB this season.
- ◆ His 36.0 inning walk-less streak ranks as T3rd-longest in Cardinals history (Bob Tewksbury 1st, 44.0 IP 6/20-7/17/1993).
- ◆ Has walked one batter or less in 19 of 24 outings this season, including a five-start streak. Has issued zero walks in nine of his starts.

### VS. PHILADELPHIA PHILLIES:

- ◆ Is 2-3 in nine career starts vs. Philadelphia with a 6.11 ERA (team is 3-6). Has allowed more than 3 runs in six of those starts.
- ◆ In four starts since 2013 is 2-0 w/ 2.77 ERA (26.0 IP/8 ER) and 23 K's.
- ◆ St. Louis scored 2 in the bottom of the 9th to win 5-4 in his start on 5/4 of this year in which he allowed 4 runs over 5.0 IP.
- ◆ Has made three starts at Citizens Bank Park and is 0-1 with a 6.10 ERA (14 ER/20.2 IP).

### 2016 SEASON & CAREER:

- ◆ Leads MLB pitchers in total chances (57), putouts (23), T2nd in double plays (4) and is 4th in assists (30).
- ◆ Ranks 2nd among active pitchers in career batting avg. (.205), trailing Zack Greinke (.223) (min. 300 PA); Adam Wainwright (.196) is 4th.
- ◆ Has allowed 26 runs in his last five starts (1-2, 8.04 ERA).
- ◆ Had a no decision in STL vs. CIN (8/9) in a quality start allowing three runs over 6.0 IP w/no strikeouts and season-high 4 walks, a 7-4 loss.
- ◆ Faced the Reds at CIN (8/4), allowing a season-high seven runs on eight hits over 5.0 innings in a 7-0 Cardinals loss.
- ◆ Gave up six runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings in St. Louis' 11-6 win at MIA (7/29). Struck out three and walked none.
- ◆ Surrendered 12 hits in a loss in his 7/23 start vs. LAD, tying his career-high (7/24/13 at SF w/CIN). The seven runs were his most since joining the Cardinals.
- ◆ Won his 2nd -straight start with a 10-2 win over SD on 7/18, striking out 11 of 24 batters faced in 6.0 IP with no walks allowed; joined Bob Gibson as only Cardinals to have consecutive starts with 10 or more K's and no walks issued.
- ◆ In eight starts between 5/10-6/10, went 5-1 with 2.70 ERA (53.1 IP/16 ER) and 36 strikeouts (7 quality starts).
